Petition to The Senate by Registered Voters of Mabatini Ward, Nairobi County, Concerning irregular establishment of the Mabatini Ward Development Fund Committee

We, the undersigned,

Citizens of the Republic of Kenya and registered voters of Mabatini Ward, Nairobi County.

DRAW the attention of the Senate to the following:

1. **THAT**, in line with Chapter 17 Article 260 of the Constitution of Kenya, The office of the County Assembly Ward, being a public office, and in accordance with chapter 6 article 73 (1,2) of the constitution, the bearer of the office is supposed to conduct him/herself with utmost integrity.
2. **THAT**, the current holder of the position of Mabatini County ward representative, Hon. Wilfred Oluoch Odalo, has fallen short of the above mentioned provisions of the constitution and various acts of law.
3. **THAT**, the Mabatini ward MCA has failed to embrace public participation in constituting the County Ward Development fund committee, as well as disregarding public participation in other development plans for the Ward in total disregard of Article 196 of the Constitution and Section 32 of Nairobi County Ward Development fund Committee act of 2014.
4. **That**, the current county ward development committee does not reflect regional and demographic diversity of Mabatini Ward.
5. **THAT**, the ward representative is engaging in skewed resource allocation in contravention of Article 174 on Objects and Principles of Devolved Government.

6. That the Ward representative is meddling with the executive functions of the county government in contravention of Section 9(2) of the County Government Act as opposed to legislating county laws as provided for in Article 185 of the Constitution of Kenya.

WHEREFORE, your humble petitioners pray that the Senate-

- 1) Sessional Committee on County Public Accounts and Investments and the Sessional Committee on Devolved Government conduct an investigation into the affairs and conduct of the Mabatini County Ward representative.
- 2) Instructs the Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission to investigate allocation of funds for development by the Mabatini County Ward development fund Committee.
- 3) Calls for documents and conducts an audit into the constitution of the Mabatini County Ward development fund Committee; and
- 4) Comes up with any decision aimed at protecting devolution, and taxpayers' monies and any parties found to have received monies irregularly surcharged;
