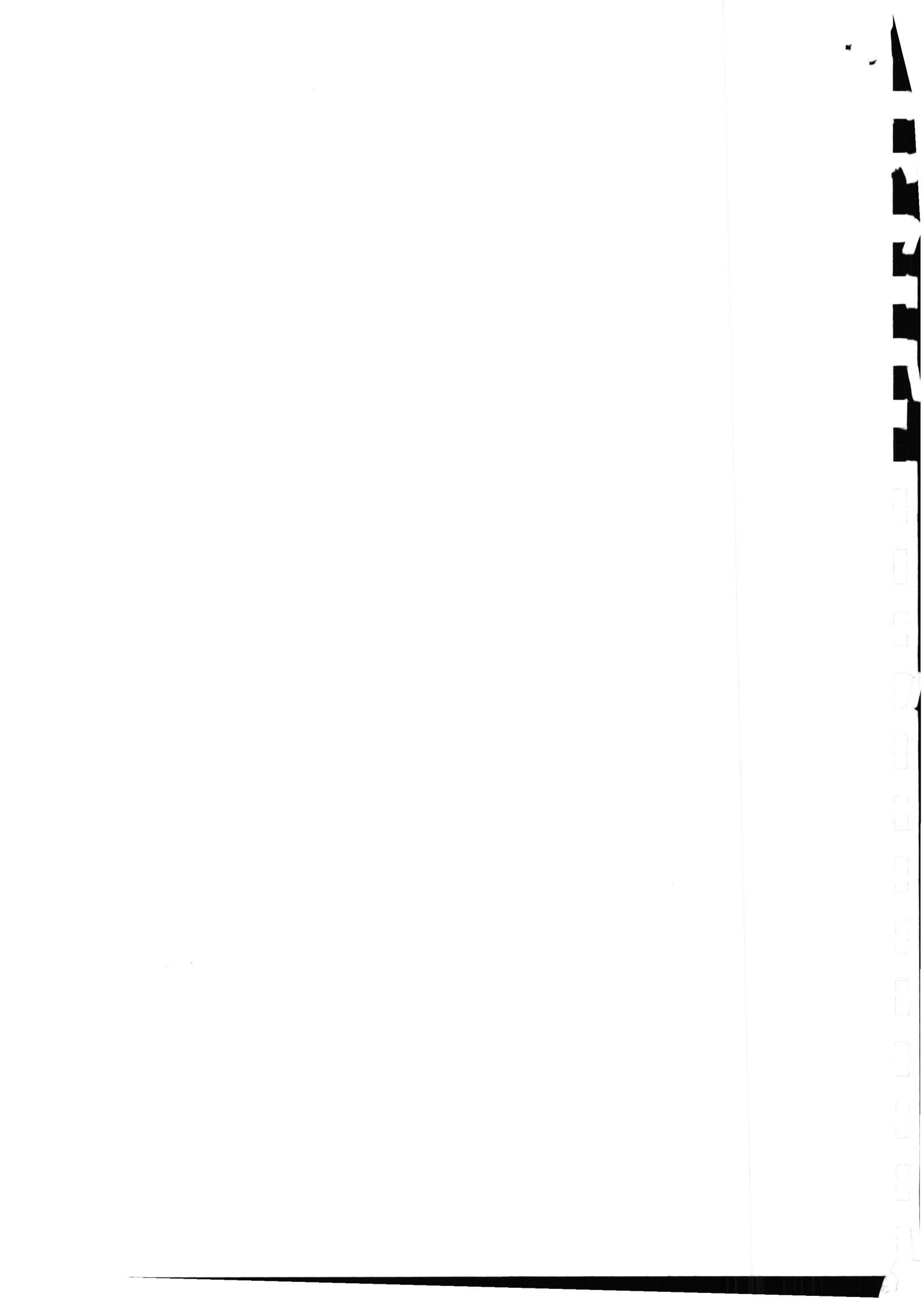

## PREFACE

This is the 2018/2019 FY edition of the *Consolidated National Government Investment Report*, published in compliance with Section 89 of the Public Financial Management Act, 2012. The Report, which the PFM Act requires the Cabinet Secretary responsible for public investments to submit to Parliament, gives a comprehensive status of public (national government) investments for the period 2018/2019 FY. These investments are primarily in state corporations and government linked corporations. To date, the National Treasury has submitted the 2013/2014FY, 2014/2015FY, 2015/2016FY, 2016/2017FY and 2017/2018 FY reports.

As in the earlier editions, the 2018/2019 FY edition provides information of national government participation in state corporations and government linked corporations in four (4) main areas, namely (i) shareholding/equity and funding; (ii) grants and subsidies; (iii) loans and guarantees; and (iv) revenue receipts.

During the 2018/2019 FY, a total of **Kshs.611,764 million** of revenues was generated from state corporations' internal sources, and GoK grants/subsidies amounting to **Kshs.365,280 million** were disbursed, comprising recurrent and development grants of **Kshs.197,548 million** and **Kshs.167,731 million**, respectively – a 13% growth from the previous financial year. It is noteworthy that during the year, there was a 13% decrease in profits and surpluses from **Kshs.83,882 million** to **Kshs.54,596**. The decrease was mainly due to depressed profits from East African Portland cement, Kenya Pipeline Company, Kenya Railways Corporation and Kenya Reinsurance Corporation. In the same period, the shareholding (nominal) increased marginally by **Kshs.39 million** to **Kshs.104,036 million**, with a moderate 9% increase in net assets to **Kshs.2,837,643 million**. GOK received **Kshs.26,945 million** from public investment in form of dividends, surplus and directors' fees during the year.

Besides investment by way of shareholding, the national government continued to provide resources for investment in hard infrastructure with a view to improving the productive capacity of the nation. During the year, the sector procured a total of **Kshs.223, 667 million** in form of loans, of which the national government disbursed a total of **Kshs.38,663 million** in form of direct and on-lent loans. The total indebtedness (total debt portfolio) amounts to **Kshs.1,014,772 million**, of which total un-discharged (outstanding) GoK loans

amounted to **Kshs.847,202 million**, an increase of **Kshs.178,893 million**. Of this amount, a total of **Kshs.481,265 million** relates to Kenya Railways alone. On un-discharged guarantees, it is noted that even though there was no new GOK guarantee issued in 2018/2019 FY, the level of guarantees rose from **Kshs. 136,705 million** in 2018 to **Kshs. 159,406 million** as at June 30, 2019. On the other hand, the level of contingent liabilities increased by 2% from Kshs.396,336 million in 2017/18 FY to Kshs.404,409 million during 2018/19 FY.

In order to get full value for our investments, we will continue to promote good corporate governance practices in the sub-sector and ensure that there is sufficient technical capacity to roll out the programmes in an efficient and timely manner, always keeping in mind that our investments are not an end in themselves but for the effective and efficient service delivery to the Kenyan citizens.

I wish to underscore that we at the National Treasury continuously strive to improve the content and style of reporting in every report to ensure that each is as accurate and informative as possible. This way, Parliament (and other stakeholders) would find the reports useful in the discharge of their mandates. This 2018/2019 FY report is no exception and, in fulfillment of that objective, a lot of diligence and data validation has been done.

As I conclude, I wish to thank all the Principal Secretaries as well as Chief Executive Officers of state corporations for facilitating and responding in a timely manner in the information requirements. I also thank the officers at the National Treasury who put in quality time and effort in ensuring that this report was ready within the set timelines.

Finally, I caution that these numbers are largely un-audited and, therefore, care should be taken when using or interpreting them.

### Legal Basis for the Consolidated National Government Investment Report

The Consolidated National Government Investment Report is prepared in accordance with Section 89 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 which states as follows:

- (1) The Cabinet Secretary responsible for matters relating to public investments shall prepare and submit to the National Assembly, not later than four months after the end of each financial year, a consolidated report summarizing the extent of national government involvement or investment in, or funding of, all state corporations and government-linked corporations for that financial year.
- (2) The report under subsection (1) shall include information on-
  - a) the date of incorporation and objects of the corporation;
  - b) the amount of national government shareholding, directly or indirectly, in the state corporation;
  - c) any changes in the shareholding of the state corporation during the financial year;
  - d) the amount of any funding in the form of grants or subsidies provided by the national government to the state corporation or government-linked state corporations, excluding profit-making state corporation, during the financial year;
  - e) the amount of any loans made by the national government to the state corporation, and the amount of any guarantees issued by the national government in respect of the state corporation, during the financial year;
  - f) the cumulative amount of undischarged loans and guarantees in respect of the state corporation;
  - g) the amount of the profit/surplus or loss/deficit of the state corporation for the financial year;
  - h) the amount of any revenue received by the national government from the state corporation during the financial year, including dividends, interest and proceeds from any divestiture of assets of the state corporation;
  - i) the amount of payments made, or losses incurred, by the national government to meet contingent liabilities as a result of loans or guarantees during the financial year, including payments made in respect of guarantees, loan write-offs or waiver of interest on loans; and
  - j) An assessment of the financial and related non-financial performance of the state corporation for the financial year.
- (3) Once every three years, the Cabinet Secretary responsible for matters relating to public investments shall prepare a report on the assessment of the national government's continued involvement or investment in, or funding of, the state corporation or government linked corporation.
- (4) The Cabinet Secretary responsible for matters relating to public investments shall submit copies of the reports referred to in subsections (2) and (3) to the Cabinet Secretary, the Controller of Budget, the Commission on Revenue Allocation and to the Auditor-General



### State Corporations and Government Linked Corporations

1. The State Corporations Act, Cap 446, is the over-arching governing law on the establishment, fiduciary oversight on management and governance; and financial control of State Corporations.
2. State Corporations or Parastatals are legal entities established by Government or investments in which the government holds over fifty (50) per cent control or ownership. They implement priority government policies, projects and programmes in social, business and commercial sectors of the economy.
3. They are incorporated under the Companies Act or an enabling Act of Parliament in which whole or controlling shareholding belongs to the Government. State Corporations are therefore, distinct legal entities that are operationally autonomous from Government and may be self-financing through internally-generated funds, loans backed by their assets, partially funded or fully financed by the Exchequer.
4. State Corporations are categorized as commercial and non-commercial. Commercial State Corporations comprise:
  - a. Companies with GoK shareholding, through the Cabinet Secretary to the National Treasury as a body corporate, of more than 50%;
  - b. A body Corporate established to perform a strategic function profitably,
  - c. An entity that generally operates on commercial principles,
  - d. Generally self-financing and sustaining, except in financing investment for public policy objectives; and
  - e. Accountable to all stakeholders and the public through the relevant departmental and oversight committees of Parliament.
5. For the Commercial State Corporations with “public goods” mandate, the GoK is required to meet the full cost of those “public good” activities using budgetary resources approved by Parliament.
6. Non-Commercial State Corporations are expected to operate on a cost recovery basis and largely depend on monies appropriated by Parliament, levies and fees. They include regulatory agencies and statutory boards; research institutions; institutions of higher learning and referral hospitals. Non-Commercial State Corporations deliver services on behalf of line Ministries and are funded mainly through the National Budgets in form of grants or loans from the Government.
7. Besides State Corporations, the Government also invests in other organizations, commonly referred to as Government Linked Corporations (GLC). GLCs are entities in which the Government’s shareholding is fifty (50) per cent and below. The Government participates in GLCs primarily to correct market failures and also partake in profit sharing in profitable enterprises to augment public resources.
8. The investments in GLCs in particular target perceived high risk investments from the private sector perspective, but in themselves have a high impact to the economy.

## I Introduction

1. The Government remains committed to deliver services to its people uplift their standards of living and achieve a high standard of living and prosperity. These policy intentions are clearly enunciated in various policy documents.
2. To achieve these noble long-term goals and objectives, the Government has over the years implemented several long-term development plans, each with specific objectives and outcomes. The Vision 2030 strategy currently being pursued by the Government aims at making Kenya a globally competitive and prosperous nation with a high quality of life for its citizens by 2030 in a clean and secure environment.
3. The Vision 2030 was programmed for implementation through five-year medium-term plans (MTP). The Government implemented the first two medium term plans (MTP1 and MTP2) with tremendous achievements in electricity generation, transmission and distribution; expansion of road networks; telecommunication connectivity; expansion of water provision; access to education; higher quality of health provision etc. The MTP3 was rolled out in 2018/2019 Financial Year and will largely be implemented through and driven by the Big Four Agenda, with a focus on issues that would have the greatest impact on the well-being of our people, i.e. food security, affordable housing, manufacturing and affordable healthcare for all.
4. To achieve the Vision 2030, the Government has deliberately separated the role of policy formulation and oversight to the line Ministries and transferred the responsibility for implementation of these policies to its agencies, mainly the State Corporations sector, that have better capacity and focus to implement the Government agenda.
5. Among the Commercial State Corporations with “public goods” mandate for which GoK is required to meet the full cost of those activities using budgetary resources approved by Parliament are Kenya Broadcasting Corporation, Kenya Ferry Services Limited and National Cereals and Produce Board as it relates to Strategic Grain Reserves.
6. Notable organizations driving the national development agenda are the infrastructure State Corporations among them the roads subsector (KURA, KERRA & KENHA); the energy subsector (Kenya Electricity Generating Company (KENGEN) & Kenya Power Kenya, GDC, Ketraco); transport subsector (Railways Corporation (KRC), Kenya Ports Authority (KPA), Kenya Airports Authority (KAA)); water subsector ( water works development agencies) and ICT Authority. In addition to infrastructure State Corporations, the Government has established the Lamu Port-South Sudan-

Ethiopia Transport (LAPSET) Corridor and the Special Economic Zones authority to spearhead opening up of new economic blocks. The Government has also established State Corporations in the health sector, financial sector; Research Institutions and Universities among others.

7. The operationalization of Phase I of the Standard Gauge Railway (SGR) from Mombasa to Nairobi has enabled Kenyans to enjoy cheaper and faster travels between Mombasa and Nairobi using Madaraka Express. In addition, the SGR freight service that started in January 2018, has facilitated cheaper movement of goods, with monthly loads increasing from the initial 22,345 metric tonnes to an impressive 213,559 metric tonnes, a ten-fold increase in only a few months. The construction work for Phase II of the Standard Gauge Railway from Nairobi to Naivasha is in progress. In 2018/2019 Financial Year, roads agencies; KeNHA, KURA and KeRRA were able to upgrade 516.22 km of roads to Bitumen Standard, reconstructed and rehabilitated 220 km and constructed 1,403 km under the low volume seal roads strategy. Further, road agencies periodically maintained 1,114.6 km of roads, routine maintenance of 39,324.49 km, constructed 20 new bridges, completed detailed designs for 1,506.7 km and constructed 165.6 km of pedestrian walkways. The Government also pursued implementation of major ICT investments including the expansion of the Fibre Optic Backbone Infrastructure across the Counties thus facilitating reliable high-speed networks and supported e-government service and innovation among businesses.
8. In order to enhance the contribution of the State Corporations to the Country's economic and social progress, key reforms aimed at addressing systemic weaknesses and challenges facing the individual institutions in the Parastatal sub-sector will be pursued. The specific restructuring initiatives will include merging of the Industrial and Commercial Development Corporation (ICDC) with the Industrial Development Bank (IDB) and the Tourism Finance Corporation (TFC) to create the Kenya Development Bank with enhanced capacity to meet the financing requirements of key sector; and implementation of initiatives to address the challenges of government investments in the banking sector. The merging process of ICDC, TFC and IDB are at an advanced stage. It is noted that in 2018/2019 FY, the merging of Export Promotion Council and Brand Kenya was completed to form the Kenya Export Promotion and Branding Agency (KEPROBA).
9. The Government Privatization Programme remains on course. The Privatization objectives aims at unlocking the potential of the identified to capacity expansion, modernization, performance and efficiency improvement, mobilization of private capital, improved competitiveness and reduced reliance on public financing. Arising from change in policy objectives however, the cabinet approved the removal of Kenya Pipeline Company, KenGen, New KCC and National Bank of Kenya from the

privatization program in 2018/2019 FY.

10. On privatization of hotels, the offer to transfer shares of TFC made in 2014 by the Privatization Commission of Kenya to the other shareholders of Hilton Hotel, Intercontinental Hotel, Mountain Lodge and The Ark Hotel expired without successful offers. The PCK has therefore restarted the privatization process of these hotels. The privatization process of other hotels i.e. Kabranet Hotels, Mt Elgon Hotel Limited, Kenya Safari Lodges and Hotels is ongoing.
11. In regard to the privatization of sugar companies, structured engagements with all primary stakeholders in the sugar industry are on-going. Consultations have been held with the Council of Governors with a view to identifying sustainable solutions to the challenges facing the operations of the state-owned sugar milling companies.
12. This Report comprises of the following five statements as required under the PFM Act 2012: -
  - (i) Consolidated Statement of National Government Shareholding/Equity and Funding of State Corporations and Government-Linked Corporations;
  - (ii) National Government Shareholding/Equity in State Corporations and Government-Linked Corporations;
  - (iii) National Government Grants and Subsidies to State Corporations and Government-Linked Corporations;
  - (iv) Loans and Guarantees by National Government to State Corporations and Government-Linked Corporations;
  - (v) Statement of Revenue Receipts from State Corporations;

## II. Status of Government Involvement in State Corporations in 2018/2019 Financial Year

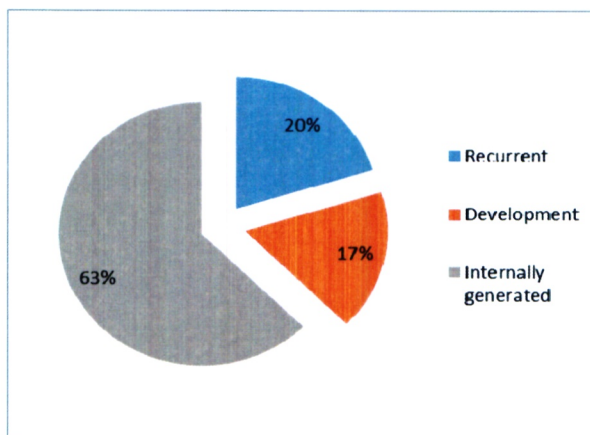
13. A summary of the National Government involvement in Public Investments is as summarized in **Schedule A**. In 2018/2019 Financial Year, the total GOK shareholding in nominal terms was **Kshs.104,036 million** up from **Kshs.103,998 million** in 2017/2018 Financial Year. The increase in GoK shareholding was attributed to National Bank paying dividends in form of shares.
14. The total revenues (internally generated funds) increased by 4 per cent from **Kshs.583,007 million** in 2017/2018 Financial Year to **Kshs.611,764 million** in 2018/2019 Financial Year. The Total assets increased by 12 per cent from **Kshs.4,555,818 million** in 2017/2018 Financial Year to **Kshs.5,103,376 million** in 2018/2019 Financial Year. The increase is mainly attributable to the growth in infrastructure development under the Ministry of Transport, infrastructure housing development; Kenya Railways with total assets amounting to **Kshs.759,470 million** and

KeNHA with total assets amounting to **Kshs.471,601 million**. The increase in Kenya Railways assets is due to investment in the Standard Gauge Railways SGR and KeNHA is mainly due to investments in the road sector.

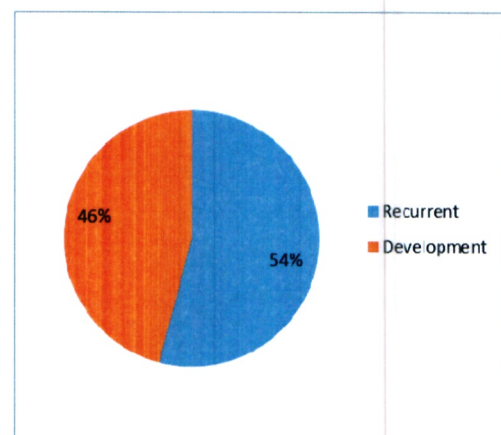
**III. Grants and Subsidies**

- 15. Total revenue of State Corporations in 2018/2019 FY was **Kshs.977,043 million** compared with **Kshs.907,689 million** in 2017/2018 FY. During the same period, total grants and subsidies to State Corporations were **Kshs.365,280 million** compared with **Kshs.324,682 million** in the previous year. During 2018/2019 financial year, 46% of total Government grants was for development and the remainder for recurrent.
- 16. State Corporations generated approximately **Kshs.611,764 million** in 2018/2019 Financial Year which accounted for about 63% of total revenue within the State Corporations subsector with the remainder (37%) coming from Government grants.

**Revenue of State Corporations 2018/19**



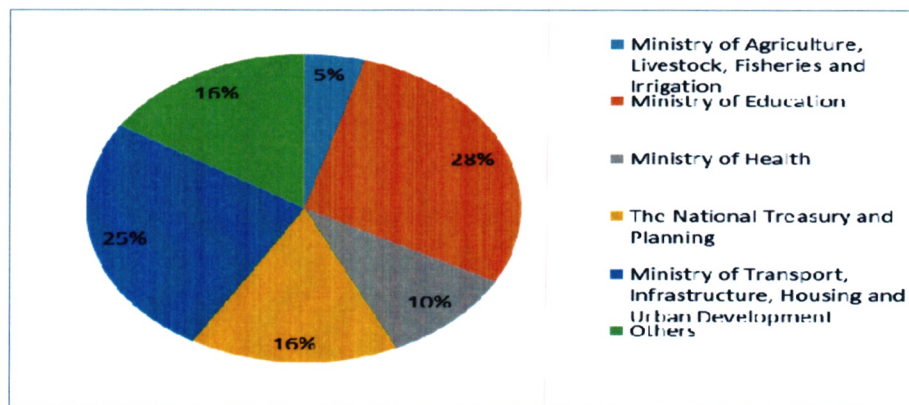
**Govt Grants and Subsidies 2018/19**

17. The State Corporations under the Ministry of Education received the highest transfers of recurrent grants at **Kshs.55,933 million** in 2018/2019 Financial Year. This allocation was mainly to public universities. State Corporations under the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure, Housing and Urban Development received second highest allocation of recurrent grants amounting to **Kshs.50,287 million**. The recurrent grants for State Corporation under the State Department of infrastructure were mainly from the Road Maintenance Levy Fund.

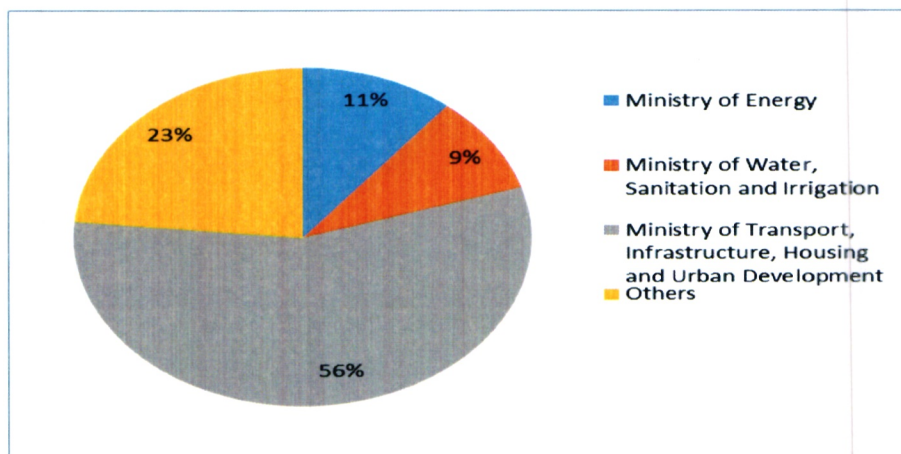
**Government Recurrent Grant to State Corporations under selected Ministries

18. In 2018/2019 Financial Year, allocation of Government Development Grants to State Corporations under the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure, and Housing account for 56% of the total allocation at **Kshs.93,775 million**. The Ministry of Energy received 11% at **Kshs.18,130 million** while Ministry of Water, Sanitation and Irrigation received 9% of Development Grants in 2018/2019 at **Kshs.15,532 million**. The remaining 24% was allocated to corporations in the other ministries.

#### IV. Financial Performance

19. Financial reporting by Commercial State Corporations is in accordance with the International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) while financial reporting by non-commercial State Corporations reports is in accordance with International Public Sector Accounting Standards (IPSAS). Consequently, commercial State Corporations reports as either having made a profit/loss while the non-commercial and regulatory bodies reports a surplus/deficit. During 2018/2019 Financial Year, State Corporations posted accumulated decreased profits/surplus amounting to **Kshs.54,596 million** compared to **Kshs.83,882 million** posted in 2017/2018 Financial Year mainly due to decreased profits from commercial state corporations. In 2018/2019 Financial Year commercial state corporations posted net profit amounting to **Kshs.22,073 million** as compared to **Kshs.49,715 million** posted in 2017/2018 Financial Year. The decrease was mainly due to depressed profits from East African Portland cement, Kenya Pipeline Company, Kenya Railways Corporation and Kenya Reinsurance Corporation.

#### V. National Government Loans and Guarantees to State Corporations

20. Under the State Corporations Act, State Corporations have legal capacity to contract debts and other liabilities to finance their requirements. Approval to procure such loans however, must be obtained from the Parent Ministry with the concurrence of the National Treasury as required under the State Corporations Act. Loans to State Corporations are either direct or on-lent. Direct loans refer to loans that the Government lends to State Corporations from exchequer resources. On the other

hand, on lent-loans are procured by GOK mainly from bilateral and multilateral sources and on-lend to State Corporations. Capital grants or loans to State Corporations are effected through a Subsidiary Loan/ Grant Agreements between the National Treasury and the individual State Corporations. The Loan/Grant Subsidiary Agreements spell out the terms and conditions of the financing.

21. When a State Corporation's Statement of Financial Position is not able to support a debt for a project that is of national importance, the National Government may be called upon to provide a guarantee. The National Treasury however, provide a guarantee upon approval by Parliament. The debt may be denominated in foreign or domestic currencies. As at June 30, 2019 total outstanding Government guaranteed debt was **Kshs.159,405 million** from **Kshs.138,803 million** as at June 30, 2018. It is to be noted that even though the Government did not issue new guarantees during 2018/2019 FY, the total stock of guarantees increased. The increase to the tune of **Kshs.20,602 million** was attributed to drawdown of the already guaranteed debt as detained in the Table below.

Except for Kenya Broadcasting Corporation, East African Portland Cement and Tana Athi River Development Authority who have defaulted in their obligation to repay GoK guarantee loans, the other State Corporations are servicing their loans. In 2017/2018 Financial Year, GoK paid a total sum of **Kshs.1,374 million** on behalf of State Corporations that were in financial distress that comprised of **Kshs.301 million** on behalf of Tana Athi River Development Authority, **Kshs.379 million** on behalf of East African Portland Cement and **Kshs.739 million** on behalf of Kenya Broadcasting Corporation.

22. Total undischarged GOK loans to State Corporations stood at **736,686 million** by the end of 2018/2019 Financial Year compared with **Kshs. 667,684 million** in 2017/2018 Financial Year. The increase was attributed to loans procured by the Government and on-lent to Kenya Railways Corporations for the implementation of the Standard Gauge Railway. Consequently, the Kenya Railways had the highest stock of undischarged GOK on-lent loans at **Kshs. 481,265 million** followed by Kenya Broadcasting Corporation (KBC) at **Kshs 71,303 million**, KenGen with **Kshs. 80,087 million** as at 30<sup>th</sup> June 2019. Others were Kenya power and lighting, **Kshs. 45,119 million**, Nzoia Sugar Company **Kshs. 38,686 million** and Athi Water Works Development Agency, **Kshs. 13,201million**. Update numbers.

## VI. Contingent Liabilities

23. As the principal owner of all State Corporations, the Government is the natural underwriter of risk that they face. Analysis of contingent liabilities therefore, is important in understanding the extent of the Government fiscal risks exposure.
24. Contingent liabilities are potential liabilities that may occur depending on the outcome of uncertain future event and are generally not shown in the statement of financial position, but must be given adequate disclosure. However, a contingent liability is only recorded in the financial statements if the contingency is probable and the amount of the liability can reasonably be estimated. Contingent liability can be explicit or implicit. Explicit contingent liabilities are specific government obligations established by law or a contract authorized by law. The government is legally mandated to settle such an obligation when it becomes due. On the other hand, implicit contingent liabilities represent a moral obligation or expected burden for the government not in the legal sense, but based on public expectations and political pressures e.g. GOK intervention in revival of Uchumi supermarket, revival bid of Mumias Sugar Company and Kenya Airways.
25. In 2018/2019 Financial Year, total exposure in form of contingent liabilities was **Kshs.404,409 million** compared with **Kshs.396,336 million** in 2017/2018 Financial Year. Out of the **Kshs. 404,409 million** total contingent liabilities **Kshs. 240,000 million** was attributed to claim against Kenya Broadcasting Corporations over claims that it breached a contract regarding the launching of a TV channel and the digital migration process.

**VII. Revenue Receipts by National Government from State Corporations and Government-Linked Corporations**

26. The receipts by the National Treasury from State Corporations and Government-linked companies are in form of dividends, loan repayments, and interest on loans, surplus remittances and director's fees. In 2018/2019 Financial Year, total receipts by National Treasury amounted to **Kshs.30,569 Million**. Receipts from dividends, surplus funds and directors fees during this period were **Kshs.26,945 million** representing 88 per cent of total receipts. The highest amount of dividend was from Safaricom Ltd. at **Kshs.15,427 million**.
27. During the year under review, revenue receipts by Government from State Corporations in respect of Loan Repayment and Interest Charges amounted to **Kshs.1,243 million** and **Kshs.2,382 million** in 2017/2018 Financial Year and 2018/2019 Financial Year respectively.
