## FOREWORD

The State Corporations sub-sector is a key player in delivery of the National Government development agenda. In recognition of this, the Government has over the years invested heavily in the sector through capital injection in form of recurrent and development grants, loans and guarantees. The State Corporations sub-sector was instrumental in helping Kenya achieve rapid expansion of the economy during the first two decades of Independence. During that period, the Government established State Corporations in key sectors of the economy such as Manufacturing, Agriculture, Banking, and Tourism among others. In later years, more State Corporations were established to implement some of the functions undertaken by the Central Government in infrastructure development; Roads, ICT, Water and Sanitations.

In mid-1990s, Structural and Governance challenges facing the sub-sector led to state corporations being a drain to the national economy. As a result, the Government initiated the Parastatal Reforms Strategy. The Parastatal Reform Strategy entailed substantive divestiture and privatization as well as unbundling operations of some State Corporations that lend to separating the regulatory functions from commercial operations.

In addition to Parastatal Reforms, the Government has initiated other measures with strong emphasis on good corporate governance, a requirement for accountability and adoption of risk management frameworks by State Corporations. These measures are aimed at ensuring State Corporations deliver on their mandates in a transparent manner and that they are accountable for utilization of resources deployed to them.

To this end, the Government issued Executive Order No. 7 of 2015 on Mwongozo Code of Governance for State Corporations. The Mwongozo was issued to provide guidance on effective governance and oversight of State Corporations. In addition, the National Treasury has issued Circulars giving guidelines for establishment of Audit Committees and Risk Management Frameworks by State Corporations. The Capital Market Authority on the other hand, has issued regulations under the Capital Market Act (Cap 485) on code of governance requirements by companies listed at the Nairobi Securities Exchange.

This Report comprises of the following five statements as required under the PFM Act 2012:

- (i) Consolidated Statement of National Government Shareholding/Equity and Funding of State Corporations and Government-Linked Corporations;
- (ii) National Government Shareholding/Equity in State Corporations and Government-Linked Corporations;
- (iii) National Government Grants and Subsidies to State Corporations and Government-Linked Corporations;
- (iv) Loans and Guarantees by National Government to State Corporations and Government-Linked Corporations;
- (v) Statement of Revenue Receipts from State Corporations;

During 2015/16 Financial Year, the nominal value of Government shareholding in commercial State Corporations and non-redeemable capital in Non-Commercial State Corporations amounted to **Kshs. 23,304 million** compared with **Kshs. 15,409 million** in 2014/2015 Financial Year. The increase in nominal shareholding value is attributed to increase in GOK shareholding in KenGen from **Kshs. 3,847 million** in 2014/2015 FY to **Kshs. 11,538 million** in 2015/2016 Financial year through the a

Rights Issue undertaken by KenGen and also increase in GOK shareholding in Kenya Petroleum Refineries from 50% to 100% through acquisition of 50% shareholding previously owned by ESSAR. In the KenGen Rights Issue, GOK exercised its Rights by way of conversion of **Kshs. 20,150 million** of its on-lent loans to KenGen into equity. In addition, GOK shareholding in Telkom Kenya increased from 30 per cent to 40 per cent in 2015/2016 Financial Year.


Transfers to State Corporations in form of Recurrent and Development Grants decreased by 15 per cent to reach **Kshs. 284,368 million** in 2015/2016 Financial Year compared from **Kshs. 332,938 million** in 2014/2015 Financial Year. The decrease was mainly attributed to a reduction in Government grants to the Ministry of Water & Irrigation and Ministry of Transport & Infrastructure. On the other hand, the amount of undischarged loans as at 30<sup>th</sup> June 2016 was **Kshs. 411,997 million** compared with **Kshs. 367,923 million** in a similar period in 2015. The increase is mainly attributed to loans procured by the Government and on-lent to Kenya Railways Corporation for the implementation of Standard Gauge Railway. Though the Government has not issued new guarantees to State Corporations since 2010, the amount of undischarged guarantee as at 30<sup>th</sup> June 2016 was **Kshs. 74,419 million** up from **Kshs. 67,880 million** in 2014/2015 Financial Year. The increase is attributed to drawdown of GOK guaranteed loans by KenGen and Kenya Ports Authority.

During the period under review, unaudited financial results shows that State Corporations collectively reported net profits/surplus amounting to **Kshs. 78,118 million** compared with **Kshs. 80,522 million** in 2014/2015 Financial Year.

Total revenue receipts by the National Government from the State Corporations in form of dividends, surpluses remitted to the Exchequer and directors' fees in 2015/2016 Financial Year amounted to **Kshs 23,049 million**. Payments by State

Corporations to the National Government in respect of direct and guaranteed loan obligations together with interest charges in the period under review stood at **Kshs. 5,188 million** in 2015/2016 Financial Year compared with **Kshs. 5,014 million** in 2014/2015 Financial Year. On the other hand, payment made by the National Government on behalf of State Corporations arising out of guaranteed loans was **Kshs 1,052 million** in 2015/2016 Financial Year compared with **Kshs 936 million** in 2014/2015 Financial Year.

Finally, while compiling this report the biggest challenge still remains getting the required information within the set timelines. We would however, like to thank those State Corporations that responded timely to our questionnaire. Further, it should be noted that this report is based on **unaudited financial statements** from State Corporations for the 2015/16 Financial Year.

## Legal Basis for the Consolidated National Government Investment Report

The Consolidated National Government Investment Report is prepared in accordance with Section 89 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 which states as follows:

- (1) The Cabinet Secretary responsible for matters relating to public investments shall prepare and submit to the National Assembly, not later than four months after the end of each financial year, a consolidated report summarizing the extent of national government involvement or investment in, or funding of, all state corporations and government-linked corporations for that financial year.
- (2) The report under subsection (1) shall include information on-
  - a) the date of incorporation and objects of the corporation;
  - b) the amount of national government shareholding, directly or indirectly, in the state corporation;
  - c) any changes in the shareholding of the state corporation during the financial year;
  - d) the amount of any funding in the form of grants or subsidies provided by the national government to the state corporation or government-linked state corporations, excluding profit-making state corporation, during the financial year;
  - e) the amount of any loans made by the national government to the state corporation, and the amount of any guarantees issued by the national government in respect of the state corporation, during the financial year;
  - f) the cumulative amount of undischarged loans and guarantees in respect of the state corporation;
  - g) the amount of the profit or loss of the state corporation for the financial year;
  - h) the amount of any revenue received by the national government from the state corporation during the financial year, including dividends, interest and proceeds from any divestiture of assets of the state corporation;
  - i) the amount of payments made, or losses incurred, by the national government to meet contingent liabilities as a result of loans or guarantees during the financial year, including payments made in respect of guarantees, loan write-offs or waiver of interest on loans; and
  - j) an assessment of the financial and related non-financial performance of the state corporation for the financial year.
- (3) Once every three years, the Cabinet Secretary responsible for matters relating to public investments shall prepare a report on the assessment of the national government's continued involvement or investment in, or funding of, the state corporation or government linked corporation.
- (4) The Cabinet Secretary responsible for matters relating to public investments shall submit copies of the reports referred to in subsections (2) and (3) to the Cabinet Secretary, the Controller of Budget, the Commission on Revenue Allocation and to the Auditor-General

# THE CONSOLIDATED NATIONAL GOVERNMENT INVESTMENT REPORT

## Preamble

1. Pursuant to Section 89 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 the Cabinet Secretary National Treasury is required to prepare a Consolidated National Government Investment Report annually. The Report indicates the extent of National Government investment in, or funding of, all State Corporations and Government-linked Corporations for the year.
2. State Corporations, or parastatals, are legal entities that have been established by Government to undertake specific strategic function that would have otherwise been done by the central Government. They are entities incorporated under the Companies Act or an Act of Parliament in which whole or controlling shareholding belongs to the Government. State Corporations are therefore, distinct legal entities that are operationally autonomous from Government and may be partially or even fully funded by Government or financially independent on account of profits, fees, commissions and other internally-generated funds
3. Government linked corporations are entities where the Government has a minority shareholding of less than 50 per cent and are not considered under the State Corporations Act.
4. State Corporations are categorized as commercial and non-commercial. The State Corporation Act Cap [446](#) is the over-arching governing law on the establishment, fiduciary oversight on management and governance; and financial control of State Corporations.



5. Commercial State Corporations comprise of:

- a) Companies with GoK shareholding, through the Cabinet Secretary to the National Treasury as a body corporate, of more than 50%;
- b) A body Corporate established to perform a strategic function profitably,
- c) An entity that generally operates on commercial principals,
- d) Generally self-financing and sustaining except in financing investment for public policy objectives; and
- e) Accountable to all stakeholders and the public through the relevant committee of Parliament.

Among the Commercial State Corporations with “public goods” mandate for which GoK is required to meet the full cost of those activities using budgetary resources approved by Parliament are Kenya Broadcasting Corporation, Kenya Ferry Services Limited and National Cereals & Produce Board as it relates to Strategic Grain Reserves.

6. Non-Commercial State Corporations are expected to operate on a cost recovery basis and largely depend on monies appropriated by Parliament, levies and fees. They include; regulatory agencies and statutory boards; research institutions; institutions of higher learning and referral hospitals. Non Commercial State Corporations deliver services on behalf of Ministries and are funded mainly through the National Budgets in form of grants or loans from the Government.

7. This Report comprises of the following five statements as required under the PFM Act 2012: -

- (i) Consolidated Statement of National Government Shareholding/Equity and Funding of State Corporations and Government–Linked Corporations;
- (ii) National Government Shareholding/Equity in State Corporations and Government–Linked Corporations;
- (iii) National Government Grants and Subsidies to State Corporations and Government–Linked Corporations;
- (iv) Loans and Guarantees by National Government to State Corporations and Government–Linked Corporations;
- (v) Statement of Revenue Receipts from State Corporations;

## I Introduction

1. State Corporations are engaged in the provision of essential services and infrastructure which are vital to the competitiveness of the Kenyan economy and to the overall social economic development of Kenya. Overall, while great progress has been made in upgrading and developing of key infrastructure, Kenya continues to have significant infrastructure development needs. In this regard, the State Corporations sub-sector continues to implement key infrastructural projects and programs covering all sector of the Kenyan economy in line with Vision 2030. The Vision 2030 seeks to create a globally competitive and prosperous nation with a high quality of life by the year 2030. The Vision 2030 envisages a newly industrialized, middle-income country providing a high quality of life to all its citizens by year 2030 in a clean and secure environment.
2. Among organizations driving this growth are the infrastructure State Corporations among them Kenya Electricity Generating Company(KENGEN), Kenya Railways Corporation(KRC), Kenya Ports Authority (KPA), Kenya Airports Authority(KAA), ICT Authority, Kenya Power, National Water, Conservation & Pipeline Corporation. Others are in the health sector, financial sector; Research Institutions and Universities among others.
3. The ongoing key Infrastructure at various stages of implementation in 2015/2016 Financial year includes the Nairobi Water Northern Collector Water project at a cost of **Kshs. 10,730 million**. The project being implemented by Athi Water Services Board aims at providing more water to Nairobi. Other project are the Last mile connectivity project, Street Lighting program and Kenya Electricity Expansion project being implemented by Kenya Power Company; the National Optic Fibre Backhaul Infrastructure (NOFBI) being undertaken by the Ministry of ICT. The Kenya Ports Authority has continued to invest in container handling capacity. The phase I of the Mombasa Port Development Project under implementation will usher in the second container terminal with a capacity to handle 1.35 million when



completed. The Standard Gauge Railway project was at advanced stage of implementation by the end of 2015/2016 Financial Year.

4. The State Corporations reform agenda remain on course. The reforms are aimed at strengthening the State Corporations sub-sector and to provide a foundation for the establishment of a new governance structure for Commercial and Non-commercial State Corporations in line with the Constitution. It is also expected that the reforms will help achieve improved performance of State Corporations in the delivery of their socio- economic mandate in a more cost effective and timely manner.
5. The privatization of some State Corporations is ongoing though at a slow pace. This followed the Government decision to stop the privatization process awaiting the conclusion of the Parastatal reforms. The privatization of sugar companies though ongoing after Parliament approval was granted, has stalled after some of the stakeholders including Governors of sugar growing zones moved to court. The Governors are of the view that the sugar companies should be vested to the respective County Governments where they are located.

## II Status of Government Involvement in State Corporations in 2015/2016 Financial Year

6. A summary of the National Government involvement in Public Investments is summarized in **Schedule A**. In 2015/2016 Financial Year, total GOK shareholding in nominal terms was **Kshs. 23,304 million** up from **Kshs. 15,409 million** in 2014/2015 Financial Year. The increase in GOK shareholding was attributed to the GOK taking up its rights during the recent KenGen Rights Issue. In this Issue, GOK took 3,076 million additional shares in KenGen in order to retain its 70 per cent shareholding in the company. At the close of the KenGen Rights Issue, GOK shareholding in the company rose from 70% to 74% following undersubscription by the private sector shareholders. The GOK shareholding in Kenya Petroleum Refineries and Telkom Kenya also increased from 50 per cent to 100 per cent and 30 per cent to 40 per cent respectively.

7. The total revenues (internally generated funds) rose by 7.5 per cent in 2015/2016 Financial Year to reach **Kshs. 475,529 million** up from **Kshs. 442,417 million** in 2014/2015 Financial Year. Total assets of all State Corporation are estimated to be **Kshs. 3,333 billion** in 2015/2016 Financial Year compared with **Kshs. 2,897 billion** in 2014/2015 Financial Year. The increase was attributed to commissioning of completed projects e.g. the Olkaria 280 MW power project, Isiolo Moyale Marsabit Road and acquisition of productive assets during the year.

### III. Grants and Subsidies

8. Total grants and subsidies to State Corporations for development and recurrent purposes in 2015/2016 Financial year were **Kshs. 284,368 million** compared with **Kshs. 332,938 million** in the previous year.

#### Government Grants and Subsidies FY 2015/2016

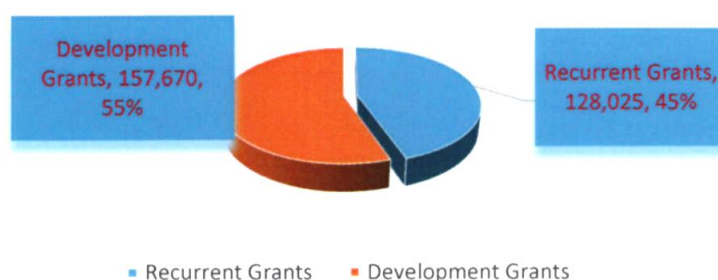
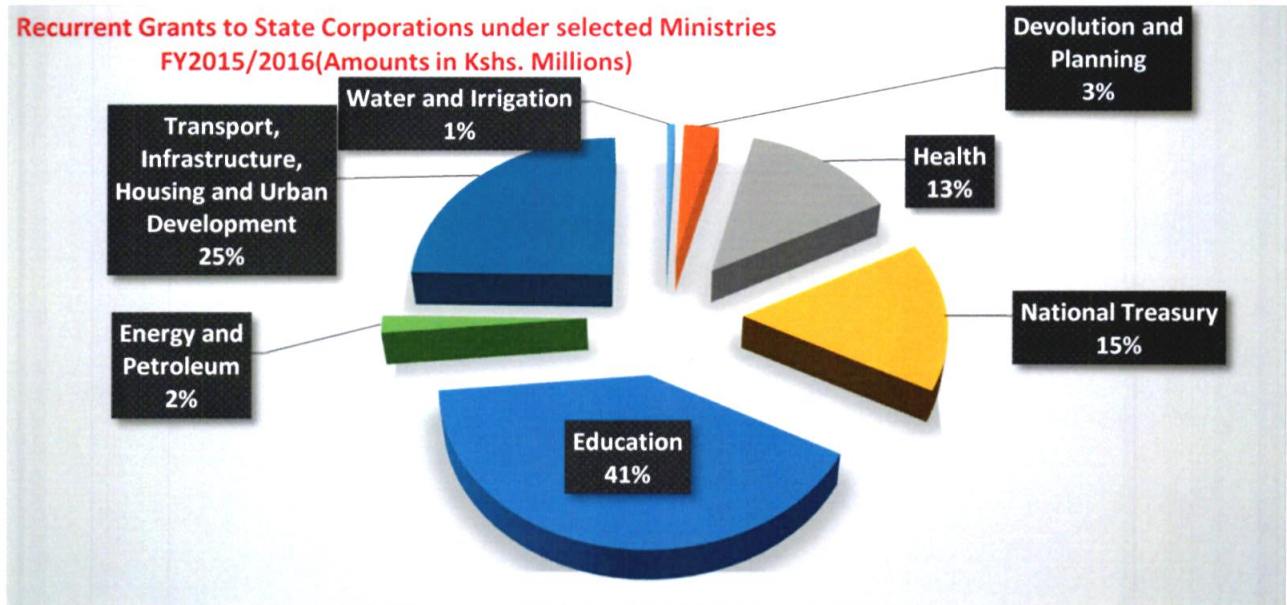


Figure 1: GOK grants and subsidies FY 2015/2016

9. During the year under review, recurrent grants increased from **Kshs. 118,671 million** in 2014/2015 FY to **Kshs. 126,658 million** in FY 2015/16 and accounted for 44.5 per cent of total grants. The State Corporations under the Ministry of Education received the highest transfers of recurrent grants at **Kshs. 44,193 million**. This allocation was mainly to public universities. State Corporations under the Ministry of Transport & Infrastructure received recurrent grants amounting to **Kshs. 26,840**

**million** mainly from the Road Maintenance Fuel Levy Fund (RMLF).

- 10.** Allocation of Government Development Grants to State Corporations under the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure, Housing and Urban Development; Education; Ministry of Energy & Petroleum; The National Treasury; Ministry of Health and Ministry of Water & Irrigation accounted for over 89% of the total allocation. The Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure, and Housing and Urban Development received the highest allocation of Total Development Grants in 2015/2016 Financial Year at **Kshs. 101,034 million** followed by the Ministry of Energy & Petroleum with **Kshs. 18,331 million**.

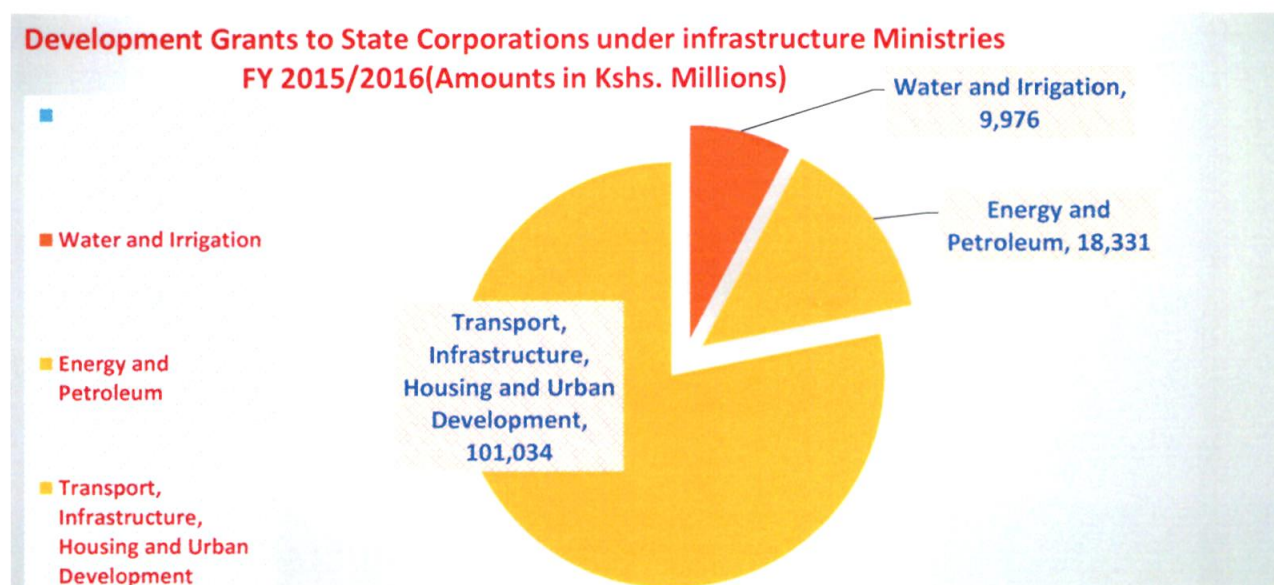


Figure 3: Distribution of Development Grants to State Corporations FY 2015/2016

#### IV Financial Performance

11. Financial reporting by Commercial State Corporations is in accordance with the International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) while financial reporting by non-commercial State Corporations reports is in accordance with International Public Sector Accounting Standards (IPSAS). Consequently, commercial State Corporations reports either having made a profit/loss while the non-commercial reports a surplus/deficit. During 2015/2016 Financial Year, State Corporations posted accumulated profits/surplus amounting to **Kshs 78,114 million** compared with **Kshs. 80,522 million** in 2014/2015 Financial Year. In 2015/2016 Financial Year, commercial State Corporations posted profit amounting to **Kshs. 56,144 million** compared with **Kshs. 54,517 million** the previous year. State Corporations under the Ministry of Energy and Petroleum, National Treasury, and Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure posted the highest profit at **Kshs 16,877 million**, **Kshs. 14,037 million** and **Kshs. 9,214 million** respectively. State corporations under the Ministries of Environment and Natural Resources, Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries Development and Tourism posted accumulated losses/deficits in 2015/2016 Financial Year amounting to **Kshs. 1,406 million**, **Kshs. 1,070 million** and **Kshs. 645 million** respectively.

## V National Government Loans and Guarantees to State Corporations

- 12 Under the State Corporations Act, State corporations have legal capacity to contract debts and other liabilities to finance their requirements. Approval to procure such loans however, must be obtained from the parent Ministry with the concurrence of the National Treasury as required under the State Corporations Act. Loans to State Corporations are either direct or on-lent. Direct loans refer to loans that the Government lends to State Corporations from exchequer resources. On the other hand, on lent-loans are procured by GOK mainly from bilateral and multilateral sources and on-lent to State Corporations. Capital grants or loans to State Corporations are effected through a Subsidiary Loan/ Grant Agreements between the National Treasury and the individual State Corporations. The Loan/Grant Subsidiary Agreements spell out the terms and conditions of the financing.
- 13 When a State Corporation's balance sheet is not able to support a debt for a project that is of national importance, the National Government may be called upon to provide a guarantee. The National Treasury however, provide a guarantee upon approval by Parliament. In 2015/2016 Financial Year, the Government did not issue guarantees to any of the State Corporations for loans that they may have secured. In 2015/2016 Financial Year, the stock of undischarged guarantees was **Kshs. 74,419 million** up from **Kshs. 67,880 million** in 2014/2015 Financial Year. The increase was attributed to drawdown of GOK guaranteed Loans to KenGen and Kenya Ports Authority. Except for Kenya Broadcasting Corporation and Tana and Athi River Development Authority who have defaulted in their obligation to repay GoK guarantee loans, the other State Corporations are servicing their loans. In 2015/2016 Financial Year, GoK paid a sum of **Kshs. 297 million** on behalf of Tana Athi River Development Authority and **Kshs. 753 million** on behalf of Kenya Broadcasting Corporation.



- 14 Total undischarged GOK loans to State Corporations stood at **Kshs. 412,006 million** by the end of 2015/2016 Financial Year compared with **Kshs. 367,928 million** in 2014/2015 Financial Year. The increase was attributed to loans procured by the Government and on-lent to Kenya Railways Corporations for the implementation of the Standard Gauge Railway. Consequently, the Kenya Railways had the highest stock of undischarged GOK on lent loans at **Kshs. 173,577 million** followed by KenGen with **Kshs. 50,470 million** as at 30<sup>th</sup> June 2016. Others with big balances were, Kenya Broadcasting Corporations **Kshs. 46,029 million**, Kenya Power, **Kshs. 37,168 million**, Nzoia Sugar Company **Kshs. 34,851 million** and Athi Water Services Board, **Kshs. 18,712 million**. Parliament has approved the write off of loans to sugar companies including Nzoia Sugar Company to be effected as part of the privatization process of the sugar companies.

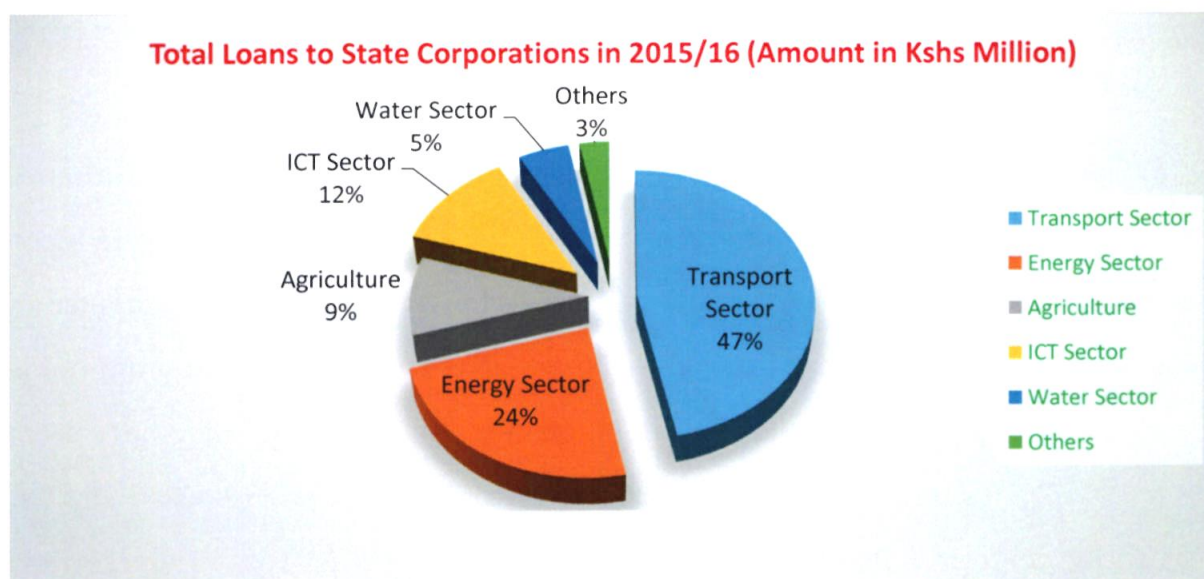


Figure 4: Total loans to State Corporations in 2015/2016

## VI Contingent Liabilities

15. As the principal owner of all State Corporations, the Government is the natural underwriter of risk that they face. Analysis of contingent liabilities therefore, is important in understanding the extent of the Government fiscal risks exposure.
16. Contingent liabilities are possible future liabilities that will only become certain on the occurrence of some future event and are generally not shown in the balance sheet, but must be given adequate disclosure. They can be explicit or implicit. Explicit

contingent liabilities are specific government obligations defined by a contract or a law. The government is legally mandated to settle such an obligation when it becomes due. On the other hand, implicit contingent liabilities represent a moral obligation or expected burden for the government not in the legal sense, but based on public expectations and political pressures e.g. GOK intervention in revival of Uchumi supermarket, revival bid of Mumias Sugar Company and Kenya Airways.

17. In 2015/2016 Financial Year, total exposure in form of contingent liabilities was **Kshs. 334,004 million** compared with **Kshs. 101,231** in 2014/2015 Financial Year. The sharp increase in contingent liabilities was attributed to the ongoing **Kshs. 240,000 million** claim against Kenya Broadcasting Corporations over claims that it breached a contract regarding the launching of a TV channel and the digital migration process.

## **VII Revenue Receipts by National Government from State Corporations and Government-Linked Corporations**

18. Receipts from Government Investments are reported in Schedule E. The receipts by the National Treasury from State Corporations and Government-linked companies are in form of dividends, loan repayments, and interest on loans, surplus remittances and director's fees. In 2015/2016 Financial Year, total receipts by National Treasury amounted to **Kshs. 23,049 Million**. Receipts from dividends and surplus funds during this period was **Kshs. 18,872** representing 82 per cent of total receipts. The highest amount of dividend was from Safaricom Ltd. at **Kshs. 8,974 million**.



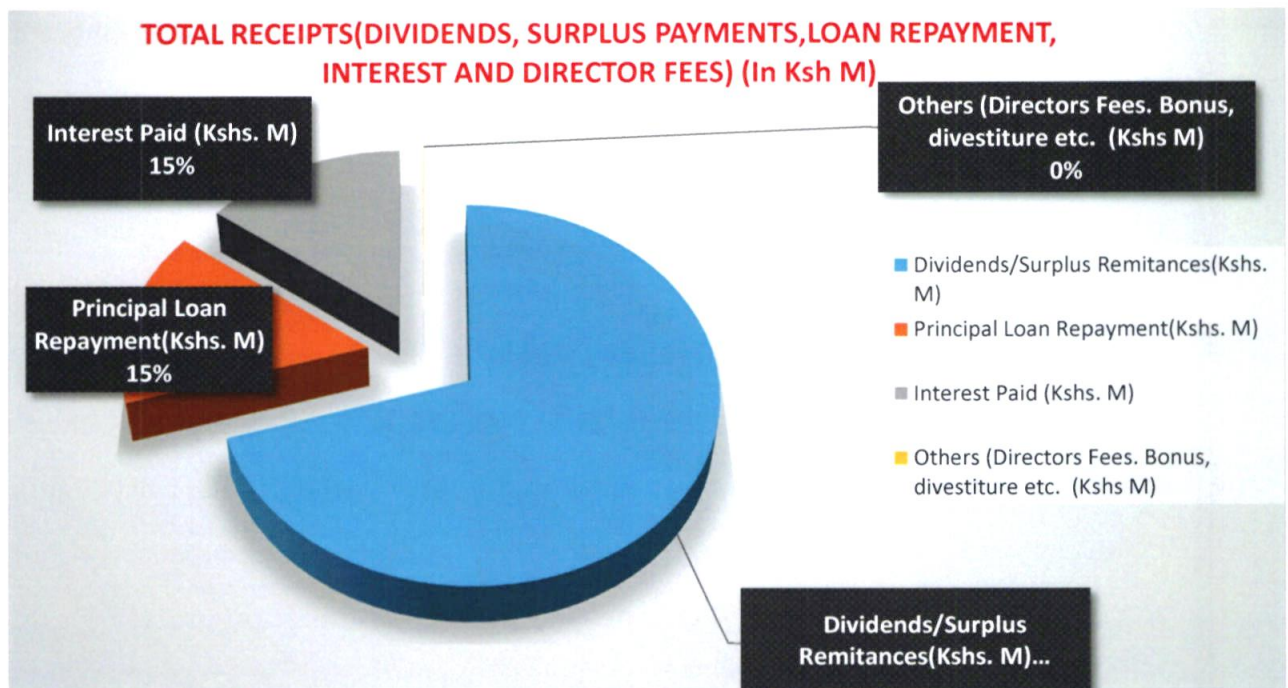


Figure 5: Total Receipts (dividends, surplus payments, loan repayment, interest and directors fees)

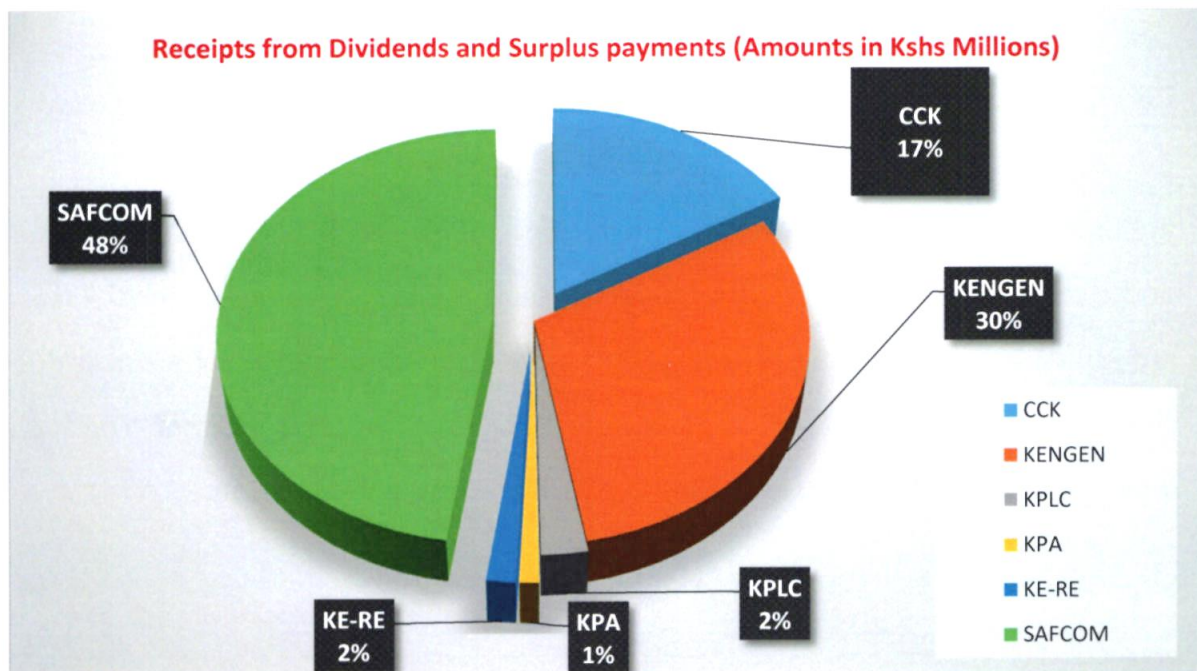


Figure 6: Receipts from dividends and surplus payments (Amounts in KShs Millions)

19. During the year under review, revenue receipts by Government from State Corporations in respect of Loan Repayment, Interest Charges and Directors’ Fees amounted to Kshs. 2,133 Million, Kshs. 2,036 Million and Kshs. 9 Million respectively.
