## CHAIRPERSONS FORWARD

Pursuant to Section 50 (5) of the National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) Act of 2015, the Select Committee on NG-CDF of the National Assembly is mandated to consider and report to the National Assembly, with recommendations, names of persons required to be approved by the National Assembly under the Act amongst others.

Section 43(1) and (2) of the National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) Act 2015 provides that:

*“(1) There is established a National Government Constituency Development Fund Committee for every constituency.*

*(2) Each Constituency Committee shall comprise of—*

*(a.) the national government official responsible for coordination of national government functions;*

*(b.) two men each nominated in accordance with subsection (3), one of whom shall be a youth at the date of appointment;*

*(c.) two women nominated in accordance with subsection (3), one of whom shall be a youth at the date of appointment;*

*(d.) one person with disability nominated by a registered group representing persons with disabilities in the constituency in accordance with subsection (3); and*

*(e.) two persons nominated by the constituency office established under Regulations made pursuant to the Parliamentary Service Act”;*

Further, Section 43 (3) and (4) provides that: -

*“(3) The seven persons referred to in subsection (2) (b), (c), (d) and (e) shall be selected in such manner and shall have such qualifications as the Board may, by regulations, prescribe.*

*(4) The names of the persons selected under subsection (3) shall be submitted by the Board to the National Assembly for approval before appointment and gazettelement by the Board.”*

In accordance with section 43(4) of the NG-CDF Act of 2015 which provides for submission of names by the Board to the National Assembly for approval before appointment and gazettelement by the board and regulation 5(2a) which provides for appointment of members of constituency committees upon commencement of a new parliamentary term, the National Government Constituencies Development Fund Board forwarded names of Garissa Township, Mbeere North and Narok East Constituencies to the Select Committee on NGCDF for consideration and recommendation for approval by the National Assembly.

The Committee considered the nominees pursuant to the provisions of the NG-CDF Act and resolved to approve the nominees.

The Committee is grateful to the offices of the Speaker and Clerk of the National Assembly for the logistical and technical support accorded to it during its sittings. Finally, I wish to express my appreciation to the Honorable members of the Committee and the Committee secretariat who made useful contributions towards the preparations and production of this report.

## 1.0 PREFACE

### 1.1 ESTABLISHMENT AND MANDATE OF THE COMMITTEE

1. The Select Committee on National Government Constituency Development Fund is established in accordance with the provisions of section 50 of the National Government Constituency Development Fund Act, 2015 and its functions include:

- a) To oversee the implementation of this Act and in this respect, shall after every two years submit a report to the National Assembly and where necessary, propose any amendments to this Act with respect to the quantum of funds repayable into the Fund in accordance with section 4 of the Act;
- b) To oversee the policy framework and legislative matters that may arise in relation to the Fund;
- c) To continually review the framework set out for the efficient delivery of development programmes financed through the Fund;
- d) To consider and report to the National Assembly, with recommendations, names of persons required to be approved by the National Assembly under this Act; and
- e) To carry out any other functions relevant to the work of the Fund.

## **2.0 LEGAL FRAMEWORK FOR APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO CONSTITUENCY NG-CDF COMMITTEE**

4. The consideration of the list of nominees for constituency NG-CDF committee is governed by Section 43(1) and (2) of the National Government Constituencies Development Fund (NG-CDF) Act 2015 provides that:

*“(1) There is established a National Government Constituency Development Fund Committee for every constituency.*

*(2) Each Constituency Committee shall comprise of –*

- a) the national government official responsible for coordination of national government functions;*
- b) two men each nominated in accordance with subsection (3), one of whom shall be a youth at the date of appointment;*
- c) two women nominated in accordance with subsection (3), one of whom shall be a youth at the date of appointment;*
- d) one person with disability nominated by a registered group representing persons with disabilities in the constituency in accordance with subsection (3); and*
- e) two persons nominated by the constituency office established under Regulations made pursuant to the Parliamentary Service Act”;*

5. Further, Section 43 (3) and (4) provides that: -

*“(3) The seven persons referred to in subsection (2) (b), (c), (d) and (e) shall be selected in such manner and shall have such qualifications as the Board may, by regulations, prescribe.*

*(4) The names of the persons selected under subsection (3) shall be submitted by the Board to the National Assembly for approval before appointment and gazettelement by the Board.”*

## **3.0 CONSIDERATION OF NOMINEES TO THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT CONSTITUENCY DEVELOPMENT FUND COMMITTEES**

6.
