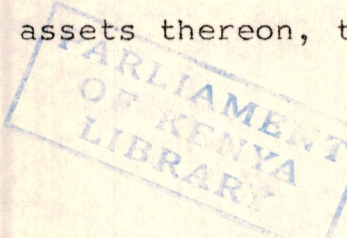

KIANYAGA FARMERS' TRAINING CENTRE

1. MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTIVES:

The objective of this Sessional Paper is to inform Parliament, as required by the Provisions of Section. J.13 of the "Financial Orders-1968 Edition", about the proposal by the Ministry of Agriculture to transfer the Kianyaga Farmers Training Centre in Kirinyaga District, together with all fixed assets thereon, to Kirinyaga County Council, for use by:



- 1.1. Kianyaga Secondary School
- 1.2. Kirinyaga Child Welfare Society.
- 1.3. Kianyaga Health Centre.

2. THE CENTRE:

2.1. The Kianyaga Farmers Centre was set aside during the Land consolidation programme in 1957, and vested in the Kirinyaga County Council under Land Parcel NO. Baragwi/Raimu/63 . It has been occupied since then by the Ministry of Agriculture as a Farmers' Training Centre.

2.2. The Centre occupies approximately twenty-six (26) acres and the developments thereon are in line with original plans for which the Centre was intended.

3. ASSETS AND IMPROVEMENTS.

The assets and improvement on the Centre are valued at K& 4,707, and it is proposed that they be apportioned to the beneficiaries as follows:


3.3. KIANYAGA HEALTH CENTRE (5 ACRES)

This is an open grazing field with no permanent improvements except fencing valued at Kshs.2,000/-. Grass Establishment (Leys, nappier etc) Kshs. 3,000/-. Natural trees Kshs.1,000/-

Total value Kshs. 6,000/-

4. The fixed assets and improvement on the Station valued at K£. .4,707 are being handed over to the beneficiaries as Government grant to the people of Kirinyaga District for use by the proposed organisations i.e. Kianyaga Secondary School, Kirinyaga Child Welfare Society, and Kianyaga Health Centre

5. The Minister for Finance and Planning has already signified his agreement to this proposal, and the intended transfer will not, other than investments already made, involve additional expenditure of public funds.
