REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL FOR THE YEAR 1976

REVIEW OF THE YEAR

Again there has been a most unfortunate delay in presenting this Annual Report. As I explained in my Report for the previous year this has been occasioned by problems arising in the processing of data and in obtaining tabulations of vital statistics. Now that new data processing equipment has become available and with the introduction of shift working for the machine operators it is hoped that we shall soon be able to bring these reports up to date.

The chief points of interest connected with the multifarious activities of the Department are given in the succeeding paragraphs and at the end of the Report are set out appendices which give statistics covering the more important subjects and provide comparative figures over the last decade.

COMPANIES SECTION

The Section comprises the registries of Companies, Business Names, Limited Partnerships and Chattels Transfers.

Companies

One thousand one hundred and forty nine new companies were incorporated during the year 1976. The figure represents a 8.3 per cent increase over 1,061, the figure for 1975.

Of the 1,149 newly incorporated companies 76 were public companies, which in effect indicates a decrease of over 28.3 per cent over last year's figure of 108. Six public companies were struck off leaving a total of 726 public companies on the Register.

The balance of 1,061 of the newly incorporated companies represent private companies. There was an increase of 12.35 per cent in such new registrations. Two hundred and eighty one private companies were struck off the Register and 17 went into liquidation during the year, leaving a total of 11,131 such companies on the Register.

During the year 44 foreign companies were registered, an increase of only 3 over last year's figure. Eleven such companies were struck off. The number of foreign companies on the register stood at 906 at the end of the year.

The total amount of nominal capital with which the 1,149 new companies were registered was K£11,891,091 compared with K£10,766,423, an increase of approximately 10.44 per cent.

Total fines amounting to Sh. 63,723.75 were imposed on companies and their officers for failing to comply with the requirements of the Companies Act (Cap. 486), for instance, for failing to file annual returns, statutory reports, etc. Charges were brought against 38 companies and their officers. Twelve prosecutions were withdrawn.

BUSINESS NAMES

Business Names

Business names on the Register stood at 65,347 as at 31st December, 1976, New business names that were registered in the period was 3,523, a drop of 163 over last year's figure of 3,607 or 3.8 per cent decrease. Six hundred and ninety names were removed from the register and 90 firms changed their business names during the year.

REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS

In all except a few districts the Department has established its own registries of births and deaths but in Marsabit, Mandera, Wajir, Isiolo, Samburu, Turkana and Tana River registration continues to be carried out by the District Commissioner.

Population

The projected population for 1976 was 13,847,000. This represents an increase of approximately 2,904,000 persons since the last national census of 1969; again of about 26.5 per cent.

Births

The overall number of births registered in 1976 was 288,325 (153,376 males and 134,949 females) whilst total current births registered during the same year amounted to 265,523 generating an average crude birth rate of approximately 19 per 1,000 population.

The overall number of births registered shows an increase of 23,180 over the previous year (i.e. 265,145 to 288,325).

Deaths

The total number of deaths registered in 1976 was 51,172 (30,804 males and 20,368 females) showing an increase of 4,492 over the previous year.

About 46 per cent of the deaths registered during the year occurred in the hospitals and other related institutions. In Nairobi area 88 per cent death cases occurred in such institutions.

There were 1,248 late registered deaths compared with 1,037 effected during the previous year.

Infant Deaths

There were 15,119 infant deaths registered generating an average infant mortality rate of approximately 57 per 1,000 births registered.

Marriages

The number of marriages registered under Marriage Act in 1976 was 1,452. This shows an increase of 252 over the previous year.

Caution

Characteristics peculiar to certain areas such as proximity to Municipal and urban hospitals or institutions affect the vital statistics of these areas as residents from outside these areas use facilities without the current indication of their normal residence.

The accuracy of the tables depends primarily on the registration of all births and deaths. There are some problems that may not make it possible to attain accurate figures as in remote areas of the country where communication with the general public is difficult. Whilst failure to register birth is not common, it would appear that a considerable number of deaths are not registered.

In 1976 there was approximately 40 per cent coverage of births while deaths reflected a per cent coverage of about 25.4 per cent. This of course is the percentage of registered births as against the estimates for both births and deaths during that particular year.

Many factors therefore, must be considered for the correct interpretation of vital statistics and it must be clearly stated that anything which affects the denominator or numerator of births, deaths and marriages described in appendices will necessarily affect the rates resulting from the computation. Limiting factors to be kept in mind when interpreting the data are as follows—

- (a) Errors in determination of residence which affect the count of births and deaths allocated to the district as a whole.
- (b) Under-registration which results in under-counts of events.
- (c) Errors in population estimation and enumeration which affect any rate requiring a population base for computation.
- (d) The efficiency of the cause of death coding and the clarity and accuracy of cause of death certification by laymen (deputy registrars) which affect the counts for deaths allocated to specific causes of deaths.

Great care, therefore should be taken in comparing a change in the rate where the frequency of event is small. A change in one or two events may result in large percentage in the relative statistics.

Any index should be evaluated on the basis of quality, validity and size of both the denominator used to derive the rate of ratio.

A further caution is given in connection with Appendices XVI and XVII. Deaths are reported either (1) on form A2 where a medical practitioner certifies the death and gives a medical cause of death which is coded in accordance with the International Statistical Classification or (2) on form A3 where no medical practitioner certifies the death.

In this case the cause of death is determined by a description of the fatal symptoms (or syndromes).

CHATELS TRANSFER

Chattels Transfer were utilized as security for borrowing a total of K£9,082,569 and decreased by K£1,753,747 over last year's total of K£10,836,316. A total of 12,200 instruments were registered.

TRADE MARKS AND PATENTS REGISTRIES

There was a marked increase in the number of initial trade mark applications and related matters, the percentage increase over the previous year being 34 per cent. There was also an increase in the number of Patent registrations during the year, the percentage increase compared to the previous year being 8 per cent.

Five applications which were subject to opposition proceedings reached the hearing stage and were formally argued before the Registrar. There was no hearing under Rule 32.

Patents

There is as yet no machinery for the original registration of patents in Kenya, the law providing only for re-registration of patents previously granted in the United Kingdom. This registration has the effect of extending the Patentee's rights to the patent to Kenya. In respect of these patents, 98 patents were registered during the year making a total at 31st December, 1976 of 2,687 which have been registered in Kenya. The number of live patents on the Register at the same date was 1,312.

Trade Marks

Statistics relating to the general work of the Trade Marks and Patents Registry, with comparative figures for the last decade are shown in Appendix V. Statistics of applications and registration still reveal the same lively interest in the classification of goods which relate to the patent medicine, cosmetics, domestic cleaning preparations and the clothing industries and the manufacture of food. The number of live trade marks on the register as at 31st December, 1976 was 15,256.

PUBLIC TRUSTEE SECTION

This section carries out the administration of estates of deceased persons under the Public Trustee Act and the management of trusts accepted under such Act. In the majority of cases the Public Trustee undertakes the administration of those estates where the assets are unadministered either because there is no heir who is prepared or is available to apply for letters of Administration or because the executor or administrator previously appointed has died or cannot be traced. In some cases the Public Trustee is specifically appointed to be an executor by a testator but in such cases the consent of the Public Trustee is required at the time of making the Will. The advantages of appointing the Public Trustee to be an executor, are, first, that there is guaranteed continuity of office by virtue of the Public Trustee's status as a corporation sole, and secondly, the fees charged by the Public Trustee for undertaking and completing the administration of estates are strictly regulated by statute and are not therefore, subject to rapid change.

In addition, the Public Trustee undertakes the administration of trusts. In many cases where a minor is entitled to a legacy or share of the assets of a deceased person and, not infrequently, where an award is made by Court to a person not of full age, the executor or administrator, with the consent of the Public Trustee or the Court, as the case may be, transfers such legacy, share or award to the Public Trustee, who establishes a trust with it. This is administered by the Public Trustee until the whole trust fund is paid over to the former minor upon his or her attaining the age of majority.

The Public Trustee also administers trusts which contain no provision for their maturing after the expiration of a stipulated period and for the trust funds then being paid over to the particular beneficiaries. Common examples of such trusts are those which are set up for purposes such as the furtherance of education, charity, recreation, etc. The duration of such trusts is by their nature frequently extremely lengthy. In such cases the fact that the Public Trustee is a corporation sole is particularly useful as the trust funds vest in the holder of the office and not individual trustees. Consequently, the delay and expense involved in the transfer of funds from individual trustees to their successors in office is obviated.

The Public Trustee is also from time to time appointed manager of the estates of persons of unsound mind under the Mental Treatment Act, and is required to make an annual report of accounts submitted by other managers during the course of each year.

During the year two thousand and eighty one new estates were accepted for administration and one thousand three hundred and sixty nine estates were wound up and distributed. In the case of trusts thirty-seven new trusts were accepted during 1976 and an equal number of those already under administration were finalized and discharged. The administration causes still actively in hand increased by seven hundred and twelve causes over the total under administration at the end of the previous year, bringing the total to 4,064 as at 31st December, 1976, whilst in the case of trusts the number under administration at the end of the year was two hundred and forty six.

BANKRUPTCY, COMPANIES LIQUIDATION AND DEEDS OF ARRANGEMENTS

Bankruptcy

During the year 12 receiving orders were made, six at Nairobi, four at Mombasa and two at Kisumu. This shows an increase of four causes over the previous year. The total amount of deficiency, as estimated by debtors is K£76,291. Of the thirteen debtors concerned seven were Asians and five were Africans. The classification of their respective occupations is shown at appendix XXVIII.

The assets realised during the year from debtors' estates and debtors' contributions amounted to K£11,280. The sum distributed in dividends to ordinary creditors amounted to K£15,405. Thirteen discharge applications were made during the year. Four were granted unconditionally and the rest were granted subject to suspension for various periods.

Companies Liquidation

During the year 8 winding up orders were made in Nairobi, of which one was an interim-order. The Official Receiver was confirmed as Liquidator in 4 cases.

The 8 companies against whom the winding up orders were made comprised of:— 3 Property investors, 2 wholesale and retail merchants, 1 cab operators, 1 hotel and catering business, 1 publishers and distributors of books.

Bankruptcy and Companies Contingency Funds

The Income and Expenditure Accounts for these funds for the year 1976 and the Balance Sheets as at 31st December, 1976 are set out in appendices XXIX and XXXII respectively.

Deeds of Arrangement

No Deed of Arrangement was registered during the year.

INSURANCE COMPANIES

BUILDING SOCIETIES AND HIRE PURCHASE SECTION

Insurance Companies

In the year 1976 six companies ceased to transact business. Two new companies commenced business thus the number of licenced companies was reduced from 49 of the previous year to 45, to continue the downward trend of previous years.

Statistics showing countries of origin of insurers and classes of insurance business which they conduct may be found in appendix XXXVII and appendix XXXVIII gives a breakdown of the main features of insurance business during the years 1972 to 1976.

Building Societies

The United Kenya Building Societies registered in 1972 has not yet commenced business. Kiambere Building Societi has been registered during the year. Business transacted by the East African Building Society can be seen in appendix XXXIX.

Hire Purchase

At 31st December, 1976, 44 businesses were licensed to conduct Hire-Purchase business. The main reason for the decline in licences issued over last year's comparative figure of 50 is the continued rise in prices of goods which forced several companies to cease financing Hire-Purchase.

By the 31st December, 1976 29,054 agreements had been registered. An amount of K.Sh. 222,565.00 was collected in respect of registration fees and late registration fees where agreements were lodged after the statutory period of 30 days from their execution had expired. Details are shown in the table annexed as appendix XXXVI.

According to the registers of Hire-Purchase agreements, it is estimated that at 31st December, 1976, the level of Hire-Purchase debt outstanding was approximately 3.1 million.

ESTATE DUTY SECTION

As in previous years this Section has had during the year to deal with assessments under two classes; those on estates which passed before the suspension of the application of the former Estate Duty Ordinance in 1959 and which have not been finalised, and those on estates which have passed since 12th June, 1963 when the Estate Duty Act was reintroduced. The date given in Appendix XXXVII has been so arranged as to indicate under which of the two statutes assessments have been raised.

During the year 730 assessments were raised under the Act and the duty assessed amounted to K£464,571. Twenty three assessments were raised under the Ordinance and the duty passed amounted to K£281.

Of the total number of estates passing and assessed under the Act, no liability arose in 335 estates i.e. 45 per cent, as the net value in each case did not exceed K£5,000, K£1,000 or K£2,500 according to whether the deceased died prior to or after 15th June, 1967; or whether the deceased died after 16th June, 1972 respectively. Of the remaining 395 estates (comprising 55 per cent) 363 estates attracted duty varying from one to 24 per cent, and 32 estates attracted duty at the fixed rates provided for under the Finance Act No. 20 of 1967.

Corrective Accounts were received in 186 estates. Of these in 136 additional assets were brought to account while in 50 estates a refund was claimed.

Of the Corrective Accounts mentioned above 183 were subject to the provisions of the Act and three to the provisions of the Ordinance. Of those filed under the Act no payment of duty was involved in ten accounts. The remaining accounts attracted additional duty to the value of K£43,174 and K£1,898 respectively.

All the 50 estates in which a refund was claimed were subject to the provisions of the Act and duty amounting to K£18,491 was refunded in 40 estates.

In seven remaining Corrective Accounts reduced duty amounting to K£3,808 was assessed, while in three Estates there was duty reduced by remission of K£32,267.

The net amount of duty collected during this year amounted to K£473,410.

TRADE UNIONS SECTION

There were 56 unions on the register at the end of the year, comprising 41 employee's and 15 employers' unions. A breakdown of these unions consisted of:—Employees—41 with mixed membership. Employers'—all 15 unions with mixed membership.

2. During the year no new trade unions were registered but the number of branches registered was nine. Whilst no trade union was dissolved during the year, the dissolution of two trade union branches was registered.

3. Application for registration from one trade union was refused—Kenya Insurance Agents Union. This union was refused registration on the grounds that there were other trade unions already registered which sufficiently represented the whole or a substantial proportion of the interests in respect of which the applicants sought registration. Applications for registration from the following four trade unions received during the year were still pending at the end of the year—Kenya Bakers and Confectioners Workers' Union, Village Polytechnic Workers' Union, University Workers Union (Kenya) and Kenya Union of Employees of Associations. Trade Unions and Allied Workers.

4. Amendments to rules of 17 trade unions were registered.

5. Approval was given to 5 union officials to act in a full-time capacity during the year and approval was withdrawn in two cases.

6. One employees' trade union registered a change of name, Union of Scientific, Research, Technical and General Employees (Kenya) becoming Union of Scientific Research, Technical and Allied Employees (Kenya).

7. During the year officers of the trade unions section carried out inspections of 307 sets of trade union books of account, comprising the accounts of 45 head offices and 262 branches. In addition to inspections carried out in Nairobi and its environs, inspections were also carried out in Thika, Murang'a, Embu, Meru, Nanyuki, Nyeri, Nyahururu, Mombasa, Malindi, Voi, Kilifi, Taita, Lamu, Nakuru, Eldoret, Kitale, Bungoma and Kakamega.

8. Details of book and voting membership of the trade unions on the register with particulars of their income and expenditure as shown by their Annual Returns are set out in Appendices XXXVIII and XXXIX hereto. The totals of the book and voting members of employers' trade unions were 3,591 and 3,575 respectively, whilst both book and voting members of employees' trade unions totalled 39, 1976.

SOCIETIES, BOOKS AND NEWSPAPERS SECTION

Societies

There were 4,569 societies registered and 1,065 exempted from registration as at 31st December, 1976. During the year 586 societies were registered and 11 societies were exempted from registration, 3 of which had previously been registered. This compared with 271 registrations and 20 exemptions effected in the previous year.

The breakdown of the registered societies as at 31st December, 1976 is 1,708 Welfare, 108 Professional, 335 Sports clubs, 537 political (KANU), 192 proprietary night clubs and 301 social clubs (members clubs). Of these 301 welfare, 19 professional, 77 sports clubs, 79 tribal and clan welfare, 71 religious, 21 proprietary, clubs, 1 political and 17 social clubs were registered in 1976.

A total of 127 societies were refused registration and registration of 72 societies was cancelled mainly for failing to comply with orders served under the Act and for failing to submit annual returns. 48 societies successfully appealed against cancellation of their registrations. 2 other societies exempted from registration had their exemptions rescinded on the grounds that they had ceased to exist.

Books and Newspapers

The number of newspapers registered as at 31st December, 1976 was 79, an increase of 7 over the previous year. During the year, 9 new registrations were effected and 2 newspapers filed notice of cessation of publication.

There were 2,555 books registered as at 31st December, 1976. This represented an increase of 117 over 1975 of which 39 per cent were educational, 36 per cent religious and 25 per cent ranged from commercial to fiction. 155 books were printed in English, 45 in Swahili, 2 in French, 1 in German, 2 in Gujarat, 7 in four vernacular language, i.e. Kikamba, Kikuyu, Luhya and Luo.

THE COLLEGE OF ARMS

With the establishment of new local government bodies there was a large increase in the number of applications for grants of arms. During the year 12 such Grants were approved, prepared and handed over: of these two were for Anglican dioceses, one for a trade union, one for a college, one for a public corporation and the rest for local government councils.

ACCOUNTS SECTION

Fees collected by the Department in respect of various services rendered to the public totalled K£174,661 for the year ended 31st December, 1976 as compared with K£147,006 for the previous year. A total of K£487,782 was collected in respect of Estate Duty as compared with K£680,230 for the previous year resulting in a decrease of K£192,448. The total expenditure of the Department on personal emoluments and other charges amounted to K£239,550, a slight reduction from the previous year's figure of K£242,093.
