PART ONE

1 PREFACE

1.1 ESTABLISHMENT OF THE COMMITTEE

- 2. The power of each House of Parliament to establish Committees and to make Standing Orders for the orderly conduct of its proceedings, including the proceedings of its Committees is provided under Article 124 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010.
- 3. The National Assembly Standing Orders has established various Committees of the House with distinct Mandates. These Committees under the Directorate of Departmental Committees play a pivotal role of facilitating the National Assembly fulfill its constitutional mandate of investigating, inquire into, and reporting on all matters relating to the mandate, management, activities, administration, operations and estimates of the assigned Ministries and departments.

1.2 MANDATE OF THE COMMITTEE

- 4. The Departmental Committee on Transport, Public Works and Housing is established under Standing Order 216(1) whose mandate, pursuant to the Standing Order 216 (5), is as follows;
 - a. investigate, inquire into, and report on all matters relating to the mandate, management, activities, administration, operations and estimates of the assigned Ministries and departments;
 - b. study the programme and policy objectives of Ministries and departments and the effectiveness of the implementation;
 - c. study and review all legislation referred to it;
 - d. study, assess and analyze the relative success of the Ministries and departments as measured by the results obtained as compared with their stated objectives;
 - e. investigate and inquire into all matters relating to the assigned Ministries and departments as they may deem necessary, and as may be referred to them by the Flouse;
 - f. to vet and report on all appointments where the Constitution or any law requires the National Assembly to approve, except those under Standing Order 204 (Committee on Appointments);
 - f. examine treaties, agreements and conventions;
 - g. make reports and recommendations to the House as often as possible, including recommendation of proposed legislation;
 - b. make reports and recommendations to the House as often as possible, including recommendation of proposed legislation;
 - i. consider reports of Commissions and Independent Offices submitted to the House pursuant to the provisions of Article 254 of the Constitution; and
 - j. examine any questions raised by Members on a matter within its mandate.
- 5. Further, the Second Schedule to the Standing Orders mandates the Committee to consider matters relating to the following subjects:
 - a) Transport;
 - b) Roads;
 - c) Public works;
 - d) Construction and maintenance of roads, rails and buildings;
 - e) Air and seaports; and
 - f) Housing.

- 6. In executing this mandate, the Committee oversights various State Departments, namely:
 - a) The State Department of Transport;
 - b) The State Department of Infrastructure;
 - c) The State Department of Housing and Urban Development;
 - d) The State Department of Public Works; and
 - e) The State Department of Shipping and Maritime Affairs.

2.3 INQUIRIES

20. The Committee undertook an inquiry into the aviation sector following the Kenya Airways (KQ) Privately Initiated Investment Proposal (PIIP) for the consideration of Kenya Airports Authority (KAA). It was a proposal for the operation, management, maintenance, investment in and development & upgrading of Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) infrastructure and KQ as a consolidated business platform, involving only the aeronautical assets of JKIA, for a period of 30 years, after which it hands back JKIA to KAA. The Committee recommended nationalization of the Kenya Airways.

2.6 TREATIES AND AGREEMENTS FOR RATIFICATION

- 25. The Committee considered for ratification and concluded on several treaties and agreements, all of which had strategic importance to the national interests. These included the following:
 - i. Revised Constitution of the African Civil Aviation Commission;
 - ii. Bilateral Air Service Agreements between Kenya and: Jordan; Jamaica; Cambodia; Burkina Faso; Finland; Seychelles; Hellenic Republic; Russia: USA; Botswana; South Africa;
 - iii. The Montreal Protocol whose primary purpose was to amend the convention on offences and certain other acts committed on board aircraft (Tokyo Convention, 1963);
 - iv. The 2014 And 2018 Amendments to The Maritime Labour Convention, 2006;
 - v. The International Labour Organization Convention C185 (Amended Convention on Seafarers Identity Documents, 2003);

PART THREE

3 IMPACT OF THE BUSINESS TRANSACTED BY THE COMMITTEE

3.1 STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT

- 28. The Committee engaged with various stakeholders in the execution of its mandate. These included: -
 - Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure, Housing and Urban Development in relation to various issues including budget scrutiny, Kenya Roads Bill, 2017, NAMATA's legal framework and other policy issues;
 - ii. SAGA's such as the National Transport and Safety Authority, the Kenya Civil Aviation Authority, the Kenya Ports Authority, the Kenya National Shipping Line, the Kenya Maritime Authority, the national roads agencies, the Kenya National Housing Corporation, the National Construction Authority, among many others on different issues of national and public interest.
 - iii. Kenya Matatu Owners Association, Kenya Private Sector Alliance, among other private organizations and stakeholders.
 - iv. Inspector General of Police in relation to various issues including the issue of rising cases of roads accidents in the country.
 - v. Kenya Airports Authority and Kenya Airways on matters of their financial performance.
 - vi. The National Treasury, the Kenya Ports Authority and the LAPSSET Corridor Development Authority on issues of funding gap for the Lamu Port project.

3.2 COMMITTEE ACHIEVEMENTS

- a. The Committee facilitated the legal and legislative mechanism for tolling that enabled the construction of the first expressway in the country, a mega infrastructural project. This has opened the way for more projects which will be done through the same model.
- b. The Committee conducted an inquiry into the Standard Gauge Railway, with a view to ensure a win-win outcome between the government on one hand and the citizen and businesspersons on the other hand.
- c. The Committee conducted an inquiry into the aviation sector, with recommendations that led to the introduction of a government Bill on the National Aviation Management.
- d. The Committee conducted an inquiry into the alarming cases of traffic accidents in the country. This led to the restructuring of the functions of agencies that led to the removal of the NTSA officers from the road.
- c. The Committee, while facilitating responses to Members' Questions and Statements, managed to push for numerous infrastructural projects. This varied from roads projects countrywide, commuter rail improvements, enhancement of port operations, building of bridges and footbridges, construction, expansion and rehabilitation of airports and airstrips, among others.
- f. Passage of key legislations including Bills and Petitions in the National Assembly that were key to ensuring that progressive and sustainable development was achieved in the infrastructural and housing spheres.
- g. The Committee Supported the State Department of Housing and Urban Development's initiative in
 - i) the provision of affordable Housing programme by prioritizing Social housing, mobilizing funds through National Housing Development Fund and fostering Public Private Partnership to fund 500,000 units.
 - ii) Decongestion of road traffic through Diesel Multiple Units (DMUs) and modernization of the Central Railway Station in Nairobi.
- h. The Committee supported the Ministry's request to fund projects during budgetary reviews. The process budget review aims at fast tracking development of critical infrastructure in the country and to implement this major policy goal of the government which in the end led to;
 - i) Expansion of the road network;
 - ii) Expansion of the rail network through rehabilitation of Metre Gauge Rail (MGR);
 - iii) Repairing, expansion and modernization of aviation facilities to maintain the country's competitive edge in the region; and
 - iv) Development of Ship Construction and repair yard in Kisumu as well as equipping Bandari Maritime Academy to effectively train seafarers;

PART FOUR

4 REASONS WHY THE COMMITTEE DIDN'T CONCLUDE SOME OF ITS WORK

- 29. The Committee experienced the following challenges which made it difficult for it to optimally discharge its mandate:
 - I. Inadequate committee meeting rooms and furniture occasionally led to delays in starting meetings and at times cancellation of meetings.
- II. The COVID-19 pandemic affected the frequency of meetings and it made it difficult to meet stakeholders to prosecute matters before the Committee. This affected the Committee's efficiency in the execution of its mandate.
- III. The Court Ruling on the Petition by the Senate regarding consideration of Bills between the two Houses of Parliament halted consideration of Bills in the National Assembly for a while. This increased the backlog of Bills in the Committee.
- IV. Unavailability of Government officials when invited for meetings to consider business before the Committee. This made it difficult for the Committee to discharge its mandate effectively.
- V. Some Members whose business was referred to the Committee were not available when invited for Committee meetings to consider their Questions, Legislative Proposals, Statements or Petitions.

VI. Difficulty in raising quorum because of the 2022 General Elections, especially in Sixth Session slowed down activities of the Committee.
