**ON THE APPROVAL OF THE MEDIATED VERSION OF THE STATUTE LAW
(MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS) (NO. 2) BILL (NATIONAL ASSEMBLY
BILL NO. 33 OF 2013)**

Honourable Senators,

I wish to report to the Senate that, pursuant to Standing Order 40 (3) and (4), I received the following message from the Speaker of the National Assembly regarding the approval of the Report of the Mediation Committee on the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No. 2) Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 33 of 2013)-

“**PURSUANT** to the provisions of Standing Orders 41(1) and 142 of the National Assembly Standing Orders, I hereby convey the following Message from the National Assembly-

WHEREAS, the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No. 2) Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 33 of 2013) was referred to a Mediation Committee on Wednesday, 13th October, 2015;

AND WHEREAS, the National Assembly, by way of resolution passed on Tuesday, 29th March, 2016, **approved** the mediated version of the said Bill in the form developed by the Mediation Committee;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of Standing Order 150(4)(b) of the National Assembly Standing Orders, Article 113 of the Constitution, I hereby **convey** the said decision of the National Assembly”.
