REPORT OF THE ESTIMATES COMMITTEE ON THE DRAFT ESTIMATES OF REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE OF THE NON-SELF-CONTAINED SERVICES OF THE EAST AFRICA HIGH COMMISSION FOR THE YEAR 1956-57.

The Draft Estimates of Revenue and Expenditure of the Non-self-contained Services of the East Africa High Commission for the year 1956-57 were referred to the Committee by motion of the Central Legislative Assembly on 21st March, 1956.

2. The Committee met on 22nd and 23rd March, 1956, and examined the Draft Estimates in detail, Heads of Departments being in attendance.

3. The Committee approved the principle of single line votes being provided for the departments under the ægis of the East African Agricultural and Fisheries Research Council, and the East African Council for Medical Research and delegated to the Councils the power of virement between the items set out in detail in the memorandum to the draft Estimates. The Committee further recommended that the Finance Member be authorized to approve urgent virement for expenditure items not provided for in the Estimates. The Committee delegated these powers on the understanding that a statement of the policy and research programme of each organization would be included in the memorandum to the Estimates in future years.

4. The Committee recommended that the East African Governments be asked to consider the fixing of ceilings of expenditure up to 30th June, 1960, for the Research Services under the ægis of the Research Councils.

5. The Committee noted that the East African Production and Supply Council had not met since September, 1954, and that at that meeting it had found it difficult to suggest clear terms of reference for the Executive or, in fact, for the Council itself until such time as the Governments had made clear their policies in relation to East African self-sufficiency. In the meantime, there had been interterritorial discussions on this subject and the Committee for Economic Co-ordination had been formed. It was agreed that while there were circumstances under which it might be desirable for a frank exchange of views at a high official level, it was also desirable that there should be a forum where commercial and unofficial advice could be obtained and for that reason the Production and Supply Council should continue in being. The view was expressed that it should seek to obtain greater co-ordination between the territories with regard to the availability and distribution of essential foodstuffs in East Africa.

6. The Committee recommended that the Finance Member be authorized to make any necessary typographical amendment in the Estimates which involve no change in principle or the approved provision of funds.

7. The Committee recommended the approval of the Draft Estimates subject to the amendments, modifications and observations set out below under the various heads of the Estimates.

EXPENDITURE**HEAD 2: E.A. AGRICULTURE AND FORESTRY RESEARCH ORGANIZATION**

The Committee recommended that the Finance Member be authorized to approve any profit from the sale of farm products as expenditure on the development of the farm.

The Committee agreed with the recommendation of the E.A. Agricultural and Fisheries Research Council that the provision be amended as follows:—

HEAD 4: DESERT LOCUST SURVEY**(4) Control Measures**

The Committee considered the views of the Desert Locust Board and the Desert Locust Control Executive Committee and recommended that the Estimates be recast to enable the expenditure to be kept within the funds available.

The Committee was advised that a reduction of £25,000 could be made in the total provision as a result of certain areas being taken over by the Imperial Ethiopian Government, thereby reducing the Estimates to £882,198. The contributions which the East African Governments were prepared to make were:—

leaving a gap of £190,000. The Committee therefore had no alternative but to recommend a further reduction in the total provision to £692,000 with appropriate adjustment in the details.

The Hon. David Makwaia, O.B.E., M.L.A., the Hon. P. C. Ofwono, M.L.A., and the Hon. Filip Ingutia, M.L.A., considered that the campaign should be abandoned and requested that this should be recorded in this report.

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HEAD 23: E.A. VIRUS RESEARCH INSTITUTE

The Committee strongly endorsed the protest sent to the Secretary of State at the reduction in the Colonial Development and Welfare Grant from 75 per cent to 45 per cent of the recurrent expenditure for the year 1956-57. The Committee considered that a large part of the work of the Institute was of international significance and the Secretary of State should again be requested to reconsider his decision.

The Committee recommended the approval of the Draft Estimates, the Hon. E. A. Vasey, C.M.G., M.L.C., M.L.A., and the Hon. Sir Alfred Vincent, M.L.A., dissenting on the amount provided for subordinate staff, library and staff housing.

In view of the difficulty of attracting suitably qualified officers, the Committee requested that proposals for a revised staff structure should be submitted to Members and the territorial Governments as soon as possible.
