VICE CHANCELLOR'S REPORT

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE 2003

I am pleased to present the Annual Report and Accounts of the University of Nairobi for the financial year ended 30th June 2003.

As in the previous year, the University of Nairobi operated on a deficit. This is as a result of insufficient funding by the government. The adverse financial position notwithstanding, the University continued with its mission of teaching and research. The student population was 27,561 out of which 5,344 were postgraduates. However, the usual University of Nairobi graduation ceremony did not take place due to the prevailing stalemate between the University teaching staff and the government of Kenya, over the terms of service for staff.

During the year under review the University incurred a deficit of Kshs.203,043,381.00 compared to Kshs.202,193,163.00 for the year 2001/2002. The cumulative deficit for at 30th June 2003 was Kshs.2,043,360,877.00

The University continued to receive financial assistance for research from international donors. During the year under review a total of Kshs.304,290,241.00 was received as compared with Kshs.404,996,193.00 in the previous year.

In line with government of Kenya policy to motivate medical staff, the University of Nairobi implemented and paid clinical allowance of Kshs.257,611,719.00 to medical and paramedical staff carrying out clinical duties, during the 2002/2003 financial year.

In the year 2002/2003 His Excellency Hon. Mwai Kibaki C.G.H., M.P., President and Commander in Chief of the Armed Forces, of the Republic of Kenya appointed Mr. Joseph Barage Wanjui as the Chancellor of the University of Nairobi.

On behalf of the University, I wish to take this opportunity to thank the government and our donors for financial support.

I also wish to thank the government for appointing a committee to look into the welfare of the staff of the University.

Finally, I would also like to express my thanks to the University community who worked tirelessly to ensure smooth operation of this institution.

REPORT OF THE CONTROLLER AND AUDITOR GENERAL ON THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NAIROBI FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2003

I have examined the financial statements of the University of Nairobi for the year ended 30 June 2003 in accordance with the provisions of Section 29 of the Exchequer and Audit Act (Cap 412). I have obtained all the information and explanations considered necessary for the purpose of the audit. Proper books of account have been maintained by the University and the financial statements which have been prepared under the historical cost convention, as modified by the revaluation of certain fixed assets, are in agreement therewith and comply with the University of Nairobi Act, 1985.

During the year ended 30 June 2003, the University incurred a deficit of Kshs.203,043,381 which brought the cumulative deficit to Kshs.2,043,360,977 as at the same date. As reported previously, the University was still facing serious financial problems attributed to lack of adequate funding from Government and as a result, the financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis with the assumption that it will get continued financial support from the Government, creditors and bankers.

Except for the foregoing reservation, in my opinion, the financial statements when read together with the notes thereon present fairly the state of financial affairs of the University as at 30 June 2003 and of its cash flows and deficit for the year then ended.

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Notes to the Accounts for the year ended 30th June, 2003

1. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

- 1.1 The accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention as modified by the revaluation of certain fixed assets.
- 1.2 Income from grants and fees includes only amounts receivable in relation to financial year 1997/98.
- 1.3 Income from Endowments and Donations, Research Grants and other services rendered is included only to the extent of the expenditure incurred during the year.
- 1.4 Income on short-term deposits is credited to the General Revenue Account or used for purchase of fixed assets and for capital minor works to the extent determined by the University Council during the year.
- Fixed assets are stated at cost of professional valuation. 1.5 Depreciation is provided for at annual rates estimated to write off the assets over their expected useful lives. The annual rates are: Furniture and Equipment - 10% on reducing balance method - 20% on straight line basis Motor Vehicles Academic gowns - 5% on straight line basis Buildings -2% on a straight line basis Computers and software development - 20% on straight line basis Depreciation is charged to the Capital Fund. Depreciation has not been provided on buildings and the gas plant as the replacement of these items becomes the subject of special grants when such replacement is necessary. 1.6 Endowment and Trust Fund investments are stated at market value. Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value. 1.7 1.8 The cost of Library books is written off to expenditure as incurred. 1.9 Revenue commitments represent goods and services ordered but not delivered at the end of the Financial year.
- 1.10 Appropriation for specific purposes represent revenue generated by the Colleges and unspent balances on certain votes, carried forward to meet expenditure in the ensuing year.
- 1.11 Deans Committee research grants are votes set aside from current and past financial years. The uncommitted balance on each research is carried forward until the related research project is completed.
- 1.12 The main pension scheme for the University's staff is the University of Nairobi Pensions Fund which was started from January 1, 1987. The University's contributions to this scheme have been charged to the relevant salaries votes. A small number of staff still remain in the U.K. based F.S.S.U. Pension Scheme.
- 1.13 Assets and liabilities in foreign currencies are converted into Kenya shillings at the rates of exchange ruling at the balnce sheet date. Conversion differences are accounted for in the appropriation fund account.
- 1.14 Values for equipment donated are estimated by the University or as advised by donors.

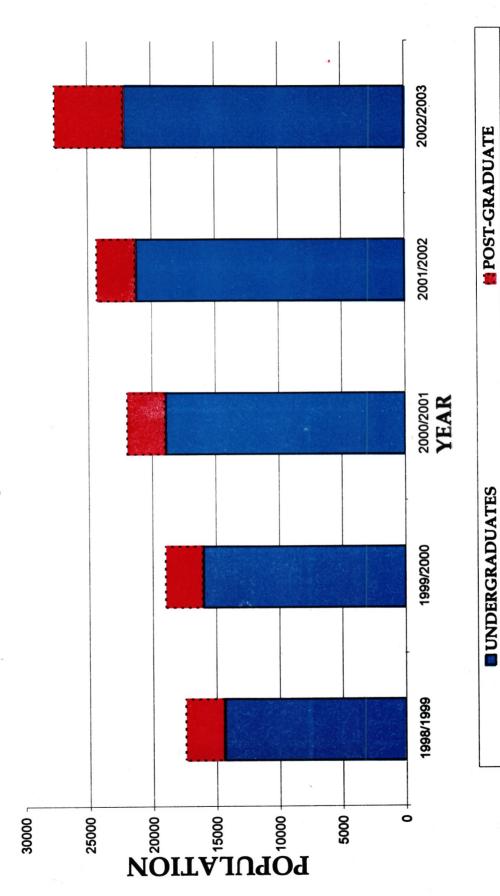
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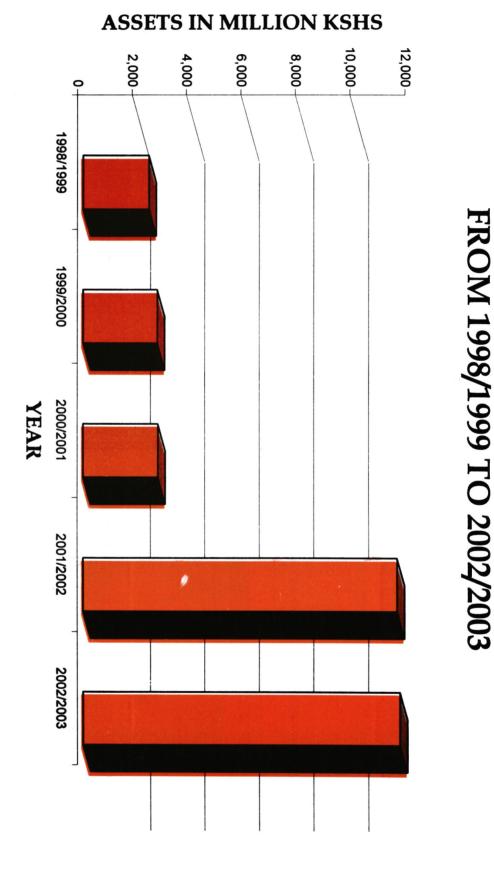

STUDENT POPULATION FROM 1999/2000 TO 2002/2003



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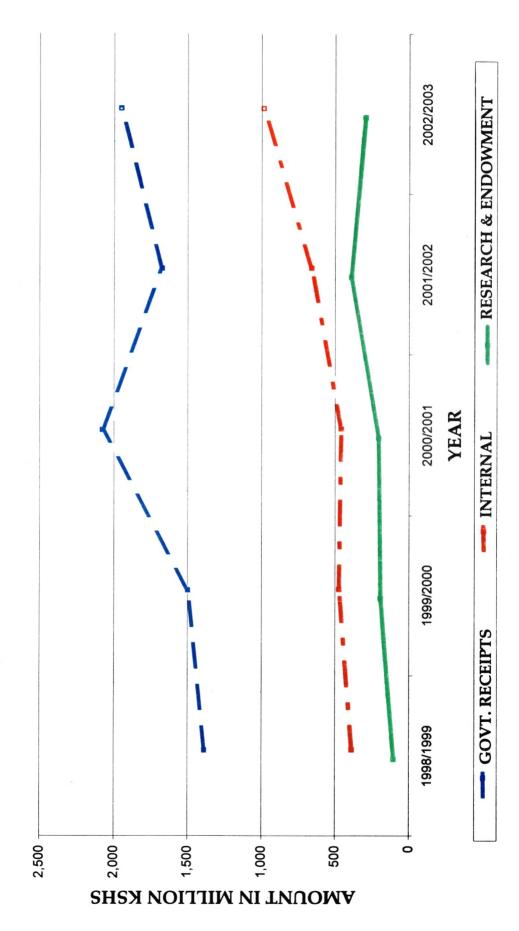


5 YEAR GROWTH OF FIXED ASSETS



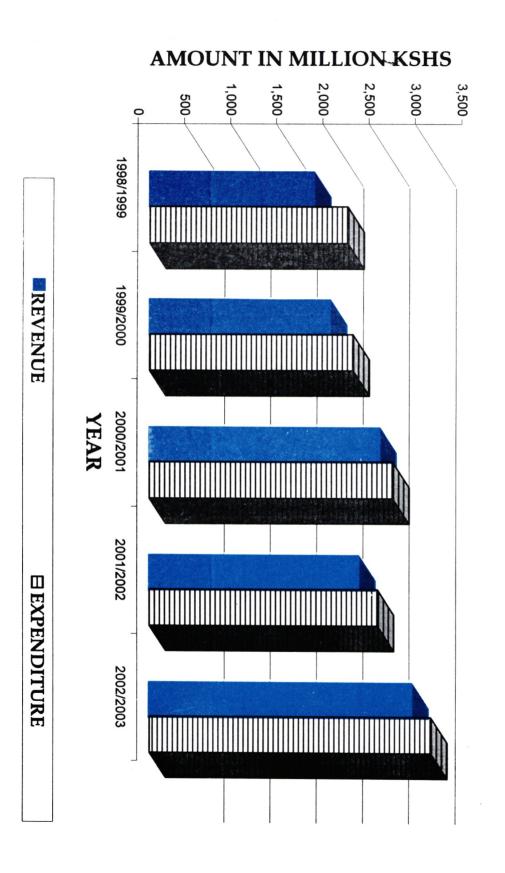
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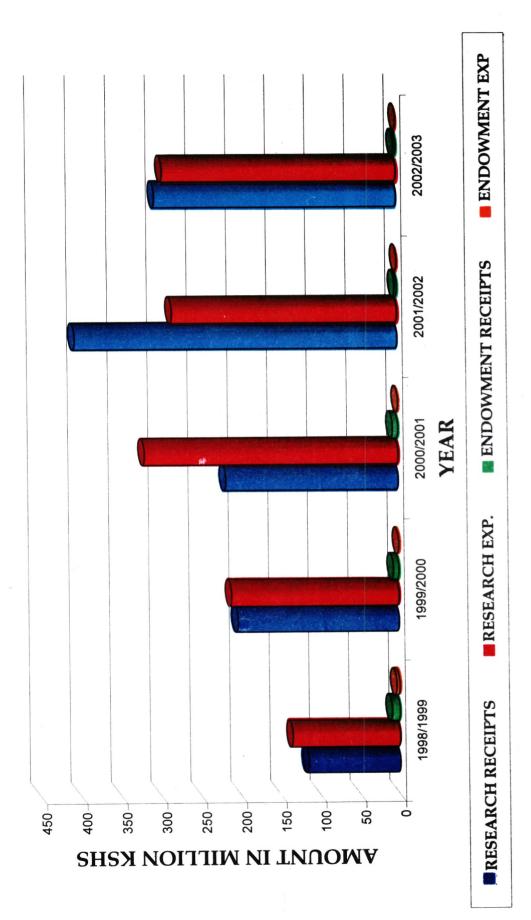
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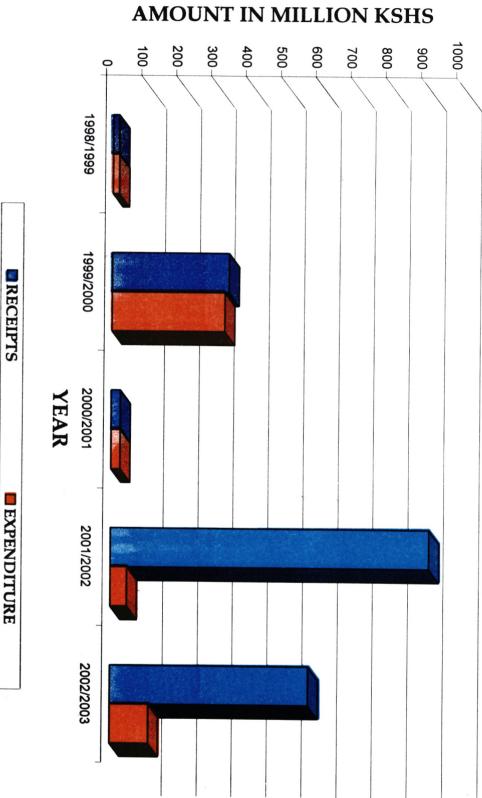
