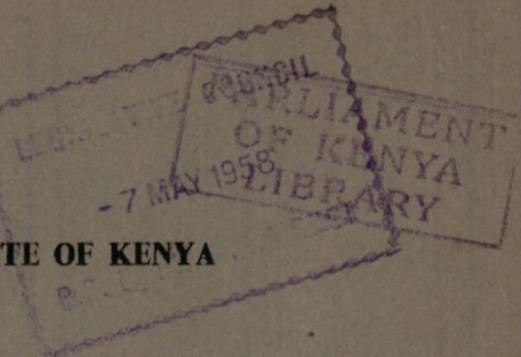

## INTRODUCTION TO THE DEVELOPMENT ESTIMATES

As in 1957/58 the pattern of the 1958/59 Estimates follows that of Sessional Paper No. 77 of 1956/57 which includes the Programme for the Intensified Development of African Agriculture (Swynnerton Plan) as an integral part of the 1957-60 Development Programme. The Estimates are accordingly presented in one section only. The revised allocations and expenditure against the 1954-57 Development Programme which were shown in Table 1 in the 1957/58 Estimates, have been omitted this year. The revised allocations and expenditure against the 1957-60 Development Programme are set out in Table 1 and alterations to the allocations have been explained in footnotes. Progress on the Swynnerton Plan is shown in Tables 2 and 3.

2. The scheme values shown in the expenditure estimates for the period 1957-60 are a combination of the scheme values for the 1957-60 programme, as shown in Sessional Paper No. 77 of 1956/57, plus the unspent balances of schemes in the 1954-57 programme. Certain additional supplementary allocations for the period 1957-60, which are described in the footnotes to Table 1, have been added.

3. It is not anticipated that there will be any measure of physical difficulty in carrying out the works programme required. The building works to be carried out in 1958/59 are estimated at approximately £1,436,500. To this total must be added Hydraulic Works to the extent of £261,512 and Aerodrome Works. To cover the cost of the works staff engaged on those projects it is proposed to make a contribution of £370,000 from Development Funds in aid of the cost of the Ministry of Works staff in the Colony Estimates. Total expenditure in 1958/59 is estimated as £8,534,026 of which approximately £2,807,76~~2~~ will be reimbursable from various sources. This will leave £5,726,26~~4~~ to be covered by borrowing.
