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DEVELOPMENT ESTIMATES FOR THE YEAR 1962/63

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General Memorandum Note

The Development Estimates for 1962/63 cover the final year of the 1960/63 Plan. Total expenditure of £14.116m. is proposed which is £2.4m. greater than the approved Estimate for 1961/62.

The increase results entirely from a very much larger requirement for Land Settlement Schemes, £5.75m. being provided in 1962/63 as compared with £2.8m. in the present financial year.

Apart from provision for Settlement Schemes, the Estimate for the General Development Programme at a total of £8.4m. shows a reduction of approximately £½m. as compared with the 1961/62 printed Estimate. As originally submitted, proposals for expenditure on General Development in 1962/63 totalled more than £9.5m. It was, however, considered that it would not be possible to finance a programme costing more than £8.5m. and within this sum it has been necessary to find savings for requirements for Settlement of £.9m. To the resulting figure of £7.6m. has been added provision for some new projects in the agricultural, industrial and educational development fields including provision for settlement in Tanganyika shown under Head D2—Administration. It is hoped it will be possible to finance these projects from the West German loan and from other special sources. It has also been necessary to add provision for the completion of certain works of which the extension of the Nairobi Airport Runway is the major item. This brings the total Estimate to £8.4m.

Within the 1962/63 Estimates for General Development priority has been given to the expansion of the Localization and Training Programme, followed by priority for the economic services. The savings which it has been necessary to achieve have been found principally by a reduction in the Government's building programme.

It must be emphasized that negotiations have not been completed with the British and West German Governments concerning the provision of all the finance required for the Development Programme in 1962/63.

In addition to expenditure in the Development Estimates, it is expected that up to £1.5m. will be spent on the Contractor-Finance Road Scheme.

In line with arrangements made for the Colony Estimates, some simplification of the Development Estimates has also been carried out.
