THE SUGAR ACT, 2024

(No.11 of 2024)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred under section 61 of the Sugar Act, 2024, the Cabinet Secretary for the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock Development, in consultation with the County Governments and the Kenya Sugar Board, makes the following Regulations—

**THE SUGAR (IMPORTS AND EXPORTS) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 2025**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Sugar (Imports and Exports) (Amendment) Regulations, 2026.

Citation.

2. The Sugar (Imports and Exports) Regulations, 2025, in these Regulations referred to as the "principal Regulations", are amended in regulation 5 by deleting the words "thirty days" appearing in paragraph (4) immediately after the words "valid for" and substituting therefor the words "one year".

3. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 7—

- (a) in paragraph (1), by deleting the words "or pre-export approval" appearing immediately after the word "permit";
- (b) by deleting paragraph (2) and substituting therefor the following new paragraph—

(2) An application made under paragraph (1) shall be accompanied by a copy of—

- (a) the applicant's import licence issued under regulation 6;
- (b) the applicant's commercial invoice indicating the price, insurance and freight costs of the consignment;
- (c) the bill of lading for the consignment;
- (d) the applicant's import declaration form;
- (e) the single administrative document for the consignment issued under the East African Community Customs Management Regulations, 2010;
- (f) delivery note for the consignment;
- (g) the certificate of origin of the consignment;
- (h) the phyto-sanitary permits issued by the Kenya Plant Health Inspectorate Service for the consignment; and
- (i) the certificate of pre-import conformity from the country of origin for the consignment.

4. Regulation 9 of the principal Regulations is amended—

- (a) in paragraph (2), by deleting the words "import or" appearing immediately after the words "issue an" in subparagraph (a);
- (b) in paragraph (3), by deleting the words "import or" appearing immediately after the word "An".

5. Regulation 10 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting paragraph (2) and substituting therefor the following new paragraph—

(2) An application made under paragraph (1) shall be accompanied by a copy of—

- (a) the applicant's import licence issued under regulation 6;
- (b) the applicant's commercial invoice indicating the price, insurance and freight costs of the consignment;
- (c) the bill of lading for the consignment;
- (d) the applicant's import declaration form;
- (e) the single administrative document for the consignment issued under the East African Community Customs Management Regulations, 2010;

- (f) delivery note for the consignment;
- (g) the certificate of origin of the consignment;
- (h) the phyto-sanitary permits issued by the Kenya Plant Health Inspectorate Service for the consignment; and
- (i) the certificate of pre-import conformity from the country of origin for the consignment.
