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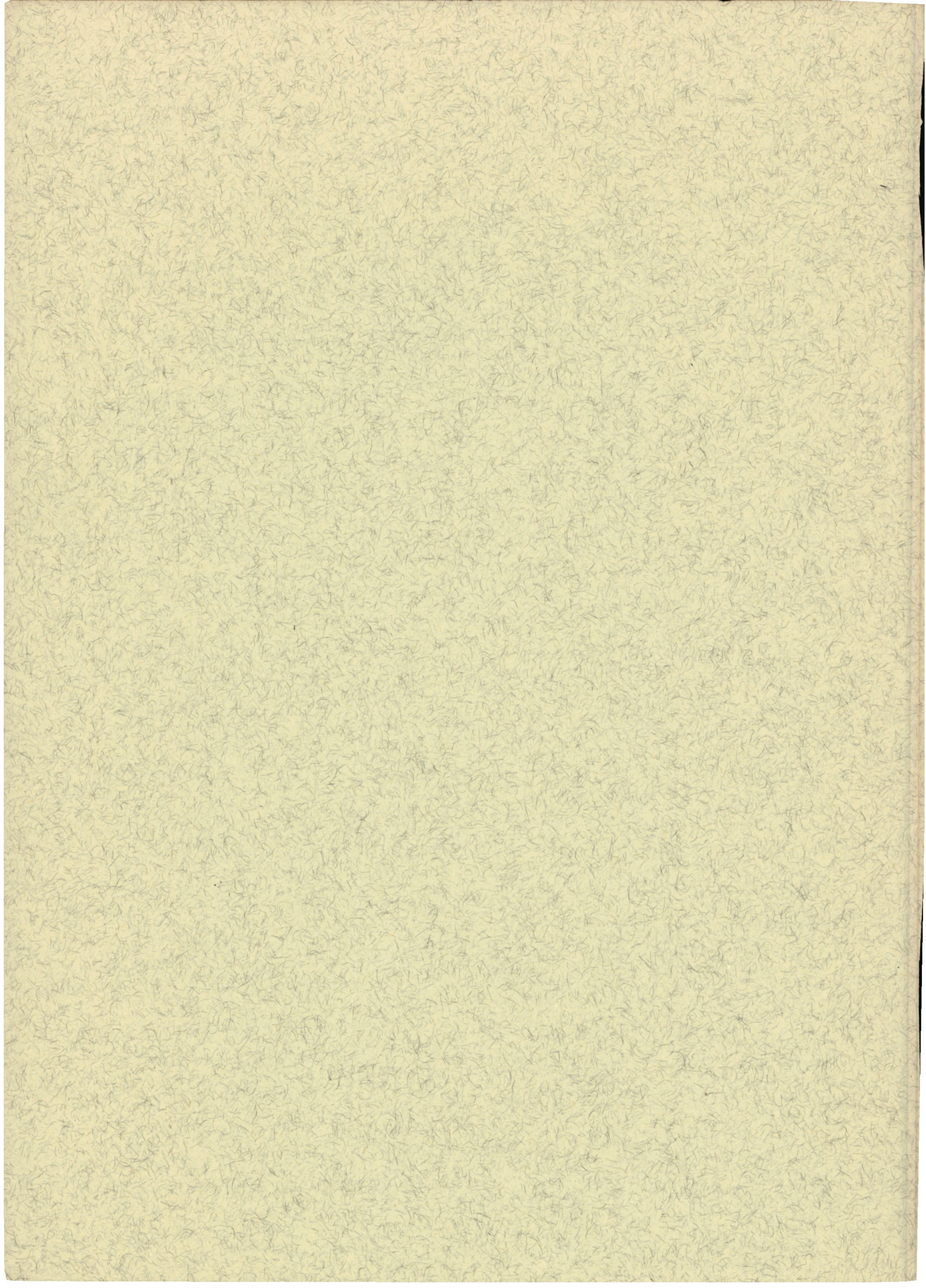

KENYA NATIONAL ASSEMBLY
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REVIEW OF THE YEAR

During the year there was once again an increase in the work of most sections of the Department. However with the improved accommodation in Sheria House, for both staff and the voluminous records of the Department, our work during the course of the year progressed reasonably smoothly, with the service offered to the public, whilst capable of improvement in some areas, none the less remaining at an acceptable level.

I very much regret the delay in submitting this report which has been occasioned by continuing problems in the preparation of data on birth and death registrations for the computer and subsequently in obtaining the relevant tabulations of vital statistics.

It is hoped that with the acquisition of new data-processing equipment these serious delays will be overcome and it will be possible to bring the Annual Reports of the Department up to date.

COMPANIES SECTION

The Section comprises the registries of Companies, Business Names, Limited Partnerships and Chattels Transfers.

The number of new companies, both public and private, incorporated during the year was 1,002 compared with 885 in the previous year. The amount of nominal capital of the new companies together with increases in capital of the existing companies was £43,169,707 compared with £27,362,211 in 1973.

There were 41 foreign companies registered and 14 such companies removed from the Register during the year.

A total of 10,225 locally incorporated companies were on the Register at 31st December, 1974, of which 555 were public and 9,670 were private. The number of foreign companies on the register stood at 841 at the end of the year, showing an increase of 27 compared with the previous year.

Of the new companies incorporated in the year, 49 per cent were formed by the African Community, 20 per cent by the Asian Community, 19 per cent by the European Community and 12 per cent by persons of two or more communal groups. The corresponding figures for the previous year were Africans 46 per cent; Asians 24 per cent; Europeans 15 per cent, and Africans, Asians and Europeans 15 per cent.

Out of 52 public companies formed, 41 were formed by Africans and the remaining 11 were formed by Africans with other communal groups.

During the year, 38 companies and their officers were prosecuted for failing to file annual returns, statutory reports, or failing to hold annual general meetings and/or lay accounts thereat, and each of these prosecutions resulted in a conviction with total fines of £10,041 being imposed.

BUSINESS NAMES

The registration of new businesses was slightly down with 4,269 compared with 4,329 in 1973 but the number of changes in particulars of existing businesses registered was 1,972 compared with 1,898 in the previous year. Five hundred and sixteen business names were removed from the register during the year, leaving a total of 59,342 on the register at the end of the year.

CHATTELS TRANSFER

The volume of borrowing on security by way of Chattels transfer was increased by £464,339; the total amount borrowed being £6,843,264. A total of 8,779 instruments and 460 satisfactions were registered.

TRADES MARKS AND PATENTS

There was a slight increase in the number of initial trade mark applications and related matters, the percentage increase over the previous year being 9 per cent. There was also an increase, compared with the previous year in the number of patent registrations during the year, the percentage increase as compared to the figure in the previous year being 8 per cent.

One application which was the subject of opposition proceedings in the previous year reached the hearing stage and was formally argued before the Registrar. There was one hearing under Rule 32.

There was one appeal in the High Court against the decision of the Registrar which resulted in the decision of the Registrar being upheld.

PATENTS

There is as yet no machinery for the original registration of patents in Kenya, the law providing only for re-registration of patents previously granted in the United Kingdom. This registration has the effect of extending the patentee's rights to the patent to Kenya. In respect of these patents 126 patents were registered during the year making a total of 2,491 patents on the register as at 31st December, 1974. The number of live patents on the Register at the same date was 1,645.

TRADE MARKS

Statistics relating to the general work of the Trade Marks and Patents Registry, with comparative figures for the last decade, are shown in Appendix VI whilst an analysis of marks registered according to the classification of goods in the Third Schedule to the Trade Marks Rules, is contained in Appendix VII. Statistics of applications and registration still show a predominant interest in the classification of goods covering patent medicines, cosmetics, domestic cleansing preparations, chemical products and stationery.

Applications from Kenya nationals continued to show a general interest in the manufacture of clothing, cosmetics, domestic cleansing preparations, medicines in oral and topical form and the manufacture of food. The number of live trade marks on the Register as at 31st December, 1974, was 14,713.

BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES SECTION

This section carries out the work connected with the Registrar-General's duties under the provisions of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, the Legitimacy Act, the Adoption Act, the Marriage Act and the African Christian Marriage and Divorce Act.

Compulsory registration of births and deaths was first introduced into the country for Europeans in 1904 and was extended to Asians in 1928. Between 1964 and 1971 it was extended district by district to all inhabitants of Kenya so that by 1974 registration of all persons had been compulsory throughout the country for about three years.

Under the provisions of the Births and Deaths Registration Act all events must be registered within six months of their occurrence. Thereafter they may be "late registered" upon application to and approval by the Registrar-General. With the introduction of universal birth registration a very large number of inhabitants applied for and obtained the late registration of their births, even though they were born prior to it becoming compulsory in their districts. This led to a great deal of additional work in the Section but as the novelty wore off predictably the number of late applications dropped considerably. There is still a large number of applications however coming in from outlying districts.

Problems have arisen due to a conflict between the desire to facilitate the registration of births where there are few, if any, contemporary records, whilst at the same time asking for as much evidence as possible to substantiate the truth of the event recorded. Owing to a large number of unfortunate cases of persons taking advantage of this in various ways, the requirements for evidence had to be tightened up in 1974. The effect of this however will not be apparent until later.

Apart from the registration of events occurring in Kenya, with the passing of the Births and Deaths Registration (Amendment) Act, 1968 the Registrar-General became responsible for the registration of births and deaths of Kenya citizens taking place outside of Kenya. In 1974 there were 118 such births and 5 such deaths registered.

REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS AND DEATHS

Apart from the old established registries in Nairobi and Mombasa, District Registries of Births and Deaths were operating in 1974 in the following Districts:— Baringo, Bungoma, Busia, Embu, Kajiado, Kakamega, Kericho, Kiambu, Kilifi, Kirinyaga, Kisii, Kisumu, Kwale, Machakos, Meru, Murang'a, Nandi, Nyandarua, Nyeri, Siaya, South Nyanza, Taita, Trans-Nzoia, Uasin-Gishu and Elgeyo-Marakwet (run together from Eldoret) and West Pokot. Registration of births and deaths occurring within the City of Nairobi, Municipalities of Mombasa and Eldoret and the Municipality and Rural District of Nakuru was done by the Town Clerks of the respective towns as agents of the Registrar-General. In all other districts registration continued to be carried out by the District Commissioners. It is however intended eventually that registration in these latter districts will be taken over by District Registrars appointed by the Registrar-General.

POPULATION

The projected population for 1974 was 12,935,000. This represents an increase of approximately 1,993,000 persons since the last national census of 1969 again of 15 per cent.

BIRTHS

The overall number of births registered in 1974 was 283,129 (149,589 males and 133,540 females) whilst total current births registered during the year amounted to 259,376, generating an average crude birth rate of approximately 20 per 1,000 population.

The overall number of births registered shows a decrease from the previous year's figures (i.e. 308,000 to 283,129).

Current births registered in 1974 also show a decrease (i.e. from 286,972 to 259,376).

In the case of late registration however there is an increase of births registered in 1974 compared with births registered in the previous year (i.e. 21,028 to 23,753).

DEATHS

The total number of deaths registered in 1974 was 53,947 (30,746 males and 23,201 females) showing an increase of 5,561 from the comparative figure for 1973.

More than 45 per cent of the deaths registered during the year occurred in hospitals and other related institutions compared with 40 per cent in 1973. The proportion was higher in Nairobi with more than 73 per cent taking place in such institutions.

There were 897 late registrations of deaths, compared with 1,394 during the previous year.

INFANT DEATHS

15,862 infant deaths were registered generating an average infant mortality rate of approximately 61 deaths per 1,000 births registered.

MARRIAGES

The number of marriages registered under the Marriage Act in 1974 within Kenya was 1,267 which is 34 less than in the previous year.

CAUTION

The same warning in reading these tables is given as in previous years namely:—

Characteristics peculiar to certain areas such as proximity to municipal and urban hospitals or institutions affect the vital statistics of these areas as residents from outside the areas use the facilities without giving a correct indication of their normal residence.

The accuracy of the tables depends primarily on the registration of all births and deaths. This situation has not been achieved in the more remote areas of the country where communication with the general public is difficult. Whilst failure to register births is not now so common, a considerable number of deaths are not being registered.

Many factors, therefore, must be considered for the correct interpretation of vital statistics and it must be clearly stated that anything which affects the denominator or numerator of the births, deaths and marriages statistics described in the following appendices will necessarily affect the rates resulting from the computation. Limiting factors to be kept in mind when interpreting the data are as follows:—

- (a) Errors in determination of residence which affect the count of births and deaths allocated to the district as a whole.
- (b) Under-registration which results in under-counts of events.
- (c) Errors in population estimation and enumeration which affect any rate requiring a population base for computation.
- (d) The efficiency of the cause of death coding and the clarity and accuracy of cause of death certification by laymen (deputy registrars) which affect the counts for deaths allocated to specific causes of deaths.

Great care, therefore, should be taken in comparing a change in the rate where the frequency of the event is small. A change in one or two events may result in a large percentage in the relative statistics. Any index should be evaluated on the basis of quality, validity and size of both the denominator and numerator used to derive the rate or ratio.

A further caution is given in connection with reading Appendices XVII and XVIII. Deaths are reported either (1) on form A2 where a medical practitioner certifies the deaths and gives a medical cause of death which is coded in accordance with the International Statistical Classification or (2) on form A3 where no medical practitioner certifies the death. In this case cause of death is determined by a description of the fatal symptoms (or syndromes) given in accordance with the table shown in Appendix XVII(a). However it has not been possible to distinguish between deaths reported in 1974 on form A2 and A3 so that the figures published show a combined total.

PUBLIC TRUSTEE SECTION

This section carries out the administration of estates of deceased persons under the Public Trustee Act and the management of trusts accepted under such Act. In the majority of cases the Public Trustee undertakes the administration of those estates where the assets are unadministered either because there is no heir who is prepared or is available to apply for letters of Administration or because the executor or administrator previously appointed has died or cannot be traced. In some cases the Public Trustee is specifically appointed to be an executor by a testator but in such cases the consent of the Public Trustee is required at the time of making the Will. The advantages of appointing the Public Trustee to be an executor, are, first, that there is guaranteed continuity of office by virtue of the Public Trustee's status as a corporation sole, and secondly, the fees charged by the Public Trustee for undertaking and completing the administration of estates are strictly regulated by statute and are not, therefore, subject to rapid change.

In addition, the Public Trustee undertakes the administration of trusts. In many cases where a minor is entitled to legacy or share of the assets of a deceased person and, not infrequently, where an award is made by Court to a person not of full age, the executor or administrator, with the consent of the Public Trustee or the Court, as the case may be, transfers such legacy, share or award to the Public Trustee, who establishes a trust with it. This is administered by the Public Trustee until the whole trust fund is paid over to the former minor upon his or her attaining the age of majority.

The Public Trustee also administers trusts which contain no provision for their maturing after the expiration of a stipulated period and for the trust funds then being paid over to the particular beneficiaries. Common examples of such trusts are those which are set up for purposes such as the furtherance of education, charity, recreation, etc. The duration of such trusts is by their nature frequently extremely lengthy. In such cases the fact that the Public Trustee is a corporation sole is particularly useful as the trust funds vest in the holder of the office and not individual trustees. Consequently, the delay and expense involved in the transfer of funds from individual trustees to their successors in office is obviated.

The Public Trustee is also from time to time appointed manager of the estates of persons of unsound mind under the Mental Treatment Act, and is required to make an annual report of accounts submitted by other managers during the course of each year.

There was once again an increase in the work of the Public Trustee Section. Two thousand one hundred and sixty-seven new estates were accepted for administration and two thousand three hundred and eighty-five estates were wound up and distributed. In the case of trusts thirty-seven new trusts were accepted during the year and forty-seven of those already under administration were finalized and discharged. The administration causes still actively in hand, therefore, increased by a figure of one hundred and nine causes to a total of one thousand nine hundred and eighty-four estates whilst in the case of trusts the number under administration at the end of the year was two hundred and sixty-one. The steady increase in current work reflects changing social conditions, particularly, the continued toll of lives in motor-car accidents which results in payments of large sums by insurance companies by way of compensation, and also the increased use of life insurance by individuals and payment of death grants or gratuities by employers, all of which result in comparatively large sums of money coming into what would otherwise have been very small estates.

BANKRUPTCY, COMPANIES LIQUIDATION AND DEEDS OF ARRANGEMENT

During the year seven receiving orders were made, of which five were made at Nairobi and one each at Mombasa and Kisumu. This shows a drop of four causes as compared with the previous year. The total amount of deficiency as estimated by debtors was £9,755. No statements of affairs were filed in two causes. Of the nine debtors concerned four were Africans, three were Asians, and two were Europeans. The classification of their respective occupations is shown at Appendix XXIX. The assets realized during the year from debtors' estates and the contributions made by debtors amounted to £11,357. The sum distributed in dividends to ordinary creditors amounted to £12,113. Four discharge applications were made by bankrupts, of which one was granted unconditionally and three were granted subject to suspensions or conditions.

COMPANIES LIQUIDATION

During the year six winding up orders were made at Nairobi and the Official Receiver was confirmed as Liquidator in two cases.

The six companies against which the winding up orders were made comprised dealers in clothing, electrical equipment and hosiery, building contractors, Insurance Agents, and manufacturers of furnishing materials.

DEEDS OF ARRANGEMENT

No deed of arrangement was registered during the year.

BANKRUPTCY CONTINGENCY FUND AND COMPANIES CONTINGENCY FUND

The Income Expenditure Accounts for these funds for the year 1974 and the Balance Sheets as at 31st December, 1974 are set out in Appendices XXX, XXXI, XXXIV and XXXV respectively.

INSURANCE COMPANIES, BUILDING SOCIETIES AND HIRE-PURCHASE SECTION

INSURANCE COMPANIES

In the year 1974, one new company was locally incorporated to carry on Insurance Business. The number of companies operating in Kenya has however again decreased due to merging of companies in India, as a part of that country's nationalization of General Insurance Business Scheme.

Statistics showing the countries of origin of Insurers and the classes of insurance business which they conduct may be found in Appendix XXXVII whilst Appendix XXXVIII gives a breakdown of the main features of insurance business during the years 1970 to 1974.

BUILDING SOCIETIES

The United Kenya Building Society which was registered during 1972 did not commence business during the year.

Statistics relating to Kenya's only functioning Building Society, the East African Building Society, are shown in Appendix XXXIX.

HIRE-PURCHASE

At the 31st December, 1974 66 businesses were licensed to conduct Hire-Purchase business, comprising 10 Finance Houses and 56 industrial dealers.

During the year 32,084 agreements were registered as compared with 33,433 registered in 1973. The agreements had an average duration of 10 months and a maximum of 24-30 months.

During the year a total of K.Sh. 265,076.00 was collected as registration fees and licence fees. This amount, of which details are given in Appendix XL, also includes a sum of K.Sh. 9,920.00 collected as late fees where agreements had not been registered within the statutory period of 30 days.

According to the Registers of Agreements it is estimated that at 31st December, 1974 the level of Hire-Purchase debt outstanding was about K£3.7 million.

ESTATE DUTY SECTION

As in previous years this section has had during the year to deal with assessments under two classes; those on estates which passed before the suspension of the application of the former Estate Duty Ordinance in 1959 and which have not been finalized, and those on estates which have passed since 12th June, 1963 when the Estate Duty Act was re-introduced. The data given in Appendix XLI has been so arranged as to indicate under which of the two statutes assessments have been raised.

During the year 562 assessments were raised under the Act and the duty assessed amounted to £653,587. Six assessments were raised under the Ordinance and the duty assessed amounted to £263.

Of the total number of estates passing and assessed under the Act, no liability arose in 192 estates i.e. 34 per cent, as the net value in each case did not exceed £5,000, £1,000 or £2,500 according to whether the deceased died prior to or after 15th June, 1967; or whether the deceased died after 16th June, 1972 respectively. Of the remaining 370 estates (comprising 66 per cent) 325 estates attracted duty varying from one to 30 per cent, and 45 estates attracted duty at the fixed rates provided for under the Finance Act No. 20 of 1967.

Corrective Accounts were received in 159 estates. Of these additional assets were brought to account in 132 while in 27 estates a refund was claimed.

Of the Corrective Accounts mentioned above 157 were subject to the provisions of the Act and two to the provisions of the Ordinance. Of those filed under the Act no payment of duty was involved in one account. The remaining accounts attracted additional duty to the value of £105,769 and £2 respectively.

All the 27 estates in which a refund was claimed were subject to the provisions of the Act and duty amounting to £7,611 was refunded in 25 estates.

In two remaining Corrective Accounts reduced duty amounting to £345 was assessed.

The net amount of duty collected during this year amounting to £561,511.

TRADE UNIONS SECTION

There were 55 unions on the Register at the end of the year, comprising 40 employees' and 15 employers' unions. A breakdown of these unions consisted of—employees 40 with mixed membership and employers—all 15 unions with mixed membership.

During the year three trade unions were registered, namely the Kenya Tea Growers Association, Kenya National Union of Fishermen Workers and East African Cabin Crew Union, whilst the number of branches registered was 30.

No trade union was dissolved during the year but the number of branches dissolved was 5.

Applications for registration from the following seven unions were refused: Kenya Educational Institutions Workers' Union, Embassies and Allied Workers' Union, Kenya Bar Workers' Union, Railway Workers' Union (K), Tea Plantations Workers' Union, Kenya National Security and Allied Workers' Union and Kenya Day and Night Security Guards Workers' Union. These unions were refused registration on the grounds that there were trade unions already registered which sufficiently represented the whole or a substantial proportion of the interests in respect of which the applicants sought registration. None of the unions appealed against refusal of registration. Four applications for registration were still pending at the end of the year.

Amendments to the rules of 19 trade unions were registered during the year.

The Secretaries of five trade unions were prosecuted for failing to submit annual returns for 1973 and four of these prosecutions resulted in convictions with fines being imposed. Thirteen branch treasurers were also prosecuted for failing to produce books of accounts to the Registrar for examination.

The Trade Unions Tribunal gave its directions to the Registrar of Trade Unions in respect of two notices of change of names or titles of officers of a trade union submitted for registration in 1973 which had been referred to it on the grounds that the Registrar was not satisfied as to the validity or propriety of the purported appointments.

All registered employees' trade unions and their branches during the year under review were busy carrying out elections of their officers for a term of three years in accordance with requirements of the Presidential Ministerial Committee's Recommendations of September, 1965 on Trade Unionism in Kenya.

During the course of the year officers of the trade unions section carried out inspections of 119 sets of trade union books of accounts, comprising the accounts of 36 head offices and 83 branches. In addition to inspections carried out in Nairobi inspections were also carried out in Mombasa, Kiambu, Limuru, Uplands, Kitui, Kajiado, Athi River and Machakos.

Details of book and voting membership of the trade unions on the Register, with particulars of their income and expenditure as shown by their annual returns, are set out in Appendices XLII and XLIII. The totals of the book and voting members of employees trade unions were 320,823 and 320,788 respectively, whilst the employers' trade unions had a total of 3,675 for both book and voting members.

SOCIETIES, BOOKS AND NEWSPAPERS SECTION

Societies

At the end of the year, there were 3,635 registered societies and 1,448 societies which were exempted from registration.

New registrations effected during the year totalled 337 and 20 societies were granted exemption from registration, five of which had previously been registered. This compared with 335 registrations and 11 exemptions effected in the previous year.

A total of 127 societies were refused registration and registration of 194 societies was cancelled mainly for failing to comply with orders served under the Act and for failing to submit returns. 18 societies successfully appealed against cancellation of their registrations. 6 other societies exempted from registrations had their exemptions rescinded under section 14 of the Act (having ceased to exist).

BOOKS AND NEWSPAPERS

The number of newspapers registered as at 31st December, 1974 was 67, a decrease of one from the previous year's total.

During the year two new registrations were effected and three newspapers filed notice of cessation of publication. There were 2,075 books registered at 31st December, 1974. This represented an increase of 158 over 1973. Of the books registered 53 per cent were educational, 26 per cent religious and the remainder ranged from commercial subjects to fiction. 124 books were printed in English, 24 Swahili, 3 in French and 10 vernacular languages.

COLLEGE OF ARMS

During the year seven new applications were received and approved. One of these was for the registration for a Grant of Arms made by the Garter Clarenceux and Norroy and Ulster Kings of Arms and six for new Grants by the Kenya College of Arms. These were ultimately signed, sealed and delivered to the applicants.

ACCOUNTS SECTION

Fees collected by the Department in respect of various services rendered to the public, totalled £152,996 for the year ended 31st December, 1974 as compared with £137,160 for the previous year, resulting in an increase of fee income of £15,836. A total of £545,729 was collected in respect of Estate Duty, as compared with £474,904 for the previous year—an increase of £70,825. The total expenditure of the Department on personal emoluments and other charges amounted to £142,717.

ESTABLISHMENT

Mr. R. Athiambo joined the Department as a Legal Assistant on 2nd May 1974.
