
APPROVAL OF THE FOREST CONSERVATION AND
MANAGEMENT BILL (NATIONAL ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 49 OF 2015)

PURSUANT to the provisions of Standing Orders 41(1) and 142 of the National Assembly Standing Orders, I hereby convey the following Message from the National Assembly –

THAT WHEREAS, the Forest Conservation and Management Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 49 of 2015) was published *vide* Kenya Gazette Supplement No. 133 of 11th August 2015 to give effect to the provisions of Article 69 of the Constitution with regard to conservation and management of forest resources and to repeal the Forest Act, 2005;

AND WHEREAS, the National Assembly considered and passed the said Bill on Thursday, 17th March 2016 with amendments in the form attached hereto;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions Articles 110(4) of the Constitution and Standing Order 142 of the National Assembly Standing Orders, I hereby refer the said Bill to the Senate for consideration.
