Draft Amendments to the Standing Orders of the House of Representatives as proposed by the Sessional Committee on 9th February, 1965, consequential upon Amendments to the Constitution of Kenya:-

- S.O.1. Delete all words after "Mr. Speaker".
- S.O.2. Amend definition of "Minister" to read as follows:-
"Minister" includes the President, the Vice-President, other Ministers, the Attorney-General, Assistant Ministers, and any person who holds temporarily any such office.
- S.O.3. Substitute "President's" for "Governor's".
- S.O.6. Substitute "President" for "Governor".
- S.O.22. Substitute "President" for "Governor".
- S.O.23. Substitute "Friday" for "Thursday".
- S.O.62. Substitute "President" for "Her Majesty", and delete all words following.
- S.O.63(1). Delete the words "The conduct of Her Majesty, Members of the Royal Family, the Governor, Mr. Speaker, Senators" at the commencement and insert in place thereof the following words:-
"The personal conduct of the President, the Vice-President, the Speaker of either House"
- S.O.88. Delete sub-section (2).
- S.O.117(2). Substitute "President" for "Governor".
- S.O.119. Substitute "the President, the Government of the Republic of Kenya" for "Her Majesty the Queen, her Heirs and Successors".
- S.O.134. Substitute "President" for "Governor".
- S.O.149(1). Insert immediately after the words "Provided that" in the proviso thereof, the words "when the House contains an official Opposition".
