
Following the Message dated 2nd August, 2018, the Speaker of the Senate directed that the matter be considered by the Standing Committee on Labour and Social Welfare. The matter was therefore considered by the Standing Committee on Labour and Social Welfare of the Senate.

Section 8 of the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approval) Act, 2011 provides that the relevant Committee should table its Report for consideration within fourteen (14) days from the date when the notification of nomination is conveyed to the House. The Committee's Report contains observations, findings and recommendation by the committee on the nominees.

The Committee conducted the vetting process for approval of the nominee with reference to the Constitution of Kenya 2010, Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approvals) Act, CAP 136 and Leadership and Integrity Act and other relevant provisions of the law.

On behalf of the committee, I wish to thank the Offices of the Speakers and the Clerks of Parliament for the support extended to it in the execution of its mandate.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Parliamentary Service Commission is established under Article 127 of the Constitution of Kenya to provide service and facilities to ensure the efficient and effective functioning of Parliament among other functions. The Constitution under Article 127 (2) and (3) provided that the Parliamentary Service Commission shall consist of the Speaker of the National Assembly as the Chairperson, Seven Members appointed by Parliament from among its members, and one man and one woman appointed by Parliament from among persons who are experienced in public affairs but are not members of Parliament.

The Position of the male non-member of Parliament Commissioner fell vacant following the resignation of Hon. (Dr. Abdullahi Ibrahim Ali, with effect from 7th February, 2017 for purpose of contesting for an elective position in the General election that took place on 8th August, 2017.

The Parliamentary Service Commission advertised for the position, shortlisted and conducted interviews on the shortlisted persons. On 20th July, 2018, at its special Meeting, the Commission considered and adopted the report of the interview and resolved that the name of Mr. Samuel Chepkong'a be submitted to Parliament for appointment in accordance with Article 127 (2)(d) of the Constitution. The National Assembly, through a resolution passed on Wednesday, 1st August appointed Hon. Samuel Kiprono Chepkong'a as a Member of the Parliamentary Service Commission. The Speaker of the Senate upon, receiving the message from the Speaker of the National Assembly directed that the Standing Committee on Labour and Social Welfare of the Senate considers the matter and report back to the House.

The Committee held a preliminary sitting on Wednesday, 6th August, 2016 to consider the message from the Speaker of the Senate and resolved to invite the nominee Hon. Chepkonga to a meeting on Thursday, 16th August, 2018 at 10.00 am.

The Committee complied with the Constitutional and legal requirements and established procedures for vetting. It ensured public participation and openness in carrying out the proceedings. Notifications inviting the public to submit memoranda were placed in the mainstream print media on Friday, 10th August, 2018, in tandem with the law.

The Committee conducted the approval hearing exercise on 16th August, 2018 and in conducting the exercise, the Committee relied on the provisions of the Constitution, the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approval) Act No. 33 of 2011) and the Standing Orders of the Senate.

The Committee thanks the Offices of the Speaker and the Clerk of the Senate for the logistical support accorded to it during the vetting exercise. The Committee is also grateful to the media coverage of the proceedings of the Committee, thus enhancing accountability and transparency of the vetting exercise.

On behalf of the Committee, and pursuant to Article 245(2) (a) of the Constitution, Section 8(1) of the Schedule to the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approval) Act No. 33 of 2011, it is my pleasant duty to table the Report of the Standing Committee on Labour and Social Welfare, on the approval hearing of the nomination of Hon. Samuel Kiprono Chepkong'a as a member to the Parliamentary Service Commission.

MANDATE OF THE COMMITTEE

The Senate Standing Committee on Labour and Social Welfare is established under standing order 212(3) of the Standing Orders of the Senate and is mandated to “*Consider all matters relating to manpower and human resources planning, pension, gender, culture and social welfare, youth, National Youth Service, children’s welfare; national heritage, betting, lotteries and sports, public entertainment, public amenities and recreation*”.

The Speaker of the Senate directed that the matter shall be considered by the Committee mandated to deal with matters manpower and human resources planning. The approval hearing process was therefore conducted by the Standing Committee on Labour and Social Welfare of the Senate.

Section 8 of the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approval) Act, 2011 provides that the relevant Committee should table its Report for consideration within fourteen (14) days from the date when the notification of nomination is conveyed to the House. The Committee’s Report contains observations, findings and recommendation by the committee on the nominee.

1.0 INTRODUCTION

The Senate Standing Committee on Labour and Social Welfare is established under standing order 212 of the Senate Standing Orders.

The Committee was mandated to consider for approval by Parliament, appointment of the Parliamentary Service Commission Nominee. The Procedure for Appointment of Non-Member of the Commission requires the Parliamentary Service Commission to submit the name of the person recommended to Parliament for approval.

The approval hearing process is guided by the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approval) Act; 2011. Section 10 of the Act provides that;

‘Where the nomination of a candidate is rejected by Parliament, the appointing authority may submit to the relevant House the name of another candidate, and the procedure for approval specified in this Act shall apply accordingly’.

Section 7 of the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approval) Act, 2011 provides that the issues for consideration by the relevant House in relation to any nomination shall be:-

- (a) The procedure used to arrive at the nominee;
- (b) Any constitutional or statutory requirements relating to the office in question; and
- (c) The suitability of the nominee for appointment proposed having regard to whether the nominee’s abilities, experience and qualities meet the needs of the body to which nomination is being made.

Pursuant to Section 6(9) of the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approval) Act, 2011, the Committee, through the Clerk of the Senate, invited submissions from the public on the suitability or otherwise of the nominee for appointment to the Parliamentary Service Commission members.

Further, section 6(10) of the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approval) Act, 2011 provides that a candidate may at any time, by notice in writing addressed to the Clerk withdraw from the approval process and his nomination shall thereupon lapse.

The Senate Committee on Labour and Social Welfare held a sitting for approval hearing of Hon. Chepkong'a on Thursday 16 August, 2018.

In view of the foregoing and in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution, the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approvals) Act and the Standing Orders of the Senate, the Committee resolved to proceed to undertake the approval hearing as required and scheduled.

2.0 APPROVAL HEARING

In conducting the approval process, the Committee on Labour and Social Welfare of the Senate examined the nominee against the following criteria, amongst others, in accordance with the Public Appointments (Parliament Approval) Act No.33 of 2011.

- (i) Academic qualifications
- (ii) Employment record
- (iii) Professional affiliations
- (iv) Potential conflict of interest
- (v) Knowledge of the relevant subject
- (vi) Overall suitability for the position
- (vii) Tax compliance
- (viii) Integrity and morality
- (ix) Vision and leadership
- (x) Expectations and key priorities

The Nominee, Hon. Samuel Kiprono Chepkong'a appeared before the Committee on Thursday, 16th August, 2018 and was informed by the Chairperson that, pursuant to

Section 6 (9) of the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approvals) Act, 2011, the Committee had invited submissions from the public on their suitability or otherwise for appointment to the Parliamentary Service Commission and by the deadline date of 16th August, 2018, the Clerk of the Senate had received no objections.

The Chairperson also informed the Hon. Chepkong'a that in view of the foregoing and in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution, the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approvals) Act and the Standing Orders of the Senate, the Committee had resolved to proceed to undertake the approval hearing as required.

Hon. Chepkong'a was orally interviewed by the Committee and responded to questions during the hearing as follows:-

SUBMISSION OF MEMORANDA

The Committee did not receive any memoranda against Hon. Chepkong'a's suitability to serve as a member of the Parliamentary Service Commission.

PETITIONS

No petitions were received rejecting the nomination of Hon. Chepkong'a to the Parliamentary Service Commission.

CLEARANCE REQUIREMENTS

On 13th August, 2018, the Clerk of the Senate wrote to the Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission, Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA) and the Higher Education Loans Board (HELB) requesting for reports with respect to the nominee on-

- matters touching on integrity;
- tax compliance; and
- Loan repayments.

In response, Kenya Revenue Authority confirmed vide a letter referenced KRA/CDT/HO/81 dated 28th August, 2018 that the nominee was tax compliant.

The Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission vide a letter Referenced EACC.7/10/5 VOL.VIII (10) dated 29th August, 2018 confirmed that they have no outstanding issues or ongoing investigations against the nominee.

The Criminal Investigations Department (CID) confirmed vide a letter referenced DCI/CRO/SEC/6/7/2/A/VOL.VI/145 dated 20th August, 2018 that Hon. Samuel Kiprono Chepkong'a was genuinely issued with a police clearance certificate on 3rd May, 2018.

Higher Education Loans Board did not respond to the Clerk of the Senate's letter but the nominee had a clearance certificate dated 27th April, 2018 from the Institution confirming that he was cleared by the board.

*** ON SELF-INTRODUCTION, HON. CHEPKONG'A STATED THAT-**

He was born in 1961, went to school in Iten and studied Law up to post graduate level in University of Nairobi. He then worked for various organizations in different capacities including ITU mission on the preparation of the Constitution for African Telecommunications Regulators (ATR), Kenya Post and Telecommunications Corporations, Kenya Planters Cooperative Union and the African Union, before becoming a Member of Parliament representing Ainabkoi Constituency from 2013 to 2017. He added that he had been the Chairperson of the Justice and Legal Affairs Committee during his tenure as an MP.

*** Hon Chepkong'a also informed Members that he had significant experience in the public sector and the legislature in particular and was of the opinion that the Commission will greatly benefit from his experience.**

Hon. Chepkonga spoke in support of Senators having their own kitty that will enable them to effectively perform their oversight roles in the counties. He further proposed that a Senator should be facilitated to have an office in each constituency of the county that he or she represents.

He spoke of bringing his integrity and independence to the PSC and promised to ensure that all MPs are facilitated to perform their jobs.

On Devolution, he mentioned that the Senate had done considerably well in protecting the interests of counties; and in effect empowering the people at the grassroots. He mentioned that the proposed Senate sittings in Uasin Gishu County scheduled for September, 2018 would enhance the visibility of the Senate.

He concluded by promising to agitate for the completion of the Parliamentary building which will see Members of Parliament having adequate office space and sufficient facilities.

3.0 COMMITTEE'S OBSERVATIONS


The Committee made the following general observations-that,

1. Hon Samuel Kiprono Chepkong'a had knowledge and experience in public sector issues and the legislature having been a Member of Parliament.
2. Hon. Chepkong'a had a tax clearance certificate from Kenya Revenue Authority. He also had a clearance certificate from the Higher Education Loans Board and the Ethics and Anti-Corruption Authority. The Directorate of Criminal Investigations had also issued him with a certificate of good conduct.

4.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee recommended the appointment of Hon. Samuel Kiprono Chepkong'a as a Member of the Parliamentary Service Commission.



b) Remarks by Hon. Chepkong'a

Hon Chepkonga began by informing the Committee that he was born in 1961, went to school in Iten and studied Law up to post graduate level in University of Nairobi. He then worked for various organizations in different capacities including ITU mission on the preparation of the Constitution for African Telecommunications Regulators (ATR), Kenya Post and Telecommunications Corporations, Kenya Planters Cooperative Union and the African Union, before becoming a Member of Parliament representing Ainabkoi Constituency from 2013 to 2017. He mentioned that he was the Chairperson of the Justice and Legal Affairs Committee during his tenure as an MP.

c) Members Remarks

Members wanted to know Hon. Chepkonga's views on the following issues:-

- i) His vision of the Parliamentary Service Commission (PSC) in a Bicameral setting; how he will use his position in PSC to ensure that Devolution works;
- ii) Budgetary allocations to each House in Parliament especially his view on the Pro-rata basis currently used which seems to disadvantage the Senate;
- iii) His opinion on the Monitoring and Evaluation Fund which the Senate is pushing for the Fund to be put into the Parliamentary Service Commission to ensure proper facilitation of the Senators to perform their duties;
- iv) Whether Parliament has put the necessary legal and policy frameworks for the full implementation of the Constitution;
- v) What legacy he intends to leave at the Parliamentary Service Commission;
- vi) Whether Parliament just like the Judiciary should have its own fund;
- vii) How Parliament can avoid public embarrassment like the bribery issues currently being floated in the media.

d) Hon. Chepkonga's Response

Hon. Chepkong'a responded to the issues raised as follows:-

- i) He is in support of Senators having their own kitty that will enable them to effectively perform their oversight roles in the counties. He proposed that a Senator should have an office in each constituency of his county;
- ii) He will bring his integrity and independence to the PSC and ensure that all MPs are facilitated to perform their jobs;

- iii) He totally supports the fund being proposed for the Senators as this will help them in their oversight role and ensure that devolution succeeds;
- iv) For Devolution to succeed the people need to be empowered at the grassroots; and the Senate had done a good job in protecting the interests of the Counties. He mentioned the proposed Senate sittings in Uasin Gishu county as a good move to bring Senate closer to the people;
- v) He mentioned that the Salaries and Remuneration Commission should facilitate the work of Members of Parliament and not curtail it;
- vi) He proposed that for proper working of government, Members of Parliament should be part of the Executive.
- vii) He completed by promising to push for the completion of the Parliamentary building which will see Members of Parliament having adequate office space and sufficient facilities.

e) Committee Resolutions


Members again congratulated Hon. Chepkonga and resolved to endorse him as a Member to the Parliamentary Service Commission. They wished him well and promised to hold him to account.

(3) The Clerk of the Senate shall be the Secretary of the Commission.

The position of the male non-Member of Parliament Commissioner under Article 127 (2)(d) became vacant following the resignation of Hon. (Dr.) Abdullahi Ibrahim Ali, with effect from 7th February, 2017 for purposes of contesting for an elective position in the General Elections that took place on 8th August 2017.

Pursuant to the Procedure for Appointment of Non-Member of Parliament Commissioner that was adopted by the Parliamentary Service Commission at its 236th Meeting held on 9th February, 2017, the Commission invited applications in two (2) local dailies of national circulation from persons who qualify for appointment for the vacant position of the male non-Member of Parliament Commissioner.

The advertisement was published on Wednesday, 25th April 2018 and closed on Friday, 18th May, 2018. At the close of the deadline, a total of one hundred and forty two (142) applications were received and long-listed, and six (6) qualified applicants short-listed.

On 12th July, 2018, the Parliamentary Service Commission published a list of all applicants in two (2) local dailies of national circulation and invited the short-listed applicants for oral interviews to be conducted in public. The oral interviews for the short-listed candidates were conducted on 19th July, 2018.

Paragraph 4 of the Procedure for Appointment of Non-MP Member of the Commission, requires the Commission to submit the name of the person recommended to the National Assembly and the Senate for approval and appointment in accordance with the Standing Orders of the respective Houses.

The Procedure further provides that if both Houses of Parliament approve the name recommended by the Commission, the Commission shall, within seven (7) days after the approval, publish the name in the Gazette. If on the other hand, one or both Houses of Parliament reject the name recommended by the Commission, the Speaker of the relevant House is required to communicate the decision to the other House and request for a fresh nomination by the Commission.



In submitting a new nominee, the Commission is required, within seven (7) days, to submit to the National Assembly and the Senate a fresh nomination from amongst the persons short-listed by the Commission. If either or both of the Houses of Parliament reject any or all of the subsequent nominees submitted by the Commission for its approval, the Commission shall make a fresh call for applications and the process repeated accordingly.

The purpose of this letter therefore, is to submit to the National Assembly and the Senate for appointment in accordance Article 127(2)(d) of the Constitution, the name of **Mr. Samuel Kiprono Chepkong'a** as the person recommended by the Parliamentary Service Commission to fill the vacancy of the position of Non-Member of Parliament Commissioner.

The report of the process is herewith attached with the following Annexes –

- (i) The Procedure for Appointment of Non-Member of Parliament Commissioner that was adopted by the Parliamentary Service Commission at its 236th Meeting held on 9th February, 2017;
- (ii) The Advertisement calling for applications published in the Daily Nation and Standard Newspapers on Wednesday, 25th April 2018;
- (iii) The Long-list Report containing names of all 142 applicants who applied for the position by the close of the deadline on Friday, 18th May, 2018; and
- (iv) The publication of 12th July, 2018 publishing names of all 142 applicants who applied for the position which also invited the six (6) short-listed candidates for oral interviews that were held on Thursday, 19th July, 2018.

1.0 INTRODUCTION

Article 127 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 establishes a Parliamentary Service Commission with functions with responsibilities as are set out in Article 127 (6) (a) to (e) and the Parliamentary Service Act. These include the following:-

- a) providing services and facilities to ensure the efficient and effective functioning of Parliament;
- b) constituting offices in the parliamentary service and appointing and supervising office holders;
- c) preparing annual estimates of expenditure of the parliamentary service and submitting them to the National Assembly for approval and basically exercising budgetary control over the service;
- d) undertaking programmes to promote the ideals of parliamentary democracy;
- e) performing other functions –
 - i) necessary for the wellbeing of the members and staff of Parliament; or
 - ii) prescribed by national legislation.

Article 127(2) & (3) of the Constitution provides that the Parliamentary Service Commission shall consist of the following Members -

- (2)(a) the Speaker of the National Assembly, as chairperson;
- (b) a vice-chairperson elected by the commission from among its members
- (c) seven members appointed by Parliament from among its members as follows;-
 - (i) four shall be nominated equally from both Houses by the party or coalition of parties forming the national government, of who at least two shall be women; and
 - (ii) three shall be nominated by the Parties not forming the national government, at least one of whom shall be nominated from each House and at least one shall be a woman; and

(d) one man and one woman appointed by Parliament from among persons who are experienced in public affairs but are not members of Parliament.

(3) The Clerk of the Senate shall be the Secretary of the Commission.

2.0 VACANCY IN THE POSITION OF MALE NON-MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT COMMISSIONER

The position of the male Non-Member of Parliament Commissioner under Article 127 (2)(d) became vacant following the resignation of Hon. (Dr.) Abdullahi Ibrahim Ali, with effect from 7th February, 2017 for purposes of contesting for an elective position in the General Elections that took place on 8th August 2017.

3.0 APPROVAL OF PROCEDURE FOR APPOINTMENT OF THE NON-MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT COMMISSIONER

Neither the Constitution nor the Parliamentary Service Act provide for the procedure to be used in filling a vacancy under Article 127(2)(d) of the Constitution. Consequently therefore, at its 236th Meeting held on 9th February, 2017, the Commission considered and adopted the procedure in Annex I for appointment of the non-Member of Parliament Commissioner under Article 127 (2) (d) as indicated below -

(a) That upon a vacancy arising in the membership of the Commission under Article 127(2)(d) of the Constitution, the Commission shall, within **fourteen (14)** days of the occurrence of the vacancy, by notice in the Gazette and at least two (2) daily newspapers of national circulation, declare a vacancy and invite interested qualified persons to apply.

(b) Any person qualified in accordance with the Constitution may make an application within **fourteen (14)** days of the publication of the notice.

- (c) The Parliamentary Service Commission shall, within **fourteen (14)** days after the last date of submission of application under paragraph 2, consider the applications, shortlist, conduct interviews and recommend -
- (i) in respect of a vacancy of a member who is a woman, the name of one female applicant qualified for the position;
 - (ii) in respect of a vacancy of a member who is a man, the name of one male applicant qualified for the position.
- (d) The names of the persons recommended under paragraph 3 shall be submitted to the National Assembly and the Senate for approval and appointment in accordance with the Standing Orders of the respective Houses.
- (e) If both Houses of Parliament approve the names recommended under paragraph 3, the Commission shall, within seven days after the approval, publish the name in the Gazette.
- (f) Where one or the two Houses of Parliament reject the names recommended under paragraph 3, the Speaker of the relevant House shall communicate the decision to the other House and request for a fresh nomination by the Commission.
- (g) In submitting a new nominee under paragraph 6, the Commission shall within **seven (7)** days, submit to the National Assembly and the Senate a fresh nomination from amongst the persons shortlisted by the Commission under paragraph 3.
- (h) If either or both of the Houses of Parliament rejects any or all of the subsequent nominees submitted by the Commission for approval under paragraph 7, the provisions of paragraphs 1 to 6 shall apply.
- (i) A person is qualified to be appointed a member of the Parliamentary Service Commission under Article 127(2)(d) if-
- (i) the person is a citizen of Kenya;
 - (ii) holds a degree from a university recognized in Kenya;
 - (iii) has at least ten years' experience in public affairs; and

- (iv) meets the requirements of leadership and integrity set out in chapter 6 of the Constitution.
- (j) In addition the persons qualified to be appointed a member of the Parliamentary Service Commission are expected to-
 - (i) demonstrate experience or interest in consolidating and advancing the ideals and objectives of Parliamentary democracy;
 - (ii) demonstrate adherence to the national values and principles set out in Article 10 of the Constitution;
 - (iii) reflect the regional and ethnic diversity of the people of Kenya.

4.0 ADVERTISEMENT AND LONG-LISTING FOR THE VACANT POSITION OF MEMBER OF THE PARLIAMENTARY SERVICE COMMISSION

The Parliamentary Service Commission (PSC) invited applications in two (2) local dailies of national circulation from persons who qualify for appointment for the vacant position of the male non-Member of Parliament Commissioner.

The advertisement was published on Wednesday, 25th April 2018 and closed on Friday, 18th May, 2018. (See Annex II) A total of one hundred and forty two (142) applications were received and long-listed. (See Annex III)

The Board of Senior Management considered the long-list report at its 153rd Meeting held on 28th May, 2018 and recommended that –

Considering the strict timelines set out in the Rules of Procedure for the Appointment of Non-Member of Parliament Commissioner, the Members Welfare Committee of the Parliamentary Service Commission considers the long-list report and short-lists the applicants based on the set qualifications and submits the names of short-listed applicants to the Commission for consideration and approval.

At its 92nd Meeting held on 5th June, 2018, the Commission Committee on Members Welfare considered the long-list report and noted as follows –

- (i) That the fourteen (14) days period within which the Commission is required to consider the applications, short-list applicants, conduct interviews and recommend a name of the suitable candidate for the position, lapsed on 3rd June, 2018.
- (ii) Further, that the timelines were set by the Commission as part of the Rules of Procedure and may be extended.

Based on the foregoing, the Committee resolved that -

- (i) Members of the Board of Senior Management present under the chairmanship of Commissioner Dr. Lonah Mumelo short-lists fifteen (15) applicants in accordance with the requirements set out in the Rules of Procedure for the Appointment of Non-Member of Parliament Commissioner adopted by the Commission at its 236th Meeting held on 9th February, 2017, and submit a report to the Committee at a meeting scheduled for Tuesday, 12th June, 2018.
- (ii) Thereafter the Committee considers the short-list report and forwards its recommendations to the Parliamentary Service Commission for its consideration.

5.0 SHORT-LISTING OF APPLICATIONS

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure for the Appointment of Non-Member of Parliament Commissioner adopted by the Commission at its 236th Meeting held on 9th February, 2017, a person is qualified to be appointed a member of the Parliamentary

Service Commission under Article 127(2)(d) if the person possesses the following qualifications -

- (i) is a **citizen** of Kenya;
- (ii) holds a **degree** from a university recognized in Kenya;
- (iii) has at least **ten years'** experience in public affairs; and
- (iv) meets the requirements of leadership and integrity set out in **Chapter 6** of the Constitution.

At its 245th Meeting held on 28th June, 2018, the Commission short-listed the following candidates for the position of non-Member of Parliament Parliamentary Service Commissioner in accordance with the criteria -
