RE: PETITION ON ALLEGED INVASION OF LR5875/2 IN ROYSAMBU CONSTITUENCY BY THE KENYA DEFENCE FORCES

That above petition was conveyed to the House by your Honourable Speaker on behalf of the petitioners on 27th June 2019. The same petition was committed to the Departmental Committee on Lands was subsequently heard, determined and a Report tabled in the House on 5th December 2019;

In response to the petitioners' prayers the Committee made the following recommendations:

1. THAT, the Ministry of Lands and Physical Planning in consultation with the National Land Commission and the Nairobi County Government does complete the titling process for LR. No.5875/2 within 180 days of tabling of the report;
2. THAT, the director for Criminal Investigations does investigate the officers in the Ministry of Lands and Physical Planning who may have caused the loss of public funds by effecting fraudulent transactions relating to LR. No. 5875/2 and the Director of Public Prosecution does prosecute any person found culpable within 90 days of tabling the report;

3. THAT, the Ministry of Lands and Physical Planning does secure the title relating to LR.No.23393 with a view of ensuring that innocent Kenyans do not lose money through fraudulent transactions as evidenced by the attempt to amalgamate it with LR. No5875/2;
4. THAT, Mr. Speaker the petitioners efforts and pursuit to have the government agencies and departments directed to implement these recommendations have not born any fruit;
5. THAT, my interventions accompanied by other constituency leaders and all the Nairobi Members of Parliament to the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Lands and to the Attorney General have been ignored;
6. THAT, in particular the office of the Attorney General disputes the validity of the Parliamentary Committee Report claiming that the same has not been adopted by Parliament even after being supplied with a copy;
7. THAT, Mr. Speaker the time window given by the report within which the recommendations should be implemented lapsed on 5th June 2020;
8. THAT, in those circumstances I am requesting your permission that a motion be authored to adopt the Report by a Resolution of the House and any other relief that Mr. Speaker in your wisdom will compel the Government Agencies to obey and implement the recommendations of the Departmental Committee of Lands.
