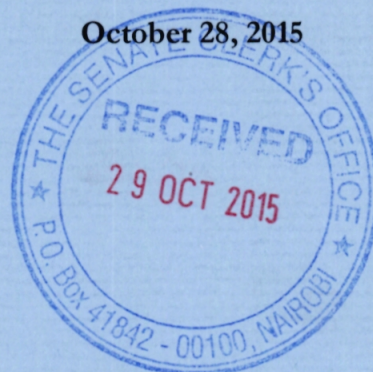


**RE: APPROVAL OF THE CONSTITUTION OF KENYA (AMENDMENT)
(NO.2) BILL, 2013 (NATIONAL ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 26 OF 2013)**

PURSUANT to the provisions of Standing Orders 41 and 142 of the National Assembly Standing Orders, I hereby convey the following Message from the National Assembly –

WHEREAS, the Constitution of Kenya (Amendment) (No. 2) Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 26 of 2013) was published *vide* Kenya Gazette Supplement No. 115 of August 6, 2013 as a Bill to amend Article 204 of the Constitution regarding disbursement of Equalisation Fund;

AND WHEREAS, the National Assembly, in accordance with the provisions of Article 256 of the Constitution, considered and passed the said Bill on Wednesday, October 1, 2015 in the form attached hereto;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with Articles 110(4) and 256 of the Constitution and the provisions of Standing Order 142 of the National Assembly Standing Orders, I hereby forward the said Bill to the Senate for consideration.
