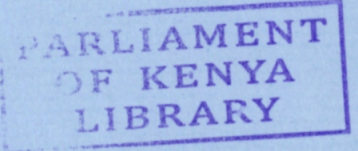


COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR

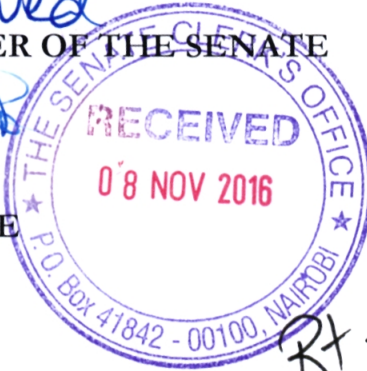
