Reference is made to the revised Petition by Mr. Charles Henry Koinage ("the Petitioner") concerning amendment of the Coat of Arms and Public Seal by way of a Constitutional amendment.

The Petitioner seeks that the Coat of Arms and Public Seal be amended by deleting the word "Harambee" which refers to worship of an Indian goddess and substituting therefor the words "Kenya".

We have examined the Petition against the provisions of the Constitution, the Petitions to Parliament (Procedure) Act (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and the National

This is a Petition to the House to pass a Constitutional Amendment Bill, by which to remove the phrase "Harambee from the coat of arms, to replace it with" KENYA."

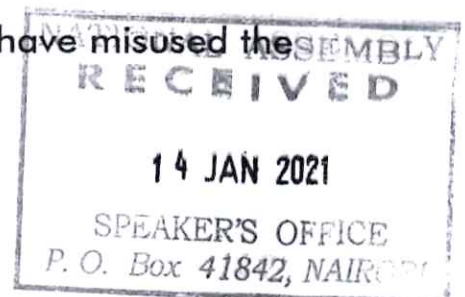
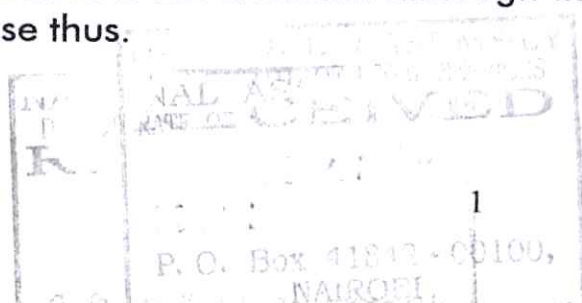
