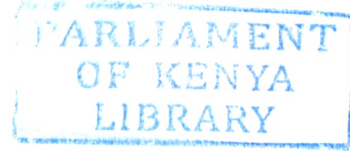


REQUEST FOR STATEMENT FROM THE CHAIRMAN, STANDING COMMITTEE ON LABOUR AND SOCIAL WELFARE.

Mr. Speaker Sir, I beg to request a statement from the Chair, Standing Committee on Labour and Social Welfare, regarding ***The status of Cash Transfer Programme.*** In his statement the chairman should address the following issues:

1. How many senior citizens and other disadvantaged citizens who are receiving cash transfers under the Cash Transfer Programme.
2. Give the names of senior citizens and other disadvantaged citizens receiving these funds from each of the 47 Counties; contrast this information with total population of each County.
3. Names of citizens receiving these funds from each of the constituencies.
4. In the estimation of the Chair, how many eligible citizens are **NOT** benefiting from cash transfers.

Mr. Speaker,

It is instructive to note that a similar statement was sought from the same Chair on 19.02.2015. However, as of the close of the last senate session the Chair, despite a lot of efforts put by him, had not given a satisfactory statement. I therefore, appeal to you Mr. Speaker to impress upon the Chair to hasten the issue of this statement. This is a matter of great National concern as the whole programme is surrounded by secrecy with millions of eligible citizens going without the cash transfers and allegations, which we cannot ignore, that these funds are going to wrong hands.
