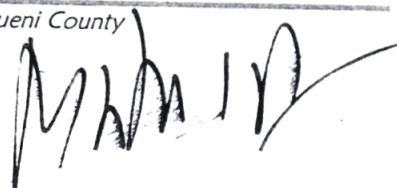
PETITION MADE TO THE SENATE BY THE RESIDENTS OF EMALI/MULALAWARD IN MAKUENI COUNTY CONCERNING THE HISTORICAL FEUD AS TO THE LOCATION OF EMALI TOWN ACROSS THE RAILWAY LINE ALONG THE HISTORICAL BOUNDARY AS PER THE TREATY BETWEEN THE MAASAI AND KAMBA IN EARLY 1900S

We, the 433 undersigned,

Citizens of the Republic of Kenya and residents of Emali/Mulala Ward in Makueni County;

~~DRAW~~ the attention of the Senate to the following:

1. **THAT**, there exists a historical feud as to the location of Email town across the railway line along the historical boundary as per the treaty between the Maasai and the Kamba in early 1900s.
2. **THAT**, the Emali/Mulala residents through the Emali Centre Residents Association forwarded their complaint to the Senator of Makueni County Assembly, Sen. Mutula Kilonzo Junior.
3. **THAT**, the Senator wrote to the Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission (IEBC) seeking a clarification to the above disputed boundary.
4. **THAT**, the Senator received a response from the Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission clarifying the disputed boundary to be a fixed survey cadastral boundary that marks the perimeter boundary of the township to the south west (approximately 800meters from the railway line to the high voltage power line) and that the whole area of the township defined by that cadastral boundary falls in Makueni County, where residents are represented from Makueni County, Kibwezi West Constituency, Emali/Mulala Ward as per IEBC Gazette notice of 2012 and as amended by the High Court in July 2012.



5. **THAT**, Kajiado County is collecting revenue from traders in the disputed area of Emali town, which is in Makueni County.
6. **THAT**, that the people living in the disputed area of Emali town have faced interference from the officials from Kajiado County, especially those from the lands department, on matters such as property registration.
7. **THAT**, service delivery to the people living with in the disputed area of Emali township has been greatly hampered, as neither Kajiado nor Makueni County Government is offering services to the residents in the said area.
8. **THAT**, we have made the best efforts to have this matter resolved amicably by the respective County Governments without success.
9. **THAT**, the issues in respect of which this petition is made are not pending before any Court of Law, Constitution or Legal body.

HEREFORE your humble petitioners pray that Senate forms an independent commission under Article 188 of the Constitution to establish the boundary dispute between the County of Makueni and Kajiado at Emali Township.
