

Sessional Paper No. 1 of 1965/66  
Amendments to the Standing Orders of the  
House of Representatives, Kenya

(as proposed by the Sessional Committee on 11th November, 1965)

1. Standing Order No. 23.

That Standing Order 23 (Government Business) be amended -

By adding at the end of the second proviso thereto the words:-

"in such order of the Sessional Committee in consultation with Mr. Speaker may determine."

2. Standing Order No. 30.

That Standing Order 30 (Notices of Motions) be amended:-

(i) by deleting paragraph (4); and

(ii) by adding the following new paragraphs:-

(4) A Member giving notice of a Motion approved by Mr. Speaker shall state its terms to the House if such Member is a Minister or if the original copy received by the Clerk has been certified by an approved Party Leader or Chief Whip to be sponsored by his party.

(5) Notice of an approved Motion not complying with the provisions of paragraph (4) shall be given by means of a list to be published to Members in such a manner as Mr. Speaker may from time to time direct, and that Member giving such notice shall state its terms to the House only if and when the Motion has acquired precedence in accordance with the second Proviso to Standing Order 23 (but at least one day before the Motion appears on the Order Paper).

3. New Standing Order.

By adding a new standing Order as follows:-

Standing Order 168A - (Seating in the Chamber)

Seating in the Chamber

All seats in the front benches of the Chamber shall be reserved for the exclusive use of Ministers.
