Power transmission line to bring reliable supply to North Rift

West Pokot and Trans Nzoia residents will benefit from a reliable power supply with the operationalization of a new electricity transmission line from the Turkwel hydropower generation plant. Energy and Petroleum Cabinet Secretary (CS) Davis Chirchir said the future of the country is pegged on power generation that is environmentally sustainable.

Chirchir said the new Turkwel-Ortum-Kitale power transmission line will minimize power loss, noting that the North Rift region has for a long time been exposed to high power losses since power generated from the Turkwel plant goes to waste because of the



long distance. "It has been a pity since a lot of power being generated from the plant has to be evacuated to Lessos in Uasin Gishu County hundreds of miles away before being reverted back to the source for use.

"This line will enhance reliability of power and connectivity within the region and reduce power losses," the CS stated, while

delivering of a transformer with a power supply capacity of 220 megawatts at Ortum Sub Station.

The North Rift Region has been plagued by unstable power supply, the reason being the long distance in power transmission lines.

Chirchir argued that geothermal and hydroelectric power is environmentally friendly, hence good for the future generation.

The CS stated that the country could be experiencing a loss of about 22 per cent of power both transmission, commercial and technical losses, reiterating that with introduction of short and high-capacity routes, these kind of losses shall be a thing of the past.

He noted that the losses are generally met by the taxpayers.

- Improve the health of all Kenyans by ensuring a clean and healthy environment.

This is therefore to require all persons likely to be affected by the proposed Regulations to submit written comments so as to reach the undersigned not later than fourteen (14) days from the date of publication of this notice.

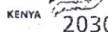
