



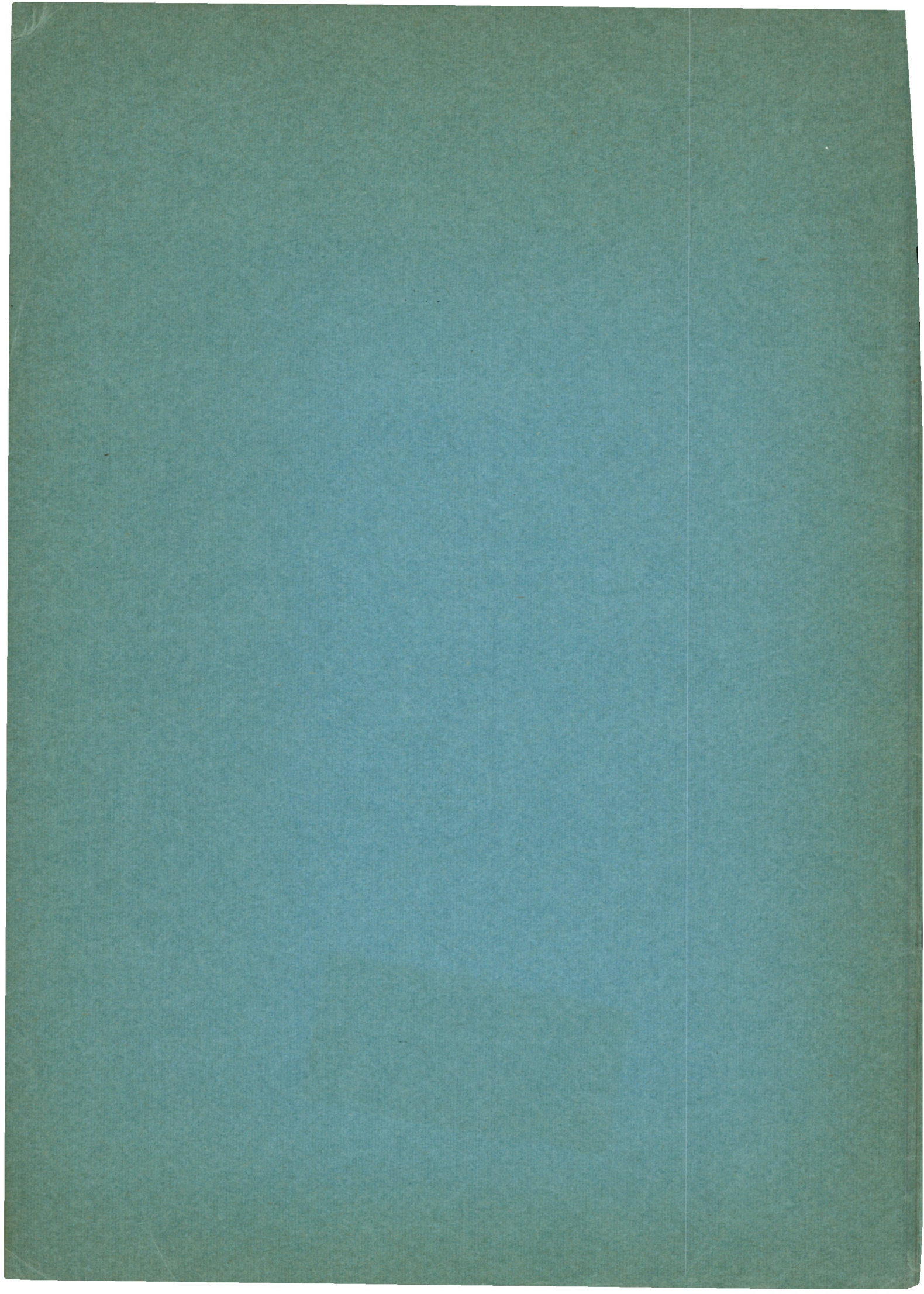

# **REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL FOR THE YEAR 1971**

## **REVIEW OF THE YEAR**

Once again I have to report a considerable increase in the work of most sections of the Department which continued to place a great strain on both the staff and accommodation and record storage space.

The Trade Marks and Patent Registries were moved at the end of the year to the Kenya School of Law in order to provide additional space until the new extensions were completed but even with this move the available space continued to be inadequate.

The revenue of the Department again showed a significant increase, fees received being some 20 per cent more than the 1970 figure whilst estate duty collected was more than 50 per cent in excess of the amount collected in the previous year.

## **COMPANIES SECTION**

The section comprises the registries of Companies, Business Names, Limited Partnerships and Chattels Transfers.

The number of new companies, both public and private, incorporated during the year was 984 compared with 866 in the previous year. The amount of nominal capital of the new companies together with increases in capital of the existing companies was £31,143,648 compared with £24,340,844 in 1970.

There are 32 foreign companies registered and 12 such companies removed from the register during the year.

A total of 8,247 locally incorporated companies were on the register at 31st December, 1971 of which 446 were public and 7,801 were private. The number of foreign companies on the register stood at 763 at the end of the year, showing an increase of 20 compared with the previous year.

Of the new companies incorporated in the year, 33 per cent were formed by the African community, 38 per cent by the Asian community, 15 per cent by the European community and 14 per cent by persons of two or more communal groups. The corresponding figures for the previous year were, African 30 per cent, Asian 37 per cent, European 13 per cent, and African, Asian and European 20 per cent. Out of the 14 per cent of the companies formed by persons of two or more communal groups, the majority of these were from the African community.

Out of the 49 public companies formed, 42 were formed by Africans, and the remaining seven were formed by Africans with other communal groups.

## **BUSINESS NAMES**

The registration of new businesses was again the highest ever recorded with 4,404 firms registered, compared with 4,280 in 1970. The number of changes registered in the particulars of existing businesses was 2,052 compared with 1,600 in the previous year. Three hundred and eighty business names were removed from the register during the year, leaving a total of 48,481 on the register at the 31st December, 1971.

## **CHATTELS TRANSFER**

The volume of borrowing on security by way of Chattels Transfers was reduced by £223,216, the total amount borrowed being £5,909,871. A total of 19,861 instruments and 707 satisfactions were registered.

## TRADE MARKS AND PATENTS REGISTRY

There was an increase in the number of patent registrations during the year, the percentage increase over that of the previous year being 15 per cent whilst the number of initial trade mark applications and related matters showed a slight increase, the number of trade mark registrations constituted a marked increase over that of the previous year, the latter percentage being 115 per cent.

There was an amendment to the Trade Marks Rules during the year governing the fees payable on taxation of bills of costs which was published as Legal Notice No. 138, in the Kenya Gazette Supplement No. 53 of 2nd July, 1971.

### Patents

There is as yet no machinery for the original registration of patents in Kenya, the law providing only for re-registration of patents previously granted in the United Kingdom. This registration has the effect of extending the patentee's rights to the patent to Kenya. In respect of these patents 122 were registered during the year making a total at 31st December, 1971 of 2,120 which have been registered in Kenya. The number of live patents on the Register at the same date was 1,402.

### Trade Marks

Statistics relating to the general work of the Trade Marks and Patents Registry, with comparative figures for the last decade, are shown in Appendix VI whilst an analysis of marks registered according to the classification of goods contained in the Third Schedule to the Trade Marks Rules is contained in Appendix VII. Statistics of applications and registration still reveal the same lively interest in the classification of goods covering patent medicines, cosmetics and domestic cleansing preparations and chemical products.

Applications from Kenya nationals continued to show the same interest generally in the manufacture of clothing, cosmetics, domestic cleansing preparations and the manufacture of food. The number of live trade marks on the Register as at 31st December, 1971 was 13,705.

## BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES SECTION

This section carries out the work connected with the Registrar-General's duties, as Registrar of Births, Deaths and Marriages under the Births and Deaths Registration Act, the Legitimacy Act, the Adoption Act, the Marriage Act and the African Christian Marriage and Divorce Act.

### Population

The population of Kenya was estimated at 11,694,000 on 1st July, 1971. This represented an increase in the country's inhabitants of approximately 751,295 since the last national census in August 1969 or an increase of 7 per cent. The larger part of the increase can be attributed to the excess of births over deaths since net gain through migration is negligible.

About 88 per cent of the country's population on 1st July, 1971 lived in rural areas. Since the last census, in 1969, there has been a noticeable gain through rural/urban migration in each of the Republic's urban areas, thus following the pattern in all developing nations.

The estimated population in compulsory registration areas before 1st September, 1971 was estimated at 7,710,000. The estimated completeness of birth registration in 1971, based on this population, was 69 per cent according to the events reported and registered by Registrars.

With the increased use of hospitals and maternity homes for delivery today, coupled with more effective feed-back exercises, it is estimated that more than 70 per cent of births in compulsory registration areas are now being registered and more people in rural areas are now coming forward to report events which have occurred in their households than was the case some years ago. There still remain certain areas in the country, however, where registration of vital events needs to be improved.

## **Births**

The number of births to residents of compulsory registration areas in 1971, set yet a new record of 236,847 births registered generating a crude birth rate of about 30 per 1,000 population of the areas concerned. This shows a significant increase over the previous year's figure when 183,924 births were registered.

With this report, additional tables for 1970 birth registration data have been included as it was not possible to have the analysis made early enough to be included in the 1970 Annual Report. Five appendices, i.e. analysis of births by parity (number of previous births to mother), births by mother's normal residence, still births and births according to exact place of occurrence are included.

Of great interest, however, is the table on parity which indicates that many births in compulsory registration areas, are contributed by mothers under 25 years of age, whereas approximately, 28 per cent of the total births are first child of the parents, and less than 1 per cent, is the tenth or more issue of the parents.

About 60 per cent of the births in 1970, occurred in hospitals and related medical institutions and the proportion was highest amongst residents of Nairobi City (97 per cent).

## **Deaths**

The number of deaths registered was 47,534 (26,953 males and 20,581 females) showing an increase of 4,204 over the comparative figure for 1970.

### **Infant Deaths**

The infant death rate in compulsory registration areas for 1971 was 96 deaths per 1,000 live births. This is 23 per cent below the estimated national rate of 124 deaths per 1,000 live births.

### **Deaths by Exact Place of Death**

More than 40 per cent of the deaths occurred in hospitals and other related institutions compared with 39 per cent in 1970. The proportion was highest in Nairobi City with more than 70 per cent.

## **Marriages**

The number of marriages registered under the Marriage Act in 1971 within Kenya was 1,061 which was 107 more than in the previous year. 28 marriages which were solemnized outside Kenya in respect of Kenya nationals were also registered. Under the African Christian Marriage and Divorce Act, 17,819 marriages were celebrated, giving a total registration during the year of 18,908 marriages, an increase of 1,967 over the previous year.

### **Late Registration of Births**

There were 45,091 births registered in 1971 after the statutory time allowed for registration had elapsed. This shows an increase of 16 per cent over the comparative figures for 1970. There were 209 late registrations of deaths, compared with 413 during the previous year.

## **General**

It proved possible to extend compulsory registration to the remaining administrative districts during the year. These were Baringo, Kajiado, Laikipia, Nandi, Narok, Samburu, West Pokot, Turkana, Garissa, Isiolo, Mandera, Marsabit, Tana River and Kitui.

The general picture shows a considerable increase in the number of events registered. Of particular interest, however, is that some districts are now able to claim to register between 40 to 50 registrations of births per 1,000 population, which would indicate an estimated percentage completeness of birth registration in excess of 90 per cent of the expected number.

Of great interest, and it is hoped of help to the general public was the exhibition of our services at the 1971 Nairobi Show where volunteer staff from the Department dealt with a massive number of inquiries, estimated at over 30,000 and well over 15,000 late births were registered and certificates issued.

### **Caution**

Characteristics peculiar to certain areas such as proximity to municipal and urban hospitals or institutions affect the vital statistics of these areas as residents from outside the areas use the facilities without the correct indication of their normal residence.

The accuracy of the tables depends primarily on the registration of all births and deaths. There may be some doubt whether this is always done especially in remote areas of the country where communication with the general public is difficult. Whilst failure to register births is not so common, it would appear that a considerable number of deaths are not registered.

Many factors, therefore, must be considered for the correct interpretation of vital statistics and it must be clearly stated that anything which affects the denominator or numerator of the births, deaths and marriages statistics described in the following appendices will necessarily affect the rates resulting from the computation. Limiting factors to be kept in mind when interpreting the data are as follows:—

- (a) errors in residence determining which affect the count of births and deaths allocated to the district as a whole;
- (b) under-registration which results in under-counts of events;
- (c) errors in population estimation and enumeration which affect any rate requiring a population base for computation;
- (d) the efficiency of the cause of death coding and the clarity and accuracy of cause of death certification by laymen (deputy registrars) which affect the counts for deaths allocated to specific causes of deaths.

Great care, therefore, should be taken in comparing a change in the rate where the frequency of the event is small. A change in one or two events may result in a large percentage in the relative statistics. Any Index should be evaluated on the basis of quality, validity and size of both the denominator and numerator used to derive the rate or ratio.

### **PUBLIC TRUSTEE SECTION**

This section carries out the administration of estates of deceased persons under the Public Trustee Act and the management of trusts accepted under such Act. In the majority of cases the Public Trustee undertakes the administration of those estates where the assets are unadministered either because there is no heir who is prepared or is available to apply for Letters of Administration or because the executor or administrator previously appointed has died or cannot be traced. In some cases the Public Trustee is specifically appointed to be an executor by a testator but in such cases the consent of the Public Trustee is required at the time of making the Will. The advantages of appointing the Public Trustee to be an executor are, first, that there is guaranteed continuity of office by virtue of the Public Trustee's status as a corporation sole, and secondly, the fees charged by the Public Trustee for undertaking and completing the administration of estates are strictly regulated by statute and are not, therefore, subject to rapid change.

In addition, the Public Trustee undertakes the administration of trust estates. In many cases where a minor is entitled to a legacy or share of the assets of a deceased person and, not infrequently, where an award is made by a Court to a person not of full age, the executor or administrator, with the consent of the Public Trustee or the Court, as the case may be, transfers such legacy, share or award to the Public Trustee, who establishes a trust with it. This is administered by the Public Trustee until the whole trust fund is paid over to the former minor upon his or her attaining the age of majority.

The Public Trustee also administers trust estates which contain no provision for their maturing after the expiration of a stipulated period and for the trust funds then being paid over to the particular beneficiaries. Common examples of such trusts are those which are set up for purposes such as the furtherance of education, charity, recreation, etc. The duration of such trusts is by their nature frequently extremely lengthy. In such cases the fact that the Public Trustee is a corporation sole is particularly useful as the trust funds vest in the holder of the office and not in individual trustees. Consequently, the delay and expense involved in the transfer of funds from individual trustees to their successors in office are obviated.

The Public Trustee is also from time to time appointed manager of the estates of persons of unsound mind under the Mental Treatment Act, and is required to make an annual report on accounts submitted by other managers during the course of each year.

During the year we once again experienced an increase in the work in the hands of the Public Trustee. One thousand three hundred and nineteen new estates were accepted for administration, but one thousand and thirty-five estates were wound-up and distributed. Though twenty-four new trusts were accepted only ten were finally discharged. The administration and trust causes still actively in hand therefore increased by seventy-seven. The steady increase in current work reflects changing social conditions, particularly the continued toll of lives in motor-car accidents which results in payments of large sums by insurance companies by way of compensation, and also the increased use of life insurance by individuals and payment of death grants or gratuities by employers, all of which result in comparatively large sums of money coming into what would otherwise have been very small estates.

It is hoped that the opening of Sheria House in 1972 will provide the office facilities needed to cope with the additional work—work which will undoubtedly increase very much more rapidly when the Succession Act comes into force; when a considerable increase in staff will become necessary.

Details of administration and trust causes undertaken and completed during the year are set out in Appendices XXV, XXVI and XXVII.

## **BANKRUPTCY, COMPANIES LIQUIDATION AND DEEDS OF ARRANGEMENT**

During the year five Receiving Orders were made of which three were made by the High Court at Nairobi, one at Mombasa and the other at Kisumu. The total amount of deficiency as estimated by debtors was £18,583. Of the five debtors concerned, two were Asians, two African and one a European. The classification of their respective occupations is shown at Appendix XXX. The assets realized during the year from debtors' estates and the debtors' contributions from their after-acquired income amounted to £18,500. The sum distributed in dividends to ordinary creditors amounted to £15,250. Ten discharge applications were made by bankrupts. All of these were granted subject to suspensions or conditions.

### **Company Liquidation**

During the year six winding-up orders were made, all being at Nairobi. The Official Receiver was confirmed as liquidator in five cases, four of which related to proceedings instituted in previous years.

The six companies against which winding-up orders were made comprised Estate Agents, Steel Structural Engineers, Caterers, Ready-Made Cloth Merchants, Aircraft Carriers and Electrical Contractors respectively.

### **Deeds of Arrangements**

No Deed of Arrangement was registered during the year.

## **BANKRUPTCY CONTINGENCY FUND AND COMPANIES CONTINGENCY FUND**

The Income and Expenditure Accounts for these funds for the year 1971 and the Balance Sheets as at 31st December, 1971 are set out in Appendices XXXI and XXXII.

## **INSURANCE COMPANIES, BUILDING SOCIETIES AND HIRE PURCHASE SECTION**

### **Insurance Companies**

In the year 1971, three insurance companies ceased to carry on business or merged with others and no new company commenced business. This reduced the number of licensed insurance companies to 56, thus continuing the downward trend noticeable during the last few years.

Statistics showing the countries of origin of insurers and the classes of insurance business which they conduct may be found in Appendix XXXVIII (a) and (b) whilst Appendix XXXVIII (c) gives a breakdown of the main features of insurance business for 1968-1971.

### **Building Societies**

No new building society was registered during the year.

There is one building society, the East African Building Society at present operating in Kenya and statistics relating to this Society are set out in Appendix XXXIX.

### **Hire Purchase**

At the 31st December, 1971, 93 businesses were licensed to conduct hire purchase business attracting annual fees of just over Sh. 90,000. These businesses ranged from major companies dealing in expensive goods, to small traders dealing in domestic equipment and furniture.

By 31st December, 1971, 49,286 agreements had been registered with an average duration of 10 months and a maximum of 24-30 months. A sum of Sh. 433,677 in respect of registration fees and late registration fees whereby agreements had exceeded the statutory period of 30 days after their execution, was collected during the year as shown in the table in Appendix XL.

The level of hire purchase business indicates an increasing use of the facility by all sections of the general public, and clearly enables larger numbers of lower paid people to participate in the increasing higher standard of living that otherwise might have been beyond their reach. It is estimated that, at 31st December, 1971, the level of hire purchase debt outstanding was about £4.75 million.

## **ESTATE DUTY SECTION**

As in previous years this section has had during the year to deal with assessments under two classes; those on estates which passed before the suspension of the application of the former Estate Duty Ordinance in 1959 and which have not been finalized, and those on estates which have passed since 12th June, 1963 when the Estate Duty Act was reintroduced. The data given in Appendix XLI has been so arranged as to indicate under which of the two Statutes assessments have been raised.

During the year, 504 assessments were raised under the Act and the duty assessed amounted to £432,478. Five assessments were raised under the Ordinance and the duty assessed amounted to £42.

Of the total number of estates passing and assessed under the Act, no liability arose in 111 estates, i.e. 22 per cent, as the net value in each case did not exceed £5,000 or £1,000 according to whether the deceased died prior to or after 15th June, 1967. Of the remaining 393 estates (comprising 78 per cent) 299 estates attracted duty varying from one to 24 per cent and 94 estates attracted duty at the fixed rates provided for under the Finance Act No. 20 of 1967.

Out of the five estates passing and assessed under the Ordinance three did not attract duty as the net value of the estates was below the exemption limit.

Corrective Accounts were received in 185 estates. Of these in 118 additional assets were brought to account while in 60 estates a refund was claimed.

Of the 118 Corrective Accounts mentioned above 116 were subject to the provisions of the Act and two to the provisions of the Ordinance. Of those filed under the Act no

payment of additional duty was involved in three accounts. The remaining Accounts attracted additional duty to the value of £138,739 and £188 respectively.

Of the 60 estates in which a refund was claimed 57 were subject to the provisions of the Act and three to the provisions of the Ordinance. In respect of these duty amounting to £35,243 and £208 respectively was refunded.

Of the remaining seven Corrective Accounts in six cases reduced duty amounting to £18,428 was assessed and in the remaining one duty amounting to £1,548 was remitted as the bequest to the institution of the property concerned was declared by the Minister to be one of public purpose as provided in section 15 of the Estate Duty Act.

The net amount of duty collected during the year amounted to £520,696.

### TRADE UNIONS SECTION

There were 50 Unions on the register at the end of the year, comprising 35 employees' and 15 employers' unions. A breakdown of membership of these unions consisted of—employees 35 with mixed membership and employers—all 15 unions with mixed membership.

During the year no new trade union was registered but the number of branches of existing unions which were registered was twenty-one.

The dissolution of two trade unions, namely the Mombasa Local Government Services Association and Civilian Clerical Association (War Department) was registered during the year. The dissolution of six trade union branches was also registered.

Applications for registration from the following two unions were refused: East African Airways African Engineers' Association and Egerton College Staff Association. These unions were refused registration on the grounds that there were trade unions already registered which sufficiently represented the whole or a substantial proportion of the interests in respect of which the applicants sought registration. None of the unions appealed against refusal of registration.

Amendments to the rules of 8 trade unions were registered during the year.

Approval was given to 12 union officials to act in a full time capacity during the year and approval was withdrawn in two cases and one application for approval was refused.

The secretaries of five trade unions were prosecuted for failing to submit annual returns for 1970 and three of these prosecutions resulted in convictions with fines being imposed. Six branch treasurers were convicted for failing to produce books of accounts to the Registrar for examination and in each case fines were imposed and paid.

One notice of change of names or titles of officers of a trade union submitted for registration was referred to the Trade Unions Tribunal on the grounds that the Registrar was not satisfied as to the validity or propriety of the purported appointments and appropriate directions were given to the Registrar.

During the year all registered employees' trade unions and their branches were busy carrying out elections of their officials for a term of three years in accordance with the terms of the Presidential Ministerial Committee's Recommendations of September, 1965 on Trade Unionism in Kenya.

During the course of the year officers of the trade unions section carried out inspections of 118 sets of trade union books of account, comprising the accounts of 14 head offices and 104 branches. In addition to inspections carried out in Nairobi, inspections were also carried out in Mombasa, Nakuru, Kericho, Kisii, Kisumu and Machakos.

Details of books and voting membership of the trade unions on the Register, with particulars of their income and expenditure as shown by their annual returns, are set out in Appendices XLII and XLIII. The totals of the book and voting members of employees' trade unions were 262,007 and 260,698 respectively, whilst the employers' trade unions had a total of 3,648 for both book and voting members.

## **SOCIETIES, BOOKS AND NEWSPAPERS SECTION**

### **Societies**

At 31st December, 1971 there were 3,371 registered societies and 1,390 societies which were exempted from registration, an increase of 84 and 14 respectively on the totals at the beginning of the year.

New registrations effected during the year totalled 252 and 19 societies were granted exemption from registration in the same period. This compares with 262 registrations and 21 exemptions during 1970.

A total of 84 societies were refused registration and the registrations of 65 societies were cancelled under section 12 of the Societies Act. Four societies successfully appealed against cancellation of registration. A further 107 societies had their registrations cancelled under section 14 of the Act, as having ceased to exist. Four other societies exempted from registration, had their exemptions rescinded under section 14 of the Act (having ceased to exist) and 1 society had its exemption rescinded under section 13. This society subsequently applied for registration.

### **Books and Newspapers**

The number of newspapers registered as at 31st December, 1971 was 59, a decrease of three over the previous year. During the year, three new registrations were effected and six newspapers filed notice of cessation of publication.

There were 1,510 books registered at 31st December, 1971. This represented an increase of 211 over the previous year, of which 50 per cent were educational, 19 per cent were religious and the remainder ranged from commercial publications to fiction. 104 were printed in English, 33 in Swahili, three in French, 60 in vernacular languages and 11 in two or more languages.

### **COLLEGE OF ARMS**

Eight applications were received during the year under the College of Arms Act. One of these was for registration of a Grant made to the applicant prior to Independence whilst the remaining seven were for new Grants.

During the year five grants of arms were approved, completed and handed over to the applicants, one new application was approved and one other withdrawn. One application for the registration of an existing grant was approved and a certificate issued.

Of the new applications five were made by local authorities, one by an education body, one by a commercial institution, and one by an association for the protection of special interests.

Once again I must acknowledge the assistance readily given to the College throughout the year by several local heraldic experts.

### **ACCOUNTS SECTION**

Fees collected by the Department in respect of various services rendered to the public totalled £137,492 for the year 1971 as compared with £114,176 in 1970. A total sum of £347,174 was collected in respect of Estate Duty, an increase of £38,636 on the total of the previous year, but a sum of £34,833 was paid out by way of duty refunded or remitted. The total expenditure of the department on personal emoluments and other charges was £97,903.

### **ESTABLISHMENT**

The establishment of professional, executive and clerical staff was increased by seven in order to permit of the opening of new compulsory registration districts and to cater for the overall increase of Departmental work during the year.

Mr. M. L. Handa who had held a senior professional post in the Department for a number of years was appointed Deputy Registrar-General in September, 1971 whilst Mr. J. N. King'arui was promoted to the resulting vacant post of Senior Assistant Registrar-General in December, 1971.
