**ON THE PASSAGE OF THE WAREHOUSE RECEIPTS SYSTEM BILL

I wish to report to the Senate that, pursuant to standing order 40 (3) and (5), I received the following Message from the Speaker of the National Assembly, on 6th September, 2016, regarding the passage, by the National Assembly, of the Warehouse Receipts System Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 12 of 2015)-

“PURSUANT to the provisions of standing orders 41 and 142 of the National Assembly Standing Orders, I hereby convey the following Message from the National Assembly-

WHEREAS, the Warehouse Receipts System Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 12 of 2015) was published *vide* the Kenya Gazette Supplement No. 34 of 27th March, 2015, as a Bill concerning County Governments in terms of Article 110 (1)(a) of the Constitution, seeking to provide a legal framework for the development and regulation of a warehouse receipt system for agricultural commodities to address marketing challenges associated with cereals and grain subsectors in Kenya;

WHEREAS, the National Assembly considered and **passed** the said Bill **with amendments** on Wednesday 31st August 2016;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of Article 110(4) of the Constitution and Standing Order 142 of the National Assembly Standing Orders, I hereby refer the said Bill to the Senate for consideration".


Hon. Senators,
