- Abstracts should clearly highlight the objective, problem, methodology, key findings/results, conclusions, recommendations and six key words. Also purely theoretical papers focusing on the subthemes will be accepted.
- Each abstract should include the name of the author(s), affiliation(s), postal address, e -mail, and Telephone Contacts. The length of the abstract should be 300 words.
- Each full paper should Not Exceed 5,000 words (excluding abstract, references and footnotes), Single Spacing Font Size 12, Times New Roman, Tables and Figures Inserted where first cited, Ms Word Format.
- The abstract and the full paper should follow the APA format of referencing:
- All references listed should be cited appropriately in the text.
