

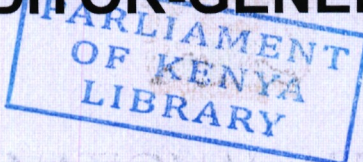

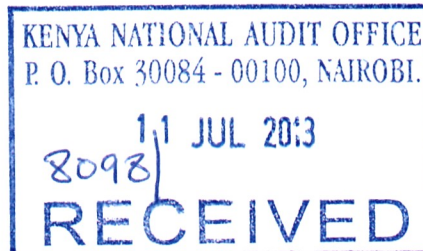

STATEMENT OF THE NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE RESPONSIBILITIES.

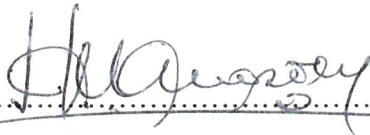

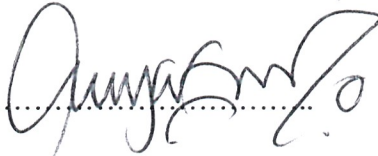

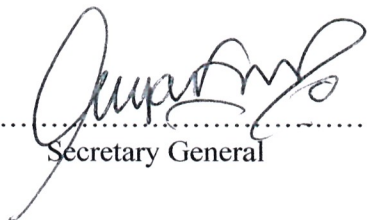

REPORT OF THE AUDITOR-GENERAL ON ORANGE DEMOCRATIC MOVEMENT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2012

REPORT ON THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

I have audited the accompanying financial statements of Orange Democratic Movement set out on pages 5 to 12, which comprise the statement of financial position as at 30 June 2012, the statement of comprehensive income, statement of changes in equity and statement of cash flows for the year then ended, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information in accordance with the provisions of Article 229 of the Constitution of Kenya, Section 8 of the Public Audit Act, 2003 and Section 34(1) of the Political Parties Act, 2007 Revised 2011. I have obtained all the information and explanations which, to the best of my knowledge and belief, were necessary for the purpose of the audit.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

The National Executive Committee of Orange Democratic Movement is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

The management is also responsible for the submission of the financial statements to the Auditor-General in accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Public Audit Act, 2003.

Auditor-General's Responsibility

My responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on the audit and report in accordance with the provisions of Section 9 of the Public Audit Act, 2003. The audit was conducted in accordance with International Standards on Auditing. Those standards require compliance with ethical

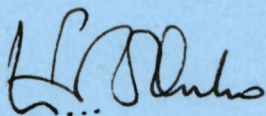
requirements and that the audit be planned and performed to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the party's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Party's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

I believe that the audit evidence obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my audit opinion.

Opinion

In my opinion the financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the Orange Democratic Movement as at 30 June 2012 and of its financial performance and its cash flows for the year then ended, in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards and comply with the Political Parties Act, 2007 (Revised 2011) and Political Parties (Funding) Regulations, 2009.

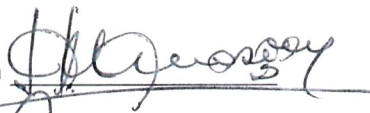

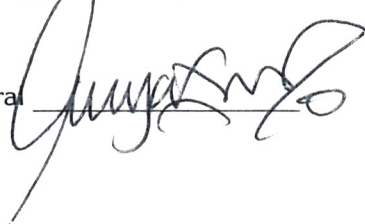

NOTE 1 (a) SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The principal accounting policies adopted in the preparation of these accounts are set below:

(i) Basis of preparation

The final statements of the Party have been prepared in accordance and comply with the standards issued by the International Financial Standards (IFRS) under the Historical cost convention.

(ii) Depreciation

Depreciation is provided for on fixed assets using the reducing balance method.

The following are the rates used :

- Lease Hold Structure 10%
- Office Furniture and Fittings 12.5%
- Office Equipment 12.5%
- Computers and Printers 30%
- Motor Vehicles 25%
