MESSAGE FROM THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

**ON THE REJECTION OF SOME OF THE SENATE AMENDMENTS TO
THE CLIMATE CHANGE BILL (NATIONAL ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 1 OF
2014)**

Honourable Senators,

I wish to report to the Senate that, on 3rd March, 2016 and pursuant to Standing Order 40 (3) and (4), I received the following message from the Speaker of the National Assembly regarding the rejection, by the Assembly, of some of the Senate amendments to the Climate Change Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 1 of 2014)-

"**PURSUANT** to the provisions of Standing Order 41 and 142 of the National Assembly Standing Orders, I hereby convey the following message from the National Assembly-

THAT, by way of a resolution passed on Tuesday, 1st March 2016, the National Assembly **concurred** with the Senate's amendments to the Climate Change Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 1 of 2014), save for the amendments to **Clauses 7 (2) (g), 7 (4) and 32**, which were disagreed to;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of Article 112 of the Constitution and Standing Order 149 of the National Assembly Standing Orders, I hereby **convey** the said decision of the National Assembly to the Senate and seek the appointment of Senators to the Mediation Committee to consider the said Bill in accordance with Article 113 of the Constitution".

Honourable Senators,

Article 112(1) (b) of the Constitution provides that *if one House passes an ordinary Bill concerning counties and the second House passes the Bill in an amended form, it shall be referred back to the originating House for reconsideration*. Further, Article 112(2) (b) of the Constitution provides that *if after the originating House has reconsidered a Bill referred back to it under clause (1) (b), that House rejects the Bill as amended, the Bill shall be referred to a Mediation Committee under Article 113*.

Honourable Senators,

In the circumstances, I concur with the Speaker of the National Assembly to form a mediation committee in accordance with Articles 112(2) (b) and 113 of the Constitution.

In this regard, Hon. Senators, I have received communication from the National Assembly that the Speaker of the National Assembly has appointed the following Members to represent the Assembly in the Mediation Committee that will attempt to develop a version of the Bill that both Houses will pass-

- 1) The Hon. Amina Abdalla, MP;
- 2) The Hon. (Dr.) Wilbur Ottichilo, MP;
- 3) The Hon. Chachu Ganya, MP;
- 4) The Hon. Kathuri Murungi, MP; and,
- 5) The Hon. Opiyo Wandayi, MP.

In this regard, Hon. Senators, I also hereby appoint the following Senators to represent the Senate in the Mediation Committee-

- 2) Sen. Christopher Obure, MP;
- 3) Sen. Martha Wangari, MP;

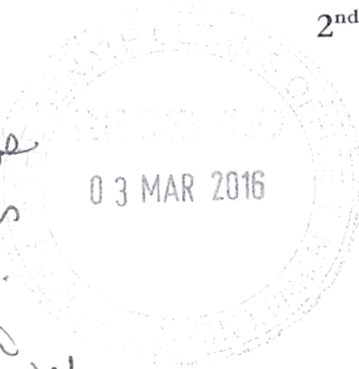

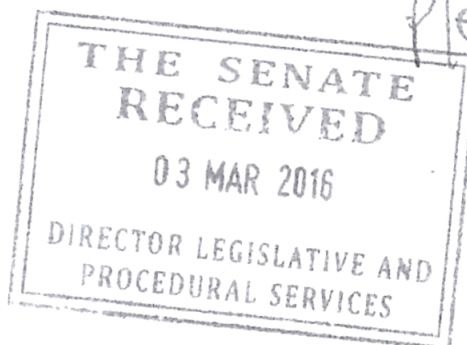
