REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL FOR THE YEAR 1972

REVIEW OF THE YEAR

As has been the case for a number of years, I have again to report a considerable increase in the work of almost all sections of the Department. The additional volume of work passing through our hands continued to place a great strain on both staff and accommodation.

The opening of Sheria House, however, by His Excellency the President, Mzee Jomo Kenyatta on 6th December, 1972, enabled the staff of the Central Registry of Births, Deaths and Marriages to move from the extremely cramped quarters which they were then occupying to the extremely well appointed office accommodation provided in the new building. This move, in its turn, released more space for the staff and records of other registries such as that of Companies, Business Names, Patents and Trade Marks.

With the move into Sheria House it was also possible to improve the facilities for members of the public visiting the Registries and the conditions of serious over-crowding which used to obtain in the Central Registration Hall have now happily ceased to exist. It was also found possible to improve the amenities of the staff by providing a canteen in the new building where officers can obtain tea, coffee and food at economical prices.

COMPANIES SECTION

The section comprises the registries of Companies, Business Names, Limited Partnerships and Chattels Transfers.

The number of new companies, both public and private, incorporated during the year was 825 compared with 984 in the previous year. The amount of nominal capital of the new companies registered, together with increases in capital of existing companies, was K£31,825,270 compared with K£31,143,648 in 1971.

There were 31 foreign companies registered and 11 such companies removed from the register during the year.

A total of 8,798 locally incorporated companies were on the register at 31st December, 1972, of which 470 were public and 8,328 were private. The number of foreign companies on the register stood at 783 at the end of the year, showing an increase of 20 compared with the previous year.

Of the new companies incorporated in the year, 37 per cent were formed by the African community, 30 per cent by the Asian community, 16 per cent by the European community and 17 per cent by persons of two or more communal groups. The corresponding figures for the previous year were African 33 per cent, Asian 38 per cent, European 15 per cent and African, Asian and European 14 per cent.

Out of 30 public companies formed, 28 were formed by Africans, and the remaining two were formed by Africans with other communal groups.

BUSINESS NAMES

The registration of new businesses was slightly down with 3,683 compared with 4,404 in 1971 but the number of registered changes in particulars of existing businesses was 2,389 compared with 2,052 in the previous year. Four hundred and twenty-seven business names were removed from the register during the year, leaving a total of 51,737 on the register at the end of the year.

CHATTELS TRANSFER

The volume of borrowing on security by way of Chattels Transfers was reduced by £223,216, the total amount borrowed being £5,909,871. A total of 19,861 instruments and 707 satisfactions were registered.

TRADE MARKS AND PATENTS REGISTRY

There was a marked decrease in the number of initial trade mark applications, the fall in number being approximately 22 per cent in comparison with the previous year's figure whilst there was a general increase in related matters. There was a slight increase in the number of patent registrations during the year, the percentage increase over that of the previous year being approximately 7 per cent.

An application which was the subject of opposition proceedings in the previous year reached the hearing stage and was formally argued before the Registrar. No appeal was lodged against the decision.

Trade Marks

Statistics relating to the general work of the Trade Marks and Patents Registry with comparative figures for the last ten years are shown in Appendix VI. Statistics of applications and registrations still reveal the same interest in the classification of goods which relate to the patent medicine and chemical trades.

Applications from Kenya Nationals continue to show the same interest, generally in the manufacture of food, cosmetics, insecticides, scouring powders and clothing. The number of live trade marks on the register as at 31st December, 1972 was 14,300.

Patents

There is as yet no machinery for the original registration of patents in Kenya, the law providing only for registration of patents previously granted in the United Kingdom. This registration has the effect of extending the patentee's right to the patent in Kenya.

In respect of these patents, 131 were registered during the year making a total of 2,248 patents on the register as at 31st December, 1972; of 131 registrations during the year 2 patents were filed by Kenya residents. The number of live patents subsisting on that date was 1,532.

BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES SECTION

This section carries out the work connected with the Registrar-General duties as Registrar-General of Births, Deaths and Marriages under the Births and Deaths Registration Act, the Legitimacy Act, the Adoption Act, the Marriage Act and the African Christian Marriage and Divorce Act.

Population

The population of Kenya was estimated at 12,067,000 on 1st July, 1972. This represented an increase of approximately 1,125,000 persons since the last national census of 1969, a gain of 10 per cent. The largest part of the increase is attributed to the excess of births over deaths, since net migration to Kenya is negligible.

It is estimated that about 90 per cent of the country's population lived in rural areas in mid 1972. Since the last census, in 1969, there has been a noticeable gain through rural/urban migration in each of the Republic's urban areas, thus following the pattern in all developing nations.

With the increased use of hospitals and maternity homes for delivery today, and the increased awareness of the public generally of the need to register births of their children, the registration rate of births in most areas improved during the year. This is due to more people in the rural areas reporting events which have occurred in their households than was the case some years ago. There still remain certain areas in the country, however, where registration of vital events falls far short of the expected figure.

Births

The overall number of births registered in 1972 was 338,339 (176,786 males and 161,553 females) whilst current births registered during the year amounted to 268,458 generating an average crude birth rate of approximately 23 per 1,000 population of the areas concerned. The number of births registered shows a significant increase over the previous year's figures, both overall (236,847) and in respect of current events (191,756).

Deaths

The total number of deaths registered was 49,104 (27,960 males and 21,144 females) showing an increase of 1,570 deaths over the comparative figure for 1971.

Infant Deaths

11,040 infant deaths were registered generating an average infant mortality rate of approximately 69 per cent in the districts concerned.

Deaths by Exact Place of Death

More than 41 per cent of deaths registered during the year occurred in hospitals and other related institutions compared with 40 per cent in 1971. The proportion was higher in Nairobi with more than 82 per cent taking place in such institutions.

Marriages

The number of marriages registered under the Marriage Act in 1972 within Kenya was 1,285 which was 224 more than in the previous year. 24 marriages which were solemnized outside Kenya in respect of Kenya citizens were also registered. Under the African Christian Marriage and Divorce Act, 31,173 marriages were celebrated giving a total registration during the year of 32,482 marriages, an increase of 13,574 over the figure for the previous year.

Late Registration of Births and Deaths

There were 69,881 births registered in 1972 after the period of 6 months allowed for registration in the normal way had expired. This shows an increase of approximately 55 per cent over the comparative figures for 1971. There were 2,220 late registrations of deaths, compared with 209 during the previous year.

General

The general picture shows a considerable increase in the number of events registered. This is due to the fact that this includes figures for the first full year since compulsory registration was introduced for the whole country on 1st September, 1971. Of particular interest, however, is that some districts are now able to claim to register over 40 births per 1,000 population, which indicates an estimated percentage completeness of birth registration in excess of 80 per cent of the expected number.

Caution

Characteristics peculiar to certain areas such as proximity to municipal and urban hospitals or institutions affect the vital statistics of these areas as residents from outside the areas use the facilities without giving a correct indication of their normal residence.

The accuracy of the tables depends primarily on the registration of all births and deaths. This situation has not been achieved especially in the more remote areas of the country where communication with the general public is difficult. Whilst failure to register births is not now so common, a considerable number of deaths are not being registered.

Many factors, therefore, must be considered for the correct interpretation of vital statistics and it must be clearly stated that anything which affects the denominator or numerator of the births, deaths and marriages statistics described in the following appendices will necessarily affect the rates resulting from the computation. Limiting factors to be kept in mind when interpreting the data are as follows:—

- (a) Errors in residence determining which affect the count of births and deaths allocated to the district as a whole.
- (b) Under-registration which results in under-counts of events.
- (c) Errors in population estimation and enumeration which affect any rate requiring a population base for computation.
- (d) The efficiency of the cause of death coding and the clarity and accuracy of cause of death certification by laymen (deputy registrars) which affect the counts for deaths allocated to specific causes of deaths.

Great care, therefore, should be taken in comparing a change in the rate where the frequency of the event is small. A change in one or two events may result in a large percentage in the relative statistics. Any Index should be evaluated on the basis of quality, validity and size of both the denominator and numerator used to derive the rate or ratio.

PUBLIC TRUSTEE SECTION

This section carries out the administration of estates of deceased persons under the Public Trustee Act and the management of trusts accepted under such Act. In the majority of cases the Public Trustee undertakes the administration of those estates where the assets are unadministered either because there is no heir who is prepared or is available to apply for Letters of Administration or because the executor or administrator previously appointed has died or cannot be traced. In some cases the Public Trustee is specifically appointed to be an executor by a testator but in such cases the consent of the Public Trustee is required at the time of making the Will. The advantages of appointing the Public Trustee to be an executor, are, first, that there is guaranteed continuity of office by virtue of the Public Trustee's status as a corporation sole, and secondly, the fees charged by the Public Trustee for undertaking and completing the administration of estates are strictly regulated by statute and are not, therefore, subject to rapid change.

In addition, the Public Trustee undertakes the administration of trust estates. In many cases where a minor is entitled to a legacy or share of the assets of a deceased person and, not infrequently, where an award is made by a Court to a person not of full age, the executor or administrator, with the consent of the Public Trustee or the Court, as the case may be, transfers such legacy, share or award to the Public Trustee, who establishes a trust with it. This is administered by the Public Trustee until the whole trust fund is paid over to the former minor upon his or her attaining the age of majority.

The Public Trustee also administers trust estates which contain no provision for their maturing after the expiration of a stipulated period and for the trust funds then being paid over to the particular beneficiaries. Common examples of such trusts are those which are set up for the purposes such as the furtherance of education, charity, recreation, etc. The duration of such trusts is by their nature frequently extremely lengthy. In such cases the fact that the Public Trustee is a corporation sole is particularly useful as the trust funds vest in the holder of the office and not individual trustees. Consequently, the delay and expense involved in the transfer of funds from individual trustees to their successors in office are obviated.

The Public Trustee is also from time to time appointed manager of the estates of persons of unsound mind under the Mental Treatment Act, and is required to make an annual report on accounts submitted by other managers during the course of each year.

There was once again an increase in the work of the Public Trustee Section. One thousand, three hundred and forty-five new estates were accepted for administration and one thousand, one hundred and eighteen were wound up and distributed. In the case of trusts there was also an increase of a figure of twenty-nine new trusts which were accepted during the year but it was only possible to discharge six of those already under administration. The administration causes still actively in hand, therefore, increased by a figure of two hundred and thirty-six causes to a total of one thousand, six hundred and eighteen estates whilst in the case of trusts the number under administration at the end of the year was, at two hundred and seventy-seven, an additional figure of twenty-three over that which obtained at the end of the previous year. The steady increase in current work reflects changing social conditions, particularly, the continued toll of lives in motor-car accidents which results in payments of large sums by insurance companies by way of compensation, and also the increased use of life insurance by individuals and payment of death grants or gratuities by employers, all of which result in comparatively large sums of money coming into what would otherwise have been very small estates.

BANKRUPTCY, COMPANIES LIQUIDATION AND DEEDS OF ARRANGEMENT

During the year there were three winding-up orders—all being made in the High Court at Nairobi. The Official Receiver was confirmed as liquidator in six cases, five of which related to proceedings instituted in the previous years.

The three companies against which winding-up orders were made comprised dealers in cameras, films etc., insurance business and building contractors respectively.

Deeds of Arrangements

No Deed of Arrangement was registered during the year.

BANKRUPTCY CONTINGENCY FUND AND COMPANIES CONTINGENCY FUND

The Income and Expenditure Accounts for these funds for the year 1972 and the Balance Sheets as at 31st December, 1972, are set out in Appendices XXX, XXXV and XXXI, XXXVI respectively.

INSURANCE COMPANIES, BUILDING SOCIETIES AND HIRE-PURCHASE SECTION

Insurance Companies

In the year 1972, 4 companies ceased to carry on business or merged with others and one company was put into liquidation. No new company commenced business and this reduced the number of licensed companies to carry on insurance to 51, thus continuing the downward trend of the last few years.

Statistics showing the countries of origin of insurers and classes of insurance business which they conduct may be found in Appendix XXXVII and Appendix XXXVIII gives a breakdown of the main features of insurance business during the years 1968 to 1972.

Building Societies

One new Building Society, "the United Kenya Building Society", was registered during the year but did not commence business.

Statistics relating to the East African Building Society are set out in Appendix XXXIX.

Hire-Purchase

At the 31st December, 1972, 77 businesses were licensed to conduct hire-purchase business. The fall in the number of licences issued and also the number of agreements registered during 1972 was no doubt due to the effect of the credit squeeze which restricted the out-flow of foreign exchange.

By 31st December, 1972, 41,577 agreements had been registered. A sum of Sh. 335,614 was collected during the year in respect of fees payable on registration and also on late registration in cases where agreements had been lodged for registration after the statutory period of 30 days from their execution had expired.

It is estimated that at 31st December, 1972, the level of hire-purchase debt outstanding was about £3,745,000.

The provisions of the Hire-Purchase Act, (Cap. 507) are limited to agreements under which the hire-purchase price does not exceed K.Sh. 80,000. The Act also does not apply in cases where the hirer is a body corporate.

ESTATE DUTY SECTION

As in previous years this section has had during the year to deal with assessments under two classes; those on estates which passed before the suspension in 1969 of the application of the former Estate Duty Ordinance and which have not been finalized, and those on estates which have passed since 12th June, 1963, when the Estate Duty Act reintroduced Estate Duty. The data given in Appendix XLI has been so arranged as to indicate under which of the two statutes assessments have been raised.

During the year 511 assessments were raised under the Act and the duty assessed amounted to £293,137. Four assessments were raised under the Ordinance but these estates being below the exemption limit, no duty was raised.

Of the total number of estates passing and assessed under the Act, no liability arose in 144 estates i.e. 28 per cent, as the net value in each case did not exceed £5,000 or £1,000 according to whether the deceased died prior to or after 15th June, 1967. Of the remaining 367 estates (comprising 72 per cent) 271 estates attracted duty varying from one to 24 per cent and 96 estates attracted duty at the fixed rates provided for under the Finance Act No. 20 of 1967.

Corrective Accounts were received in 158 estates. Of these in 120 estates additional assets were brought to account while in 38 estates a refund was claimed.

All the 120 Corrective Accounts mentioned above were subject to the provisions of the Act, and attracted additional duty to the value of £29,572.

All the 38 estates in which a refund was claimed were subject to the provisions of the Act and duty amounting to £15,464 was refunded in 33 estates.

Of the remaining Corrective Accounts, in five estates reduced duty amounting to £4,550 was assessed.

In two estates duty amounting to £4,514 was remitted with the approval of the Treasury. The net amount of duty collected during this year amounted to £370,689.

TRADE UNIONS SECTION

There were 53 unions on the register at the end of the year, comprising 38 employees' and 15 employers' unions. A breakdown of these unions consisted of employees', 38 with mixed membership; employers—all 15 unions with mixed membership.

During the year three new trade unions were registered, namely, the University Academic Staff Union, the Kenya Management Staff Association and the East African Pilots' Association, whilst the number of branches registered was 6.

The dissolution of three trade union branches was registered during the year.

Applications for registration from the following three trade unions were refused—Kenya Institutional Workers' Union, Kenya Body Builders Workers' Union and Kenya Jaggeries Workers' Union. These Unions were refused registration on the grounds that there were trade unions already registered which sufficiently represented the whole or a substantial proportion of the interests in respect of which the applicants sought registration.

Amendments to rules of 12 trade unions were registered.

Approval was given to 29 union officials to act in full-time capacity during the year, and approval was withdrawn in one case and one application for approval was refused.

The secretaries of two trade unions were prosecuted for failing to submit their union's annual returns for 1971 and each of these prosecutions resulted in conviction with fines being imposed.

Two notices of change of name or titles of officers of a trade union submitted for registration were referred to the Trade Unions Tribunal on the grounds that the Registrar was not satisfied as to the validity or propriety of the purported appointments and appropriate directions were given to the Registrar.

During the course of the year officers of the trade unions section carried out inspection of 51 sets of trade union books of account, comprising accounts of 20 head offices and 31 branches. In addition to inspections carried out in Nairobi, inspections were also carried out in Kiambu, Limuru, Uplands and Embu.

Details of book and voting membership of the trade on the register, with particulars of their income and expenditure as shown by the Annual Returns, are set out in Appendices XLII and XLIII hereto. The totals of the book and voting members of employees' trade unions were 293,133 and 293,113 respectively, whilst the employers' trade unions had a total of 3,629 book members and 3,629 voting members respectively.

SOCIETIES, BOOKS AND NEWSPAPERS SECTION

Societies

At the end of the year there were 3,314 registered societies and 1,417 societies which were exempted from registration.

New registrations effected during the year totalled 320 and 10 societies were granted exemption from registration in the same period. This compared with 252 registrations and 19 exemptions during 1971.

A total of 117 societies were refused registration and registrations of 129 societies were cancelled under section 12 of the Societies Act, mainly for failing to comply with orders served under the Act. This latter figure includes two societies which were declared by the Minister to be societies dangerous to the good Government of the Republic of Kenya. Six societies successfully appealed against cancellation of registration. A further 247 societies had their registrations cancelled under section 14 of the Act, as having ceased to exist. Three other societies exempted from registration, had their exemptions rescinded under section 14 of the Act (having ceased to exist).

Books and Newspapers

The number of newspapers registered as at 31st December, 1972 was 66, an increase of 7 over the previous year. During the year 9 new registrations were effected and 2 filed Notice of Cessation of publication.

There were 1,691 books registered at 31st December, 1972, representing an increase of 181 over the previous year. Of the titles registered 25 per cent were of a religious nature, 15 per cent were educational and the remainder ranged from commercial publications to fiction. 112 were printed in English, 38 in Kiswahili, 5 in French, 1 in German, 19 in vernacular languages and 6 in two or more languages.

COLLEGE OF ARMS

Seventeen applications were received during the year under the College of Arms Act. Of these seven sought the Grant of Arms to local government bodies; three to educational establishments; two to Anglican dioceses and one to a social organization.

During the year six applications were approved and three grants completed and handed over to the applicants.

Once again I must acknowledge the assistance readily given to the College throughout the year by local heraldic experts.

ACCOUNTS SECTION

Fees collected by the Department in respect of various services rendered to the public totalled £140,648 for the year 1972 as compared with £137,492 for the previous year—an increase of £3,156. A total sum of £355,297 was collected in respect of Estate Duty, an increase of £8,123 on the total for the year 1971, but a sum of £15,465 was paid out by way of duty refunded or remitted. The total expenditure of the Department on personal emoluments and other charges was £123,750.

ESTABLISHMENT

The establishment of professional, executive and clerical staff had again to be increased by 15 in order to enable the compulsory registration scheme for births and deaths to be extended and to cater for the overall increase of Department work during the year.

Messrs. J. K. Muchae and J. P. N. Simba, who had been admitted as advocates after receiving their legal education at the Kenya School of Law, joined the professional staff of the Department as Legal Assistants on 1st April, 1972.

The Department lost the valuable services of its Adviser on Accounts on 13th July, 1972, when Mr. C. H. Webb was appointed as Chief Accountant of the Maize and Produce Board.

Mr. V. N. Bastodkar, who had previously held the appointment of Bankruptcy Investigating Accountant was promoted to the resulting vacancy on 13th December, 1972.
