ON THE AMENDMENTS TO THE STATUTE LAW (MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS) BILL (SENATE BILL NO. 6 OF 2014)

I wish to report to the Senate that, pursuant to Standing Order 40 (3) and (4), I have received the following Message from the Speaker of the National Assembly regarding the amendments, by the Assembly, to the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill (Senate Bill No. 6 of 2014).

“PURSUANT to the provisions of standing orders 41 and 144 of the National Assembly Standing Orders, I hereby convey the following Message from the National Assembly-

THAT WHEREAS, the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill (Senate Bill No. 6 of 2014), published *vide* the Kenya Gazette Supplement No. 19 of 3rd March, 2014 as a Bill originating in the Senate to effect minor amendments to various statutes, was referred to the National Assembly for consideration following its passage by the Senate on 20th August, 2014;

AND WHEREAS, the National Assembly passed the said Bill **with amendments** on 15th November, 2016;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of Article 110 (4) of the Constitution and Standing Order 144 of the National Assembly Standing Orders, I hereby refer the said Bill to the Senate for concurrence".

Honourable Senators,

Article 112 (1) (b) of the Constitution provides that *if one House passes an ordinary Bill concerning counties and the second House passes the Bill in an amended form, it shall be referred back to the originating House for reconsideration.*

Honourable Senators,

It is in this regard, and pursuant to standing order 150 of the Senate Standing Orders that I direct that the National Assembly amendments to the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill (Senate Bill No. 6 of 2014) be circulated to all Senators and the same be listed, for consideration, in the Order Paper for Thursday, 24th November, 2016.

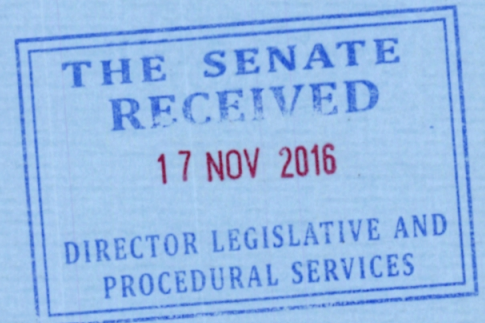

NATIONAL ASSEMBLY AMENDMENTS TO THE STATUTE LAW (MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS) BILL (SENATE BILL NO. 6 OF 2014)

The following amendments to the Statute Law Miscellaneous (Amendments) Bill (Senate Bill No. 6 of 2014) were considered and passed by the National Assembly on 15th November 2016:

Clause 2

(a) Provisions relating to the National Transport and Safety Authority Act

THAT, clause 2 of the Bill is amended in the schedule to the proposed amendments to the National Transport and Safety Authority Act by deleting—

- (a) paragraph (a) of the proposed amendment to section 4(1);
- (b) paragraph (a) of the proposed amendment to section 6(1); and
- (c) the proposed new section.

(b) Provisions relating to the National Authority for the Campaign Against Alcohol and Drug Abuse Act, No. 14 of 2012

THAT, the Bill is amended in clause 2 in the Schedule to the proposed amendments to the National Authority for the Campaign Against Alcohol and Drug Abuse Act, No. 14 of 2012—

- (a) in the proposed amendments to section 5—
 - (i) by deleting paragraph (b); and
 - (ii) by deleting paragraph (c).
- (b) by deleting the proposed amendments to section 6.

(c) Provisions relating to the Pyrethrum Act, No. 22 of 2013

THAT, clause 2 of the Bill is amended in the Schedule by deleting the proposed amendments to the Pyrethrum Act, No. 22 of 2013 and substituting therefor the following new amendments—

Section 6(2)

- (a) renumber paragraph (c) as paragraph (e) appearing immediately after paragraph (d);
- (b) delete the word “two” and substitute therefor the word “one” in subparagraph (i) of paragraph (e);
- (c) insert the following new sub paragraph immediately after subparagraph (i) in paragraph (e)—

“(ia) one person shall be nominated by the Council of Governors;”

Section 6(3)


Insert the following new subsections immediately after subsection (3)—

(3A) In nominating and appointing members under this section the nominating persons and bodies' shall uphold the principle of one-third gender representation.

(3B) Appointments to the Board shall take into account the national values referred to in Article 10 of the Constitution and the principle that the composition of the Board taken as a whole shall reflect the regional and ethnic diversity of the people of Kenya.
