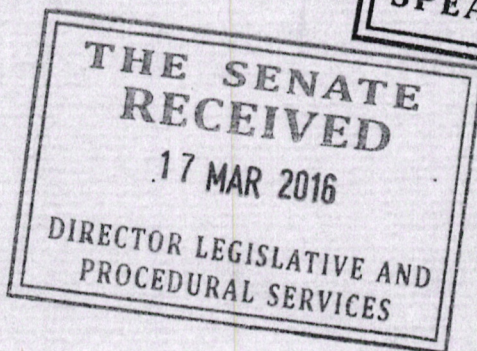
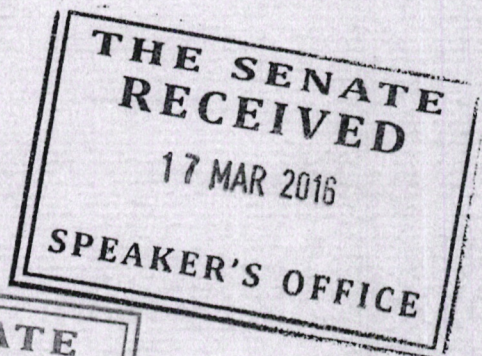

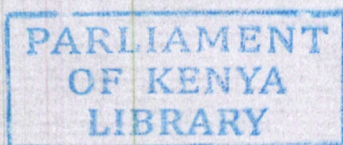

**RE: REQUEST FOR STATEMENT ON THE STATUS OF THE  
NATIONAL SECURITY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM**

I wish to request a statement from the Chairman of the Senate Committee on National Security and Foreign Relations on the status of the national security communications system, and in particular to address the following issues:


1. What is the objective of this project?
2. Who are the lead implementers of this project? What procedure under the Public Procurement and Disposal Act was used to select and appoint them?



3. What is the scope of the project, i.e. the geographic area covered and security agencies that will utilise it?
4. What is the cost to taxpayers of this project?
5. What is the current status of this project? When is it expected to be complete, and what benefits should Kenyans expect from it?
6. What procedure under the Public Procurement and Disposals Act was used to allocate the 4G frequency spectrum license to the implementers of this project? What is the value of this license? How much has been paid for it by the implementers? Has this amount been deposited in the Consolidated Fund?
7. How does the government intend to take over control and management of this critical security network upon successful implementation?
