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#### PREFACE

The Consolidated National Government Investment Report summarizes the extent of National Government involvement or investment in, or funding of, all State Corporations and Government-Linked Corporations for that Financial Year. The Report is prepared in accordance with the provisions of the Public Financial Management Act, 2012, Section 89. The Report for 2023/2024 FY is the 11<sup>th</sup> edition and provides information of the National Government involvement in State Corporations and Government Linked Corporations in four (4) main areas, namely shareholding/equity; grants & subsidies; loans & guarantees; and revenue receipts.

During the period under review, the Government implemented bold policy incentives to mitigate negative global and persistent shocks that had pushed the economy to its lowest vibrant level and embarked on structural reforms to stabilize Government finances and the economy. These shocks included global supply chain disruptions; high cost of accessing credit in the domestic and international money markets, volatile foreign exchange rates and high debt servicing costs. This also affected the financial and operational performance of Government investments.

Government Investments were faced with challenges of high cost of doing business & debt serving, generating adequate revenue from sales, as well non-receipts of revenue due. This led to cash flow challenges with the resultant build-up in unpaid bills. The Government initiated policy measures to enhance state corporations' revenue generation and expenditure rationalization in line with the Government's fiscal consolidation efforts.

Government policy measures were initiated for all state corporations to ensure prudent and responsible use of public resources as provided for in the Constitution and other relevant laws. The policy measures were geared towards enhancing efficiency, self-sustainability, and generate additional revenue for the National Exchequer.

Due to the challenges facing Government investments, the National Treasury undertook a preliminary assessment covering financial evaluation and review of enabling legislations. The preliminary assessment of State Corporations and Government-Owned Enterprises was to determine their viability in terms of Government budgetary resources required for their sustainability as well as their continued relevance.

The preliminary assessment was intended to provide a basis for Government policy decision for State Corporations reforms, among others: State Corporations with outdated mandates, entities for privatization, entities requiring large bailouts or those producing goods and providing services better suited for the private sector to be considered for privatization.

The assessment was also aimed at identifying entities for restructuring including mergers or transfers to parent ministries or relevant corporations, to eliminate duplication, enhance efficiency, optimize resource use, increase revenue to the exchequer, and improve service delivery to Kenyans.

The Government also initiated policy changes to ensure Government- Owned Enterprises (GOE) realize their full potential. In November, 2023 the Cabinet approved the Ownership Policy for GOEs, a key governance reforms framework. To anchor the policy in law and facilitate its implementation, the draft Government-Owned Enterprises Bill, 2024, underwent public participation and the process is ongoing.

The Government also prepared draft Government Investment Regulations, 2024 to provide a framework for the efficient and effective management of Government Investments. The draft Regulations have undergone public participation and are being finalized for submission to Parliament.

During the reporting period, the Cabinet approved divesture of six (6) entities through the Nairobi Securities Exchange, to optimize the contributions of the investments towards the achievement of national development goals. The Companies include East African Portland Cement Company, Nairobi Securities Exchange, Housing Finance Company of Kenya, CFC Stanbic, Liberty Kenya Holdings and Eveready East Africa PLC. To facilitate the sale of shares and in line with Central Depositories Act 2000, the Government initiated the process of dematerialization of its securities through the Central Depository and Settlement Corporation.

The Government continued to enhance governance mechanisms, management, performance and operations of State Corporations to improve efficiency and quality service delivery. Towards this end and pursuant to operational and financial oversight role on Government investments, the National Treasury and Economic Planning continued to leverage on ICT with operationalization of Government Investments Management Information System (GIMIS). The System has enhanced efficiency, transparency and completeness of State Corporations' financial, operational performance and fiscal risk analysis and enables quantification and reporting of fiscal risk exposure from State Corporations. Further, it enhances monitoring of Government investments in Government Linked Corporations and International Bodies.

During the year under review, a significant improvement was recorded in most facets of government investments. Internally generated funds by State Corporations increased by 24% from Kshs.1,003,229 million in 2023/2024 FY to Kshs.868,359 million in 2023/2024 FY. Total transfers and subsidies to State Corporations in 2023/2024 FY was Kshs.266,241 million for recurrent and Kshs.107,549 million for development.

The profit declared by Commercial State Corporations decreased by 35% from Kshs.63,709 million in 2022/2023 to Kshs.41,230 million in 2023/2024 FY. The Government received a total revenue of Kshs.51,802 million from Government Investments in form of dividends, loan redemption & interest payments and directors' fees. This was an increase of 24% in comparison to Kshs.41,833 million received in 2022/2023 FY. Total assets amounted to Kshs.7,861,391 million with net assets/total equity of Kshs.5,436,372 million.

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- I wish to underscore that the National Treasury is committed to providing accurate and timely information to promote Government investment transparency and accountability in accordance with the best practices. To this end, a lot of diligence and data validation has been done in compiling the 2023/2024 Report. It is my hope that the Report will provide valuable insights to Parliament and other stakeholders in the discharge of their mandates.
- This Report is prepared based on management accounts for 2023/2024 FY. The preparation involved collaborative efforts and material inputs from the National Treasury and the State Corporations.

I wish to thank all Chief Executive Officers for facilitating and submitting the information required. I also take this opportunity to recognize the key role played by the Government Investments and Public Enterprises Department in its lead role in enabling timely production of the Consolidated National Government Investment Report for 2023/2024 FY.

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Legal Basis for the Consolidated National Government Investment Report The Consolidated National Government Investment Report is prepared in accordance with the Public Finance Management Act 2012, Section 89 states as follows:

- (1) The Cabinet Secretary responsible for matters relating to public investments shall prepare and submit to the National Assembly, not later than four months after the end of each financial year, a consolidated report summarizing the extent of National Government involvement or investment in, or funding of, all State Corporations and Government-Linked Corporations for that Financial Year.
- (2) The Report under subsection (1) shall include information on
  - a) the date of incorporation and objects of the corporation;
  - b) the amount of National Government shareholding, directly or indirectly, in the State Corporation;
  - c) any changes in the shareholding of the State Corporation during the Financial Year;
  - d) the amount of any funding in the form of grants or subsidies provided by the National Government to the State Corporation or Government-Linked Corporations, excluding profit-making State Corporation, during the Financial Year;
  - e) the amount of any loans made by the national government to the state corporation, and the amount of any guarantees issued by the national government in respect of the state corporation, during the financial year;
  - f) the cumulative amount of undischarged loans and guarantees in respect of the state corporation;
  - g) the amount of the profit/surplus or loss/deficit of the state corporation for the financial year;
  - h) the amount of any revenue received by the national government from the state corporation during the financial year, including dividends, interest and proceeds from any divestiture of assets of the state corporation;
  - the amount of payments made, or losses incurred, by the National Government to meet contingent liabilities as a result of loans or guarantees during the financial year, including payments made in respect of guarantees, loan write-offs or waiver of interest on loans; and
  - An assessment of the financial and related non-financial performance of the State Corporation for the Financial Year.
- (3) Once every three years, the Cabinet Secretary responsible for matters relating to public investments shall prepare a report on the assessment of the National Government's continued involvement or investment in, or funding of, the State Corporation or Government Linked Corporation.
- (4) The Cabinet Secretary responsible for matters relating to public investments shall submit copies of the reports referred to in subsections (2) and (3) to the Cabinet Secretary, the Controller of Budget, the Commission on Revenue Allocation and to the Auditor-General

#### State Corporations and Government Linked Corporations

- 1. The State Corporations Act, Cap 446, is the over-arching governing law on the establishment, fiduciary oversight on management and governance; and financial control of State Corporations.
- State Corporations or Parastatals are legal entities established by Government or investments in which the Government holds over fifty (50) per cent control or ownership. They implement priority Government policies, strategic projects and programmes in social, business and commercial sectors of the economy.
- 3. They are incorporated under the Companies Act or an enabling Act of Parliament in which whole or controlling shareholding belongs to the Government. State Corporations are therefore, distinct legal entities that are operationally autonomous from Government and may be self-financing through internally-generated funds, loans backed by their assets, partially funded or fully financed by the Exchequer.
- 4. State Corporations are categorized as commercial and non-commercial. Commercial State Corporations comprise:
  - a. Companies with GoK shareholding, through the Cabinet Secretary to the National Treasury as a Body Corporate, of more than 50%;
  - b. A Body Corporate established to perform a strategic function profitably,
  - c. An entity that generally operates on commercial principles,
  - d. Generally self-financing and sustaining, except in financing investment for public policy objectives; and
  - e. Accountable to all stakeholders and the public through the relevant departmental and oversight committees of Parliament.
- For the Commercial State Corporations with "public goods" mandate, the GoK is required to meet the full cost of those "public good" activities using budgetary resources approved by Parliament.
- 6. Non-Commercial State Corporations are expected to operate on a cost recovery basis and largely depend on monies appropriated by Parliament, levies and fees. They include regulatory agencies and statutory boards; research institutions; institutions of higher learning and referral hospitals. Non-Commercial State Corporations deliver services on behalf of line Ministries and are funded mainly through the National Budgets in form of grants or loans from the Government.
- 7. Besides State Corporations, the Government also invests in other organizations, commonly referred to as Government Linked Corporations (GLC). GLCs are entities in which the Government's shareholding is fifty (50) per cent and below. The Government participates in GLCs primarily to correct market failures and also partake in profit sharing in profitable enterprises to augment public resources.
- 8. The Government investments in GLCs in particular target perceived high risk investments from the private sector perspective, but in themselves have a high impact to the economy.

Consolidated National Government Investment Report 2023/2024 FY (Section 89 of PFMA)

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### I. Status of National Government Involvement in State Corporations in 2023/2024 FY

The internally generated revenue (AIA) increased from Kshs.1,003,229 million in 2022/2023 FY to Kshs.1,143,095 million in 2023/2024 FY. The total assets increased from Kshs.7,420,069 million in 2022/2023 FY to Kshs.7,778,304 million in 2023/2024 FY. The increase is mainly attributed to the growth in infrastructural projects under Transport and Energy Sectors; Kenya Airports Authority (KAA) with total assets amounting to Kshs.1,056,585 million, Kenya National Highway Authority amounting to Kshs.807,998 million, Kenya Railways Corporation amounting to Kshs.788,485 million, Kenya Electricity Generating Company amounting to Kshs.490,283 million and Kenya Power and Lighting Company amounting to Kshs.358,086 million. The change in State Corporations total assets was attributed to capitalization of work in progress and new acquisitions during the financial year.

### Chart 1: State Corporations Asset and Liabilities Trend




2. In 2023/2024 FY, the total GOK shareholding in nominal terms was **Kshs.106,166 million** with market value of **Kshs.277,659 million** for the publicly listed corporations. During the period there was no movement in shareholding.

### II. Grants and Subsidies


3. Total grants and subsidies to State Corporations in 2023/2024 FY were Kshs.374,891 million, comprising Recurrent grants Kshs.264,776 million and GoK Capital grants Kshs.110,115 million compared to Kshs.343,190 million comprising Recurrent grants Kshs.265,045 million and GoK Capital grants Kshs.78,145 million in 2022/2023 FY.

4. State Corporations generated approximately Kshs.1,143,096 million in 2023/2024 FY which accounted for about 75% of total revenue generated within the State Corporations subsector with the remainder (25%) coming from Government grants. However, it should be noted that a substantial proportion of the internally generated revenue comprises of member contributions to various Funds; National Social Security Fund Kshs.105,409 million, Public Service Superannuation Fund Kshs.58,192 million, Kenya Deposit Insurance Corporation Kshs.34,568 million and Local Authorities Provident Fund Kshs.19,417 million.




### **Chart 2 : Internally Generated Funds and GoK Grants**

#### III. Financial Performance

5. During 2023/2024 Financial Year, State Corporations posted accumulated profits/surplus amounting to Kshs.230,400 million compared to Kshs.133,410 million posted in 2022/2023 Financial Year. Commercial State Corporations in 2023/2024 Financial Year posted net profit amounting to Kshs. 132,735 million compared to Kshs.63,709 million posted in 2022/2023 FY. Under the commercial state corporation's category; Kenya Power reported the highest net profit of Kshs.30,080 million followed by KPA with Kshs.12,893 million then KPC and KenGen with net profit of Kshs.6,866 million and Kshs.6,797 million respectively. The growth in profitability is mainly attributed to Government concerted efforts including the turnaround strategy in energy sector state corporation, government policy measures on revenue enhancement and cost rationalization.


### Chart 3: Top Ten Commercial State Corporations Profitability



- However, it should be noted that a substantial proportion of profits declared are from Funds comprising of Member contributions; National Social Security Fund Kshs.88,126 million, Public Service Superannuation Fund Kshs.57,488 million, Kenya Deposit Insurance Corporation Kshs.33,648 million and Local Authorities Provident Fund Kshs.3,445 million.
- 7. Kenya Railways Corporation reported the highest net loss of Kshs.50,374 million followed by NHIF and New KCC with net loss of Kshs.3,375 million and Kshs.2,416 million respectively. Under the non-commercial category; Communication Authority had the highest surplus of Kshs.6,773 million while NACONEK has the highest deficit of Kshs.3,098 million followed by REREC and KFS with a deficit of Kshs.1,847 million and Kshs. 1,772 million respectively.

#### IV. National Government Loans and Guarantees to State Corporations

- The National Treasury has guaranteed a number of loans to State Corporations and Government linked Corporations. As at June 30, 2024 only three corporations had guaranteed loans as follows: - Kenya Ports Authority Kshs.43,135 million, Kenya Electricity Generating Company Kshs.27,891 million, and Kenya Airways Kshs.29.139 million.
- 9. As at June 30, 2024 total outstanding Government guaranteed debt was Kshs.100,165 million a decrease from Kshs.170,229 million as at June 30, 2023. The decrease was mainly attributed to novation of Kenya Airways Guaranteed Loan amounting to Kshs.58,647 million taken over by government
- 10. Total undischarged GoK loans to State Corporations stood at Kshs.1,182,792 million by the end of 2023/2024 FY compared with Kshs.961,683 million in 2022/2023 FY. The commercial loans borrowed on the strength of the balance sheet amounted to Kshs.78,207 million.

#### V. Contingent Liabilities

- 11. As the principal owner of all State Corporations, the Government is the natural underwriter of risk that they face. Analysis of contingent liabilities therefore, is important in understanding the extent of the Government fiscal risks exposure.
- 12. Contingent liabilities are those exposures to the Government from State Corporations and Government Linked Corporations by virtue of Government being the owner or majority shareholder of those entities. This emanates from failure by those entities to meet their statutory and contractual obligations.
- 13. Contingent liabilities can be explicit or implicit. Explicit contingent liabilities are those that have crystallized and determined. The government is legally mandated to settle such an obligation when it falls due. Implicit contingent liabilities represent a moral obligation or expected responsibility of the Government, but based on public expectations and the entity's strategic importance to the economy.


14. Pending bills among State Corporations remain high, with records indicating Kshs. 379,817 million as at 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2024. However, the amount is 14% decrease compared to Kshs.443,596 million as at 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2023. During the period under review, unpaid contractor fees for capital projects at Kshs.160,646 million, land compensation at Kshs.41,410 million, consumables & general supplies at Kshs.37,827 million, other contracted services at Kshs.26,286 million and unremitted employer pension contributions at Kshs.24,097 million are some of the key pending bills reported by State Corporations, with some requesting for exchequer support to clear the bills.

### VI. Revenue Receipts by National Government from State Corporations and Government-Linked Corporations

- 15. The receipts by the National Treasury from State Corporations and Government-linked companies are in form of dividends, loan repayments, interest on loans, other profits remittances and director's fees. In 2023/2024 Financial Year, total receipts by National Treasury amounted to Kshs.51,802 million. The amount is 24% increase as compared to Kshs.41,833 million received in 2022/2023 FY.
- 16. Receipts from dividends, other profits and directors' fees during this period were Kshs.42,629 million representing 82% of total receipts. The largest contributors of dividends were Safaricom at Kshs.16,406 million, Kenya Ports Authority at Kshs.10,576 million, Kenya Pipeline Company at Kshs.7,000 million and Kenya Electrical Generating Company at Kshs 2,307 million.
- 17. During the year under review, revenue receipts by Government from State Corporations in respect to Principal Loan Repayment and Interest payment amounted to Kshs.7,087 million and Kshs.2,087 million respectively.
