DEVELOPMENT ESTIMATES FOR THE YEAR 1961-62

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General Memorandum Note

The Development Estimates for 1961/62 relate to the middle year of the three-year planning period 1960-63. At £11.712 m. they are the largest Development Estimates in Kenya's history. It is proposed to spend £8.239 m. on the projects in the published Development Programme and another £3.473 m. on new schemes, viz.:—

In addition to the expenditure shown in the Development Estimates it is expected that up to £1.250 m. will be spent on the contractor-finance road scheme.

Table 1 shows that it is proposed to finance expenditure amounting to £6.191 m. by Special Funds and the balance of £5.521 m. from the Central Loan Programme. Negotiations are not yet completed for the financing of all projects in these estimates. In particular it has not yet been possible to obtain approval for all the C.D. & W. schemes shown in the estimates. Should any of these schemes not be approved, or should the amounts that have been applied for be reduced, it will be necessary to seek approval from the United Kingdom Government for other schemes to be financed in whole or in part from the Colony's block allocation and for funds to be provided from some other source for those schemes which do not receive approval.

The Development Estimates are presented on a new basis this year. One of the main objects has been to give fuller information on the details of development expenditure and to show more clearly the destination of moneys voted in the Development Estimates. To this end, the information which was formerly relegated to Appendices has been brought into the main body of the estimates. Each Head of expenditure has a summary statement on the lines of the Colony Estimates, together with a statement of expected sources of finance. Large scale development projects often span more than one planning period. The detailed expenditure analysis now shows the relation between proposed expenditure in the planning period 1960-63 and the Full Project Value where this is appropriate.

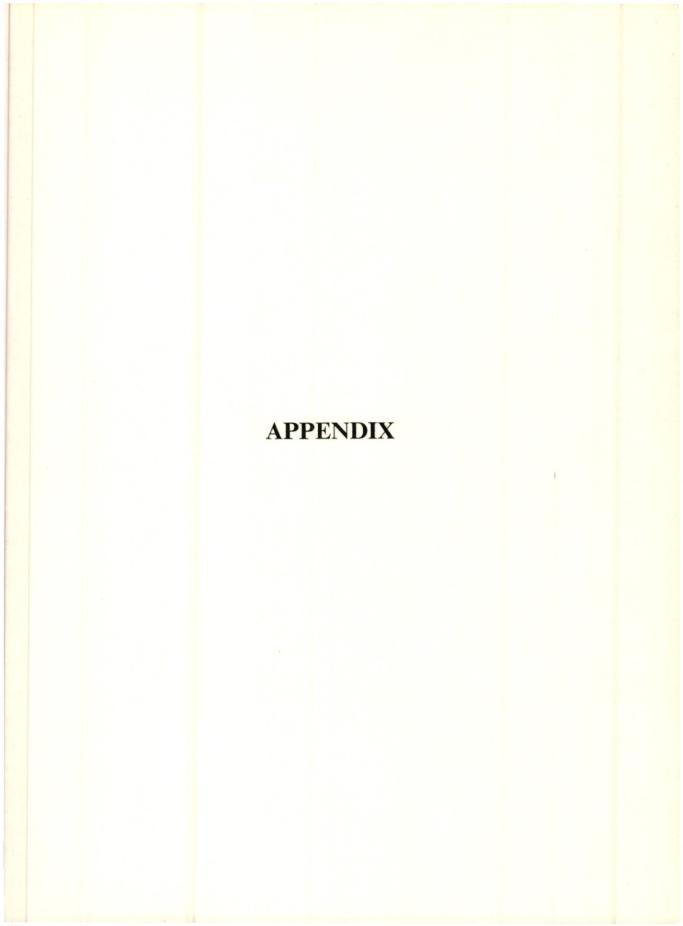
