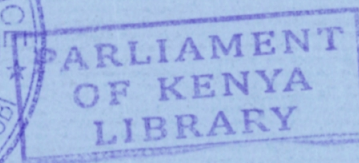


**SUBJECT: DECISION OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY ON THE SENATE'S AMENDMENTS TO THE CLIMATE CHANGE BILL (NATIONAL ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 01 OF 2014)**

**PURSUANT** to the provisions of Standing Orders 41 and 142 of the National Assembly Standing Orders, I hereby convey the following Message from the National Assembly –

**THAT**, by way of a resolution passed on Tuesday, 1<sup>st</sup> March 2016, the National Assembly **concurred** with the Senate's amendments to the Climate Change Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 01 of 2014), save for the amendments to **Clauses 7(2)(g), 7(4) and 32**, which were **disagreed to**;

**NOW THEREFORE**, in accordance with the provisions of Article 112 of the Constitution and Standing Order 149 of the National Assembly Standing Orders, I hereby **convey** the said decision of the National Assembly to the Senate and seek the appointment of Senators to the Mediation Committee to consider the said Bill in accordance with Article 113 of the Constitution.
