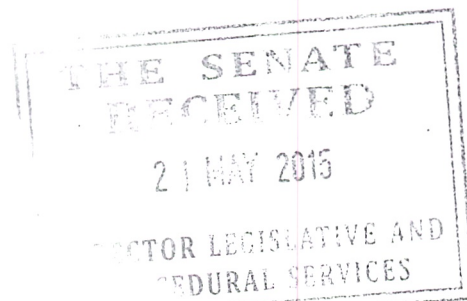

I refer to your letter of April 22nd, 2015 on the above captioned subject.

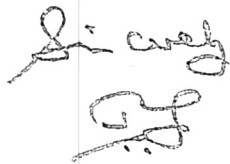
