RE: PETITIONING THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF TANA RIVER COUNTY.

I would like to seek your intervention as in petitioning the County Government of Tana River for dismissing me from my duty as a cashier at the revenue office in the Hola Sub County Referral Hospital.

My predicaments started early last year when i had issues with the officer in charge of human resource at the facility named Abubakar when he sent someone who is a driver to my station while i was on duty to collect some money, knowing the procedures which only allowed the accountant to collect money from the revenues office, i declined but as the driver insisted i told him to ask Mr. Abubakar to come and collect the money in a person and append his signature on the counter book as a commitment that he took the money. Then after a while Mr. Abubakar came and confronted me and said he will make sure he sucked me, but i ignored him.

Mr. Abubakar continued making frequent visits to my station in the name of trying to do auditing, i understood he was not employed as an auditor so i reported to one Mr. Omar Dhadho who is the Administrator, the admin communicated to Mr. Abubakar and told him to cease coming to the revenues office since the office is classified and can only be accessed by the accountant or an auditor from the county government offices.

Mr. Abubakar never stopped storming my office til one day he came and started shouting and me while knocking on the counter, i was frustrated as i was scared since he was a man and i a lady, i decided to get out, but knowing there was money in the drawer and anything could happen i left and locked the door from outside leaving him inside. Later, the admin came and Mr. Abubakar was asked to leave as i confirmed the money was intact.

One day i was given a letter that was written by Abubakar asking me not to report to work till further notice yet no reason was started in the letter. I petitioned Mr. Abubakar through the County Assemble of Tana River whose recommendations were for me to be entitled half of my salary and auditing be done since there was an allegation that money was lost from the revenue office while was on duty. The auditor's report is out and no money was lost. yet i am not called for work and i have not been paid since day i received the letter.

My prayer to the senate is:

- I want my money as salary that i was entitled from the day i received the letter in full since i am not found with a wrong doing.
- I want Mr. Abubakar to know that he is not an auditor or an accountant and so not supposed to access the revenue office.
- I want Mr. Abubakar to be held responsible for abuse of office.
- I want the senate to intervene and have me back at my work since i have not done anything wrong and i deserve to be working.

I have suffered a lot, my daughter whom am raising alone after the father died had to quit the school i preffered to a public school, i want Mr. Abubakar to pay for my tribulations
