

PETITION BY THE GOVERNOR AND OFFICERS OF THE UASIN GISHU
COUNTY GOVERNMENT REGARDING THE STATUS OF AND FUNDING OF
THE MOI TEACHING AND REFERRAL HOSPITAL IN UASIN GISHU COUNTY

Honourable Senators,

1. Pursuant to Standing Orders 220 (1) (a), and 225(2) (b), I hereby report to the Senate that a petition has been submitted, through the Clerk, by Hon. Jackson K. Mandago, the Governor of Uasin Gishu County, and five other officers in the Uasin Gishu County Government.
2. The Petition relates to the status and funding of the Moi Teaching and Referral Hospital, which is located at Eldoret, within Uasin Gishu County.
3. In the Petition, the Petitioners state –
 - a) that, although the Moi Teaching and Referral Hospital is recognized as a referral hospital serving residents of Upper Rift Valley and the Western part of Kenya, it has for long been classified as a Level IV hospital. This has meant that, since the onset of devolution, the Moi Teaching and Referral Hospital ('MTRH') has not benefitted from the Conditional Grants allocated through the Budget process to other referral hospitals;
 - b) that, the MTRH has since been re-classified by the Ministry of Health as a Level VI referral hospital. Despite this, the MTRH has not been allocated any Conditional Grant for the Financial Year 2017/2018, the estimates of which are under consideration by Parliament; and
 - c) that, since the MTRH has now been classified as a Level VI referral hospital, the County Government of Uasin Gishu requests that funds be allocated to enable construction of a Level IV hospital to serve the residents of Uasin Gishu County.
4. The Petitioners therefore pray that the Senate urgently considers this matter to ensure that the MTRH benefits from Conditional Grants allocated for national referral hospitals in the 2017/2018 and subsequent financial years.
5. **Honourable Senators**, pursuant to standing order 226, I shall now allow comments, observations or clarifications in relation to the petition for not more than **thirty** minutes.

1. Diversion/misappropriation of funds made to benefit the residents of Nyamira county by the Governor and his executive committee member on Roads and infrastructure.

1.1 THAT, the Governor be summoned to account for the misuse of public funds amounting to Ksh. 50,000,000 (fifty million) for works on the following Roads:

-Magombo-Gekano Girls, Kijauri-Manga, Eronge-Kebuse, Nyaramba-Bonyunyu and Rirumi, Jua Kali-Boflos-Tente back street, Kabatia-Bokimo-Kenya, Nyachururu-Nyangena, Riosongo, NYaisa & Moromba Roads, Miruka, Nyandocheii, Getare & Nyamaiya roads.

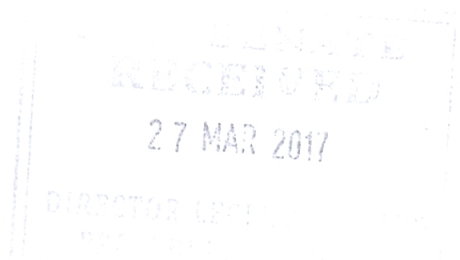
1.2 THAT, the governor be summoned to elaborate why procedural process was not followed in renovation of his office.

1.3 THAT, the governor be summoned to elucidate why ksh.5,084,637 was misappropriated on the construction of masonry tank at Ekerenyo.

1.4 THAT, the governor be summoned to explain why the construction of market stalls and latrines at Nyabite as not been completed yet the contractor has been paid the whole sum of Ksh.11,900,416 according to the BQS.

2. Renovation and Development of water resources in Nyamira county.

2.1 THAT, the governor be summoned to elucidate why the following water resources were either never done properly or partially done or no work was done yet they were funded.

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-Rianyabate water spring(ksh.308,950),Kioronya water spring(ksh.299,950),Rirumi Nyageita project(ksh.6.6 million),Nyagwancha water project(ksh.8,967,496),Manga Girls water project(ksh.9,310,794),Mekenene water project(4.699 million),Machuririati water project(ksh.8.8million),Kemera water project(5.4 million),Riasure water spring(490,00) and drilling of five(5) bore holes ksh.25,527,461).

3. Renovation or construction of Health centres Nyamira county

3.1 THAT, the governor be summoned to explain why the following Health Centres were allocated money for the work to be done but were either partially done, or no work done because some were funded by CDF.

Nyankono Health Centre, Magwagwa health Centre(ksh.2,312,518), Motagara Health Centre(ksh.3,263,207), Kiamanyomba Health Centre(ksh.2,186,391), Orwaki Health Centre(ksh.3,304,120).

4. Construction/Renovation of the following Youth Polytechnics in Nyamira county.

4.1 THAT, the governor be summoned to give an explanation as to the following Youth polytechnics were either poorly constructed or no proper workmanship was done according to the BQS

Kiogutwa youth polytechnic, Saiga ngiya youth polytechnic(ksh.2,260,538), Bigege youth polytechnic(ksh.2.3 million)

5. Official trip to U.S.A which never happened

5.1 THAT, the governor be summoned to explain whether the allowances which were given to the officers who were listed to travel to USA trip which never took place monies was recovered .

6. Official trip to Italy.

6.1. THAT, the governor be summoned to explain why a trip to Italy they included a KDTA director who was given allowances yet he was not an employee of the county Government.

6.2. THAT, the governor be summoned to elucidate why his personal assistant travelled to Italy yet the Governor was not travelling.

7. THAT I/WE have made the best efforts to have these matters addressed by the relevant authorities(COUNTY ASSEMBLY), ALL of which have failed to give a satisfactory response.

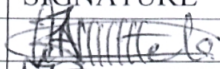
8. THAT, none of these issues raised in this Petition is pending in any court of Law, Constitutional or any other legal body.
