Honourable Senators,

1. Pursuant to Standing Orders 220 (1) (a), and 225(2) (b), I hereby report to the Senate that a petition has been submitted, through the Clerk, by the new kengele association from Busia County, concerning the procedure followed in the construction of Mjini primary school on the security buffer zone land.
2. In the Petition, the petitioner states-
 - a) that, the Busia county held an investors conference on 18th -20th March 2015;
 - b) that prior to the hosting the above investors conference, public participation was not conducted as contemplated in chapter II part 1 (c) of the constitution and part VIII a, b and g of the county government Act 2012; and
 - c) That public money was spent on the investors conference and that details on expenditure has not been made public.
3. The Petitioner therefore prays that the Senate investigates this matter, and makes appropriate recommendations and interventions thereon. Among the proposals made by the Petitioner is for the Senate to recommend the county government of Busia to make a detailed expenditure report for the investors conference, the procurement criteria used to identify and contract Busia chambers of commerce as the sole organizers of the investor conference and whether it complied with the procurement Act 2002 section 58 (2).

I acknowledge with thanks receipt of your Petition on the above subject matter.

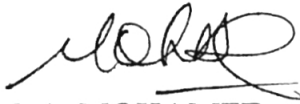
Upon reviewing the Petition in terms of Senate Standing Order 220 (3), it is noted that it raises matters which appear to be audit queries and makes allegations of criminal conduct on the part of officials of the Busia County Government. You will appreciate that the relevant institutions to deal with such issues at the first instance are the Office of the Auditor- General, the Ethics and Anti Corruption Commission (EACC) and the Directorate of Public Prosecutions (DPP). Your Petition herein neither demonstrates that any efforts have been made to have the matter addressed by the said relevant bodies nor indicate whether there has been any response therefrom or whether the response has been unsatisfactory, as required by Senate Standing Order 223 (f).

Furthermore, the Petition is defective on the ground that it does not contain the addresses of the Petitioners, in contravention of Standing Order 223 (j)

In the Circumstances, I regret to advise that the Petition is not admissible for consideration by the Senate in its present form. Attached, are the relevant provisions relating to the requirement for a public petition as well as a template on the form of a public petition, which you may adopt should it become necessary to pursue this matter in future.
