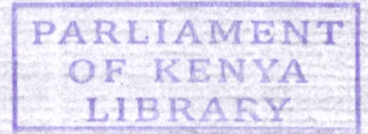
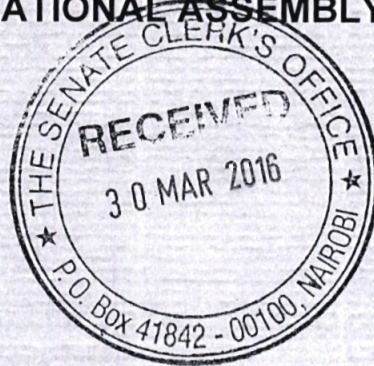

APPROVAL OF THE DIVISION OF REVENUE
BILL (NATIONAL ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 4 OF 2016)

PURSUANT to the provisions of Standing Orders 41(1) and 142 of the National Assembly Standing Orders, I hereby convey the following Message from the National Assembly –

WHEREAS, the Division of Revenue Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 4 of 2016) was published *vide* Kenya Gazette Supplement No. 27 of 9th March 2016 pursuant to Article 218(1)(b) of the Constitution to provide for equitable division of revenue raised by the national government among the national and county levels of Government;

AND WHEREAS, the National Assembly considered and passed the said Bill on wednesday, 30th March 2016 without amendments in the form attached hereto;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions Articles 110(4) of the Constitution and Standing Order 142 of the National Assembly Standing Orders, I hereby refer the said Bill to the Senate for consideration.
